# Fire causes more than R100 million damage

**Koster** - Eagles Pride Hatchery (Pty) Ltd (Eagles Pride Hatchery) is part of the Kuipers Group (Pty) Ltd (Kuipers Group) which mainly operates in the poultry industry (commercial eggs, broiler, and poultry feed). Eagles Pride Hatchery operates mainly in the broiler poultry division of Kuipers Group. Eagles Pride Hatchery have various hatcheries, including one which is situated approximately 7 km from Koster on the R509 towards Swartruggens.

On Saturday 29 July 2023, at around 06:30 am the security at the Eagles Pride Hatchery Koster operation noticed smoke coming from one of two hatcheries at the facility. The security immediately informed the management of the hatchery. This occurred during a time at which staff were coming on duty. Upon investigation, it was noticed that a fire was burning in the hatchery and all employees were immediately evacuated from both hatcheries. According to Kuipers Group chief executive officer Charles Le Maitré the exact cause and origin of the fire has not yet been determined. At this stage, it is believed that an electrical shortage might have caused the fire.

"The management team contacted the Kgetlengriver Local Municipality (KLM) to request the fire department to assist with the fire. The management were told that all the fire trucks were sent in for service and were not operational. This fire department could therefore not assist. KLM phoned back and informed management that had

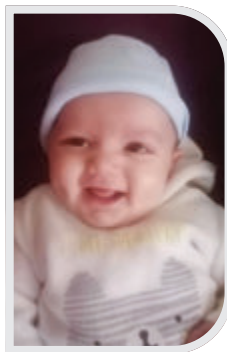
requested the Rustenburg Local Municipality's (RLM) fire department to assist with the fire. It is unknown to us as to why all fire trucks were sent in for service and were not operational, especially during winter months with increased fire hazards. KLM is less than a 10 minutes' drive from the Eagles Pride Hatchery near Koster, and we believe that if they could have responded, the damage to property would have been minimum. With the quick thinking of management and employees on site, the building link between the two hatcheries and office block were demolished to prevent the fire from spreading further to the second hatchery. When the fire started, it was posted on all emergency WhatsApp groups in the area, including Rustenburg, Lindleyspoort and Swartruggens. The first responders attending to the fire were the Koster Eagles Pride Hatchery employees who formed part of trained firefighting teams. Additional firefighting equipment and manpower was also dispatched from other Eagles Pride Hatcheries and Kuipers Group facilities. The Rustenburg Fire Department arrived at around 08:30 on the scene, but by this time most of the damage was already done and the fire had almost burnt out. They left the scene around 14:00 after they were satisfied that the fire was fully extinguished and posed no further threat. The Rustenburg Fire Department was extremely professional, and their assistance was greatly appreciated by all. We are extremely grateful and

humble to our employees, neighbours, farmers in the area, and the Koster community, as well as efforts and assistance from members of the local Kgetlengriver Fire Association and Lindleyspoort Fire Association for their time, equipment and selfless conduct while assisting us on Saturday to contain the fire. The damage to the one hatchery, egg room, and packaging room, are extensive

and will need to be demolished in total. The value of the damage to the hatchery, including losses of fertilised eggs and packaging are estimated to be more than R100 million. Two employees sustained minor injuries later during the day while clearing debris, and no employee needed medical assistance or treatment. We are grateful that no major injuries occurred," said Le Maitré.

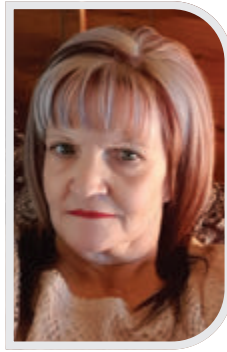

## PEDESTRIAN FATALITY ON THE N4

**Rustenburg** – A pedestrian fatality occurred on the N4 highway at approximately 07:30 on Monday 31 July 2023. “This occurred on the N4 highway from Rustenburg’s direction towards Mooniooi just the old Marikana bridge,” said Anton’s Towing driver Buks van Jaarsveld, “The pedestrian was hit by a Mercedes Benz, and unfortunately died on impact, however the driver of the vehicle did pull over after the tragic accident.” Van Jaarsveld added that the traffic department and the Marikana police swiftly responded to the scene. Motorists are urged to be extra vigilant when using the busy N4 highway which pedestrians try to cross at all hours of the day.

## DOG TRADERS BECOME VIOLENT

**Rustenburg** – On Friday 28 July a lady who works at a business near the corner of Brink and Kloppe Street witnessed a couple of men who were in possession of a Yorkie. The lady noticed that the dog was being treated poorly and took the dog from the men. The lady then took the dog to a nearby veterinarian to check whether it was chipped to determine ownership. Upon her return, the men started harassing her as they demanded money for the dog. The harassment continued throughout the day at her workspace, and escalated to the point where she could not enter her vehicle at the time of going home. The matter was reported to a local CPF group, and a female CPF member responded to help the lady. Upon her arrival, the CPF member was also physically intimidated by the group, however, she bravely stood her ground in her attempt to help the lady. Another onlooker proceeded to pay the men the R100 they demanded for the dog, and a second CPF member arrived to disperse the altercation. Although the person who paid the R100 probably meant well and intended to stop the violent scene—as it was located nearby a school—it should be noted that people should not purchase/pay street vendors who sell dogs. Incidents of street vendors selling dogs frequently occur, and in most cases the dogs have been stolen. By purchasing the dog, one is only escalating the problem. Information received indicated that the dog is currently in a safe space, and it has been assessed by a veterinarian. According to SAPS, this is not currently a rising issue, however, this could also be because people don’t always report such incidents. Together, we can protect our community and its innocent animals.

