

Two arrested for possession of unbranded cattle

Koster - Two men were arrested along the R53 Road to Koster on Friday 5 May 2023 for transporting livestock without documentation.

Ofentse Ignatius Mphomane and Motlogelwa Jairous Matlapeng appeared before the Koster Magistrates' Court on 8 May and were each granted R5,000 bail.

Said police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi: "Police who were on patrol at the time received information of a suspicious Tovota Quantum travelling along the R53 from Swartruggens towards Koster, which was towing a trailer loaded with livestock. When police stopped the vehicle, nine unbranded live cattle were discovered, and the

suspects could not provide any documentation of ownership."

Further investigations by police revealed that the two suspects had bought the cattle for R40,000 from a farmworker, without the rightful owner's knowledge. The cattle are worth approximately R100,000.

"The owner of the cattle, who is a farmer, was traced by the police and summoned to the station to identify his livestock. He was also charged for not branding his cattle," Mokgadi said. The two suspects are expected to appear again before the court on 15 June 2023. Police, who are carrying out further investigations, are yet to locate the whereabouts of the farmworker.

Man's body found near bridge

Phokeng/ Rustenburg – The body of a 61-year-old man was discovered in Phokeng on Sunday 7 May 2023.

The man's body, which was found after the bridge along the Legato and Luka Road, had a stab wound in the neck and visible injuries on other areas of the body.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said that police are investigating a case of murder.

"According to preliminary investigations, the deceased was killed elsewhere before he was dumped at the

3 neighbourhood watch members killed

Freedom Park/Rustenburg - Three neighbourhood watch members were killed while two others sustained serious injuries during a shooting. The incident occurred at the Ntsintsi area of the Freedom Park informal settlement on Saturday 6 May 2023 at around 21:30.

Police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi explained that two unknown gunmen opened fire on the neighbourhood watch members who had gathered near number 8 hostel for a meeting.

"The meeting was about to end when the gunmen started shooting randomly. Three men, aged 45, 58 and 62 were killed, and two people were admitted at Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital with serious gun wounds," said Mokgadi. Acting Bojanala Platinum District Sub 2 Commissioner, brigadier Mamotsamai Ntoagae, strongly condemned the incident and called on the community help the police bring the perpetrators to book.

Three cases of murder and two of attempted murder are being investigated by police and no arrests have yet been made.

Taxi overturns during accident

Rustenburg – A taxi overturned on its side after it was hit by another taxi at the corner of Thabo Mbeki Drive and Boshoff Street. The accident occurred on Wednesday 10 May 2023 at approximately 06:20 in the morning.

Police are investigating the possibility that one of the taxis, which was headed toward the direction of Geelhout Park on Thabo Mbeki Drive, hit the other taxi which was travelling on Boshoff Street.

"Up arrival we found that one of the minibus taxis was transporting school children. The traffic lights were not working, and it is suspected that one of the taxi's did not stop at the intersection." said Revno Dempers, special operations manager for Trauma-Rescue EMS.

"The taxis t-boned each other and one taxi overturned and landed on its side. A total of 20 patients on scene were transported to various hospitals across Rustenburg," Dempers added.

Dempers pointed out that nobody sustained life-threatening injuries. "Trauma Rescue would like to thank all the role players helped to stabilise and transport the injured victims to the hospitals," he said. Rustenburg SAPS members were also at the scene while personnel from the Rustenburg traffic department controlled the flow of traffic.
