## PANGOLIN POACHING: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...

the declining population of the Temminck's pangolin, Platinum Weekly reached out to wildlife rehabilitation specialist and African Pangolin Working Group co-chairperson Nicci Wright on Tuesday 11 July.

"There are four pangolin species in Africa. The African species are the vulnerable, black-bellied pangolin tetradactyla) the endangered, whitebellied pangolin (Phataginus tricuspis), the endangered giant ground pangolin (Smutsia gigantea), and the Temminck's pangolin (Smutsia temminckii) which also currently has a vulnerable status," said Wright, "The Temminck's pangolin is the most commonly poached species in South Africa. This means that their numbers are definitely declining."

Adding to the poaching issue, four suspects appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Friday 7 July 2023 for possession of two dead pangolins.

The suspects' court appearance emanated from their arrest during a Crime Intelligence driven operation on Tuesday afternoon operationalised information which they received regarding four men who were seen trying to sell two dead pangolins. The police reacted swiftly and the four suspects who were in possession of the of Wagpos in Brits. The pangolins were

Rustenburg/Brits – To raise awareness on found inside plastic bags and the suspects were all arrested. They were charged with possession of endangered species which is in contravention of the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, (NEMBA), 2004 (Act No. 10 of 2004). "The suspects, Morewell Mpofu (34),

Simon Gwenzi (26), Phineas Mchuma (46) (Phataginus and Taurai Zhou (35) were remanded in custody for further investigation. They are expected to appear again before the same court on Friday 14 July 2023. Investigation into the matter continues," said police spokesperson captain Sam Tselanyane.

Although factors such as international trade, habitat loss, road mortalities, and electrified fences all play a role in pangolin fatalities, domestic trade poses the largest threat to African pangolins at present. According to the African Pangolin Working Group: "All four African pangolin species are widely used in traditional medicines. There are cultures who believe that pangolins are a great gift to be bestowed upon a person of authority. Another belief is that a pangolin seen during the day indicates an oncoming 4 July. Brits Trio Task Team members drought, and that the only way to avoid the drought is to sacrifice the pangolin next to a river. While other cultures use pangolin fat to ward off evil spirits and believe that carrying a vial of pangolin blood or scale will protect you from danger. Additionally, pangolins were cornered in the vicinity some cultures also use pangolin meat as a delicacy which is served to dignitaries."

What should be noted is that there is no scientific foundation to any of these beliefs. To make matters worse, the eradication of pangolins was also spurred by the unproven notion that the mammal contributed to the start of COVID-19. When asked if there are certain hot spots

for the sale of pangolins, Wright answered that areas constantly shift, and routes change as poachers are arrested. "Pangolins deserve our urgent protection

because they are becoming extinct on our watch. Help us do something about it!" Wright said. As stewards of the planet, it is within our

responsibility to not indulge the pangolin trade and to report pangolin poaching-

The stats indicate that the Bojanala district recorded a total of 41% of the crime for the entire North West province, while Rustenburg's crime escalated by 10.3%. For the quarter, Tlhabane and Phokeng reported 1,180 crime incidents. It was for this reason that MEC Lehari led the anticrime imbizo. "What worries me more, is the ever-rising figures of robberies, car hijackings, residential robberies, domestic violence, and gender-based violence," he said.

"Disturbingly, the number of sexual-related crimes and incidents of child neglect and ill-treatment are on the increase. We implore the communities to act responsibly and report all incidents that contravene any law of the country." MEC Lehari reiterated. "Most of the crime incidents seemingly emanate from alcohol-selling premises like taverns and often both victim and perpetrator know each other."

## Water crisis in Rustenburg persists

Rustenburg - Access to clean, potable water remains an uphill battle in Rustenburg – especially in previously disadvantaged areas. Areas that are mostly affected by water shortages in Rustenburg, include Rustenburg North, Zinnaville, Karlien Park, Serlang, Nkandla, Tlhabane West, Boitekong, Sunrise Park and Geelhout Park. And while many concerned residents, business owners and associations raised complaints with several government institutions, including the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM), Office of the Premier, Department of Water and Sanitation, Rand Water, Water and Sanitation Services South Africa (WSSA), and Magalies Water... the waves they made is a mere drop in the bucket.

This persisting issue is a multi-faceted challenge with no single, easy solution. From poor infrastructure, no/ little maintenance, and lack of planning for development are but a few of the challenges landing the government in hot water. But that still leaves residents in bad waters.

The water shortages in Rustenburg are going from bad to worse and we will continue to experience water shortages for the foreseeable future," said Zinniaville Ratepayers Association chairman Shuaib Bham in an interview with Platinum Weekly newspaper.

In a letter from the Zinniaville Ratepayers Association, addressed to the office of the Minister of Water and Sanitation, honourable Senzo Mchunu on 4 July 2023, they listed a number of days in which Karlien Park and Zinniaville were left without water:

- June 2022 5 days
- November 2022 9 days
   April 2023 5 days
- July 2022 9 days August 2022 – 25 days
- December 2022 27 days
   May 2023 9 days January 2023 – 21 days
   June 2023 – 27 days
- September 2022 9 days
  October 2022 14 days

   February 2023 24 days
   March 2023 15 days

That amounts to a staggering 199 days without water, from June 2022 up to June 2023. The complaint to the minister was not a first, and will most definitely not be the last. Yet, all past complaints are water under the bridge - but what about our future? "We humbly request that immediate steps be undertaken to remedy the situation," adds Bham.

#### **Rand Water to implement planned maintenance**

Rand Water will implement a planned maintenance to tie-in two valves between the A19 and B14 Pipelines. The planned maintenance will be undertaken to replace multiple valves at the Vereeniging Water Treatment Plant, Eikenhof Booster Pumping Station and Zuikerbosch Water Treatment Plant. The last part of the project will be work on electrical boards at Lethabo Pumping Station. This project forms part of Rand Water's maintenance strategy that focuses on proactive refurbishment and upgrading of its infrastructure to ensure future sustainability. The 58-hour project will commence from 19:00 on Tuesday, 11 July 2023 until 05:00 on Friday, 14 July 2023. Some residents within the Rustenburg Local Municipality, Mogale City Local Municipality and the Rand West Local Municipality will experience intermittent water supply during the implementation of the project. 




