Rustenburg dagga raid exposes dark side of cannabis legalisation

The crime combatting operation led to the confiscation of dagga plants and other products valued at almost R1, million.

as general praise of the 'wonder herb' continues to gain popularity and acceptance. While the use of cannabis prevailingly enters a more harmless and beneficial light, it is important to note that it remains a popular ingredient in the cocktail street drug 'nyaope'. On Friday 23 June 2023 a crime combatting operation by the Rustenburg Crime Intelligence, Phokeng, Harbeespoort Dam K9 units, as well as the Brits Crime Combating Unit (CCU) resulted in the discovery of a dagga cultivation plant and laboratory at a plot in Mooinooi near Brits. Dagga plants in various stages of cultivation and other products with an estimated street value of R760,000 were confiscated. Such large-scale operations highlight an underlying issue as they enable the use of nyaope, which is on the rise... Read more on page 5.

SAPS SUCCE

NW - The North West Police activated a 'high-density operation' from 22 to 25 Jun3 2023, resulting in 255 arrests.

The suspects were nabbed for murder, assault with the intent to do grievous bodily harm (GBH), common assault, driving under the influence of alcohol, illegal dealing in liquor, burglaries at residential and business premises, dealing in drugs, carjacking, and the possession of counterfeit goods. In one of the local success stories, a Nissan NP 300 (which was stolen earlier this month in Rustenburg) was traced

and found abandoned on Friday afternoon, 23 June 2023. However, the suspect is still at large.

The provincial police commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwena said that provincial management will continue to redirect resources and intensify operations in hotspots.

ROAD IN HAZARDOUS DISREPAIR

Rustenburg - Platinum Weekly received complaints on Friday 23 June 2023, that Boven Crescent has been neglected for an unreasonable amount of time, even though residents have reported the poor conditions of the road to the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) on several occasions. On Monday 26 June 2023, AfriForum's Marico district coordinator, Armand Viljoen, also sent a letter addressed to the RLM, detailing alleged previous incidents plaguing Boven Crescent; including:

- 1. Persistent experiences of damaged power lines, burst water pipes, crumbling road infrastructure, and instances of sewage leakage into residents' yards.
- 2. In November 2022, a truck transporting chrome accidentally drove into a pothole (which almost looks like a sinkhole!) in Boven Crescent. This incident was promptly reported to the RLM, and the necessary steps were taken to extract the truck, requiring the removal of approximately four tonnes of chrome from the truck. The extracted chrome was subsequently utilised to fill the sinkhole.
- 3. In December 2022, a severe storm struck Rustenburg, resulting in heavy rainfall and subsequent further damage to road infrastructure. As a result, numerous sinkholes and potholes have formed along the street, posing a significant risk to residents and motorists.

The state of disrepair has escalated from unsafe to almost impossible! Platinum Weekly also reached out to the RLM for comment, but at the time of going to print, no feedback was received.

SCAMMED AND LEFT SEARCHING FOR A NEEDLE IN A HAYSTACK

Rustenburg – A scammed individual relayed his unfortunate encounter with trickery on Wednesday 14 June 2023 to *Platinum* Weekly. The alleged scammer is active on Facebook where the culprit advertises hay bales at an attractively affordable price. When the victim attempted to use the scammer's banking details to pay for his order of hay bales, the banking details were not accepted. The scammer then directed the victim to make a cellphone payment. After the payment was made communication was lost with the scammer and no delivery was made. "At first, I wanted to make a larger purchase, but because I wanted to test the quality of the bales I opted for a smaller purchase," said the

victim, "This is fortunate or else I would have lost a lot of money." When making online purchases, especially on Facebook, it is important to exercise the following:

- 1. Check the seller's Facebook page to learn more about them; if the page doesn't have a track of history, and is newly created, then it is important to proceed with caution.
- 2. Check if pictures of the products are genuine and original.
- 3. Never deviate from agreed payment methods, there must be a valid reason for a sudden change.
- 4. Trust your instinct, if it feels too good to be true, chances are it probably is!





- If your power goes off during the day without reason, don't immediately go outside to inspect your power box; try to get help from outside and/or inspect with another person.
- If you notice that a tap is running in your yard, don't inspect without caution—taps don't open by themselves.
- If someone claims to be injured or calls for help at your gate, don't open access. Instead, contact the necessary emergency services such as SAPS or an ambulance.
- · If a police vehicle arrives at your premises for no apparent reason, do not be overly trusting. Contact SAPS to confirm the vehicle's details.
- Don't rush to the scene if your car's alarm goes off. Try and inspect the situation from a safe distance and alert authorities if you witness attempted theft. Sounding a car's alarm is a clever tactic used by culprits to get you into a closer proximity with them-making theft easier.
- Be vigilant of strangers who frequently linger close to your premises for long periods of time. One incident reported a motorist who was allegedly 'working on his car' outside a premises. It is suspected that he was keeping watch over the premises/assessing the occupants by pretending to fix something on his car's engine. As soon as assistance was offered, the motorist made a 'quick fix' and drove off.
- Equip yourself with all emergency numbers, including your local policing forum.
- If your kids are walking home from school, or are being dropped off at a public location, try and arrange for them to travel with a friend, and collect them from their drop off spot
- Educate your children not to linger and not to occupy themselves on their cellphones while walking home, as this makes them easy targets.



