A tribute to a master chef Rustenburg - Johann Ludick, master chef, dear creative soul and used to sew clothes for his sister's

friend, beloved brother, and cherished son sadly passed away on Wednesday 12 April 2023.

Johann was the well-known owner of Under the Cherry Blossom where he created unforgettable fine dining experiences for his clients

Johann spent his formative years in Rustenburg where he went to Laerskool Rustenburg and then to Hoërskool Rustenburg. Even as a child he had a and cousin's dolls. Word of his talents soon spread, and he even had orders coming in from the Free State to earn extra pocket money.

After school, he started working at Arthur Kaplan. His parents then moved to the Western Cape and Johann followed shortly after. Here he got a job at Stellenbosch Motor Spares where he was a warranty

But Johann's creative side kept calling, and one day he arrived home and told his parents that he had resigned and wanted to follow his dream of becoming a great chef. On 1 December 2004, he started working at the iconic Lord Charles Hotel as a trainee chef, under the mentorship of another great chef, Andrew Hammond. He later returned to Rustenburg in 2018, where he became the executive chef at the Excalibur Boutique Hotel and Function Centre in Rustenburg Finally, in 2019 his dream came true when he opened his own

fine-dining establishment, Under the Cherry Blossom. Every dish he prepared was made with only the finest ingredients. According to his mother, Ria Ludick, he didn't use a recipe book; every dish was measured and prepared by heart. He would often talk to his mom about his developing recipe ideas, on which he painstakingly pondered; he would rest on a recipe for a while and would later return to his mom once he had it figured out; according to Johann's mom, God inspired the final decisions on his recipes

For Johann, a fine-dining experience was more than just a night out as he made every experience unique and personal. Ria tends to a flower garden, which he often used to collect garnish for his dishes. Every dish was made with such precision that even the tiniest of flowers would be placed with a tweezer. When it came to detail and taste, Johann left no stone unturned, which is one of the reasons he received four culinary awards during his time as a chef

In his personal life. Johann was known as a warm and affectionate person who loved to be around people, and who adored his parents and family. He was a devoted Christian who always stood firmly in his faith. Johann also had a caring heart and gave back to his community with initiatives such as baking beautiful cakes for the Lighthouse Children's Home.

Johan made a lasting impression on everyone he met, and inspired others to follow their dreams.

His legacy will live on in the cherished memories of those who had the privilege of knowing him. He made his parents proud, not only with his culinary achievements, but also because of who he was as a person. Ria will forever miss the enticing scents which sauntered out of Johann's kitchen while he was cooking his masterpieces.

Phatlhaphatlha said the new board has a lot of work on their hands. "We plan to hold awareness campaigns so that everyone can be on board in the efforts to fight crime. There are increasing incidents of robberies in Boitekong and we have to do everything we can to eradicate crime within our communities," he said.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi revealed that from 2019 the board was led by an interim structure after the chairperson had resigned.

"We are happy that a new structure is now in place. A proper CPF board election was prevented by Covid-19 and other challenges," Mokgadi said.

TAVERNS ROBBED IN TWO DAYS

Phokeng/ Rustenburg - Three taverns were to take them to the office where they took cash robbed during separate incidents reported in Rasimone as well as in the Kgale and Pitso areas

Cases of business robbery and attempted murder are being investigated by the police, who have not ruled out the possibility that the implicated suspects could be linked to all three incidents.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said that the first incident occurred in Rasimone on Saturday 22 April at around 00:30 in the morning.

"Two armed suspects got out of a white Audi sedan with unknown registration plates and held the tavern's patrons and owner at gunpoint," Mokgadi said, "The owner tried to fight them off, but one suspect fired a shot in the air and forced the owner to cooperate. All patrons were ordered to lie down, and their cellphones and money were taken from them," Mokgadi added.

The suspects then instructed the tavern's cashier

and bottles of whisky before driving away from the scene using a vehicle belonging to the owner of the tavern. Later, the vehicle was discovered in Mafenya

Mokgadi said that the suspects involved in the second incident on Saturday evening 22 April at a tavern in Kgale used the same method as the one used in the first.

"Early on Sunday 23 April, at round 01:00, suspects also shot at patrons in a tavern Pitso and injured five of the patrons," Mokgadi further explained. "The victims of the shooting were all taken to hospital and are in serious but stable conditions," he added.

Police are still investigating to establish more facts related to all three incidents.

Four nabbed for cable theft

Koster - Four suspects appeared before the Koster Magistrates' Court on Monday 24 April 2023 following their arrest for possession of suspected stolen copper cables worth R117 000

Eric Mathebetlha (42), Itumeleng Sebokolodi (39), Mlandeni Mlatha (36) and Shadrack Mokotedi (31) were stopped by police on Sunday 23 April while travelling in a white Ford bakkie along the R52 Road from Lichtenburg to Koster.

"Police, who demanded to search the vehicle, discovered 1,000 meters of Eskom fox aluminium worth R96,000, and a 70-metre bundle of black conductor cable worth R21,000 at the back of their bakkie," said police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi. "The four failed to provide any documentation of where they bought the cables. An inspector from Eskom was contacted and was able to identify the cables as the property of the company," Mokgadi added. The four suspects remain in custody until their next court appearance on Thursday 4 May 2023.

The Smile Foundation conducts plastic and reconstructive surgery on children who suffer from treatable facial deformities such as cleft lip and palate, burn victims, Mobius syndrome (facial paralysis) and other conditions. The organisation does not only conduct life-changing surgeries on these children but also provides support and counselling for their families. According to the Smile Foundation's finance and fundraising manager Ms Elaine Ngwenya, the organisation has conducted 5066 operations across seven provinces in the country. "We also assist with the training of nursing staff in academic hospitals and have sent doctors overseas to be trained on specialist procedures," she said. The department has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the foundation through which the reconstructive procedures will be conducted in other facilities across the province in order to bring the service closer to communities.

More than a vegetable garden

Rustenburg – A community member living in the Dienie Estates settlement allocated a piece of land on his property to the Rustenburg Hospice. This garden is being utilised to plant vegetables and is being tended to by patients who receive home-based care.

Platinum Weekly had the opportunity to visit the garden on Friday 14 April 2023.

The vegetable garden has recently been harvested and is currently being prepared for the next planting season. Recently plucked bean bushes and beetroot are all that remain of the successful harvest.

Seedlings are bought from local street vendors, nurseries, and hardware shops, and planted according to season. There is also a JoJo tank on the property to ensure that the garden gets enough water.

Although the garden is not very large, it has provided more than enough food for those tending to it. However, the aim of the garden is for it to provide more than nourishment. "It keeps the elderly active and gives them a purpose. Every Wednesday, the hospice gathers everyone together and they sit and talk and it's more like a support group. They also have a pastor who comes and ministers to them," said the

Rustenburg Hospice project manager Besong Williams. Williams added: "People often think that a hospice is just a place where people go to finish their remaining years, but we do so much more than that. We provide palliative care, which is specialised medical care for people living with a serious illness. Often families don't know how to take care of elderly family members, so we also educate them and help them where needed."

The Rustenburg Hospice also has trained helpers who check in with their patients daily. These helpers take the patients' blood pressure, make sure they have taken their medication, and assess their general well-being. Depending on the circumstances, most of these services are provided at no cost.

The hospice vegetable garden is a great way to engage with the patients and provide not only medical support, but also emotional support.

You can support this project by donating seeds and seedlings, or by supporting the Rustenburg Hospice's fundraising projects and charity shops. Any donations of shade netting and gardening equipment are also welcomed.