FROM 'WONDER HERB' TO NYAOPE NIGHTMARE

Rustenburg – As views on cannabis are becoming increasingly relaxed, some might not bat an eye at the news of the latest dagga bust. While nyaope. a mixture of low-grade heroin, cannabis products, antiretroviral drugs, and other harmful ingredients has become increasingly accessible and prevalent in our communities. Every day nyaope has a detrimental effect on the lives of our youngsters, destroying lives at the same rate the drug is being distributed on our streets. As a favoured additive to the nyaope mixture, one should question, just how accepting should we be of cannabis as the new 'wonder herb'? On Friday 23 June 2023 a crime combatting operation conducted by the Rustenburg Crime Intelligence, Phokeng, and Hartbeespoort Dam K9 units, as well as the Brits Crime Combatting Unit (CCU) discovered a dagga cultivation plant and laboratory at a plot in Mooinooi near Brits. Dagga plants in various stages of cultivation and other products with an estimated street value of R760,000 were confiscated.

"The members of the crime combatting operation successfully applied for a search and seizure warrant and found a 36-year-old man upon arrival at the plot. The man [allegedly] confirmed that he was renting the place. Upon conducting a search, the police discovered a dagga cultivation warehouse consisting of several rooms. Aside from the confiscated dagga, the team seized 18 lights, 11 fans, a battery, two gas bottles, an air conditioner, chemicals, two machines, a laptop, and a cellphone. An Investigation into the matter by the Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation (DPCI) is underway. The provincial police commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwena lauded all the units involved and indicated that the police will continue to rid communities of drugs through arrests like this one": South African Police Service (SAPS) press release extracts, 24 June 2023.

The suspect, Ferdie Versfeld (36) appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court on 26 June 2023 where his case was postponed to 3 July for a formal bail application.

This discovery serves well to highlight the growing issue of *nyaope* which, aside from death, presents serious health issues such as hepatitis, HIV, abscesses, venous sclerosis, and bacterial/fungal endocarditis—to name but a few.

In an interview with Platinum Weekly on Tuesday 27 June 2023, Hope Hill Centre addiction counsellor Mxolisi Sithole said: "Nyaope is a white or brown powder mixture which gradually builds the user's dependence. At first, users don't suffer withdrawals, but as the use of it increases, the drug gains a negative mental, physical, and spiritual hold over its users. It creates a high that takes you down. Nyaope addiction is growing at large, not only among the youth, but also among adults. What's important to note is that dagga is not only a common ingredient in the mixture; the use of dagga on its own also increases the chances of a person using *nyaope* as a means to getting a stronger high. Nyaope rehabilitation is especially difficult as it's not easy to go through the withdrawals. The drug only remains in the system for four hours, which means that you need a frequent fix. Withdrawals are also painful as they are accompanied by unbearable stomach cramps." On 28 February 2023 the National Assembly

granted permission to the Portfolio Committee on Justice and Correctional Services to inquire into extending the subject of the Cannabis for Private Purposes Bill. The committee opened the proposed amendments to the bill for public comment, which closed on Friday 28 April 2023.

The proposed amendments seek to broaden the scope of the bill to include provisions relating to the commercialisation of hemp, the use of cannabis, and its production. The new bill also aims to address loopholes and grey areas within the current legislative framework surrounding cannabis.

Current laws allow for cannabis use and cultivation in private spaces within measure, but the definition of a 'private space' is vague as there is confusion regarding whether spaces like homes and cars qualify as 'private' and therefore allow for cannabis use and cultivation.

The bill further aims to allow for the cultivation and possession of a prescribed quantity of cannabis plants. While the new cannabis bill, if efficiently regulated, has the potential to broaden the industry and allow for businesses to take advantage of the growing popularity of cannabis products, addiction to *nyaope* is boosted when regulations around cannabis become less stringent.



The community must check the daily Fire Danger Index (FDI) when considering applying for a permit to start burning. The FDI can be found on the GRFPA's website or Facebook page and consists of five colour coded categories which indicates the level of danger and the associated prevention and preparation measures. The end-date of the hazardous fire season is dependent rainfall, which should measure 30mm, and indicates the end of the dry season and the decline of fire risks.



- · 2 kg Beef tripe
- 1 x Onion
- · 2 x Tablespoons olive oil
- · 1 x Tablespoon of Rajah curry powder
- 1 x Tablespoon of crushed garlic
- · 2 x Cubes of beef stock

Method:

- 1. Boil the beef tripe in water for one hour and thirty minutes until it's soft, then separate the tripe from the water. Put the tripe and the water aside in separate containers.
- 2. Fry the onion, garlic, and curry powder together with the olive oil.