## POWER OUTAGE DUE TO FIRE AT SUBSTATION

**Rustenburg** – The Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) notified residents of Rustenburg and surrounding communities of the emergency power interruption following the fire outbreak around the Eskom substation in the industrial area on Saturday 29 July 2023. As a precautionary measure, Eskom switched off power to prevent potential damage to the power station. According to information received, tar poles nearby the station had caught fire, but at the time of going to print, the cause of the fire was not yet publicised. The technical team and Rustenburg Emergency and Fire Department were on site with the support of emergency services from Bojanala District Municipality and Royal Bafokeng to extinguish the blaze and manage the situation.

**IMPALA RUSTENBURG INTENTION TO DEVELOP A SOLAR ENERGY PLANT**

**ARMED ROBBERIES ON THE INCREASE**

**Rustenburg** - Rustenburg SAPS confirmed on Wednesday 2 August that armed robberies are on the increase in the following areas:

1. The Zinnaville railway line/crossing where vehicles are passing from Zinnaville to Tlhabane and Rustenburg North.
2. The Railway crossing between Yizo Yizo, Oukasie, and Bothibelelo Flats.
3. Lebone Street near Yizo Yizo.
4. Rabaji Street and surroundings.
5. Zinnaville, including Zinnaville Shopping Complex.

“The above areas are our hotspots for robberies. Security officers are attacked at their guard houses while guarding businesses and get robbed of their belongings. Three unknown armed men are operating in the above-mentioned areas. It has been mentioned in five of the cases this far that the suspects were speaking Sesotho and Zulu,” said Tlhabane station commander colonel David Moagi.

The Tlhabane SAPS have established a task team led by colonel Moagi and intensified its patrols and stop searches in and around these areas. Anyone with information may directly contact colonel Moagi on 082 416 1337.

**IN CUSTODY FOR POSSESSION OF STOLEN PROPERTY**

**Brits** - Amos Matlhodi (27) and Isaac Dube (19) were remanded in custody after they appeared before the Brits Magistrate's Court on Friday 28 July 2023 for possession of stolen property. They are expected to again appear in the same court on Friday 4 August 2023 for legal aid.

The accused were arrested during an intelligence driven operation by the Brits Trio Task Team after information regarding business robberies in Mmakau was received.

“The first arrest was made after one of the suspects was spotted at his place in Ramogodi Village on 26 July. A search conducted at the suspect's place resulted in the recovery of goods such as cigarettes, coins, different bath soaps, a welding machine, gloves, and other items.

Further investigation into the matter led the team to the second suspect's place where similar items and a pickaxe were confiscated,” said police spokesperson captain Aafje Botma.

The district commissioner of Bojanala Platinum sub-district one, commissioner major general Modisagaarekwe Mosimanegape, has lauded the task team members for a sterling job.

### KEY INITIATIVES FOR 2023/24

Provincial Treasury in collaboration with National Treasury will enhance the Infrastructure Reporting Model through the rollout of the Infrastructure Delivery Management System (IDMS) Helpdesk to all provincial infrastructure departments.

Through the Office of the Provincial Accountant General, we shall continue to provide financial management oversight and support to all departments and public entities on accounting, audit, risk management, reviewing of financial statements and monitoring of the post audit action plans for improved audit outcomes.

With regard to Provincial Internal Audit, focused audit work will again be performed on the adequacy and effectiveness of risk management and post audit action plan systems. These two (2) systems remain central for the improvement in service delivery and clean administration in the Province. Provincial Internal Audit will also perform assessments of combined assurance systems.

In our quest to empower Provincial Departments and their Entities with the implementation of the new Preferential Procurement Regulation (PPR 22), Provincial Treasury is embarking on intensive training of all Bid Committees (both Provincial Departments and their Entities). The training program will be rolled out in the beginning of the second quarter of 2023/2024 financial year.

In recognition of our young people being at the core of our developmental agenda, the department will be hosting a Youth Summit for learners from rural areas across the province to educate and expose them to career opportunities available in the finance and commerce sectors.

### PROVINCIAL SOCIO-ECONOMIC OUTLOOK

The Province is experiencing sluggish growth and high unemployment. The provincial GDP growth has averaged 1.0 per cent for the years from 2018 to 2021 which is a far cry from the 6.0 per cent growth targeted by the National Development Plan (NDP).

### DEPARTMENTAL OWN REVENUE

One of the critical functions of the Department is to ensure equitable distribution and allocation of resources to departments in line with national and provincial fiscal policy plans. The Provincial Treasury contribution towards provincial own revenue target of R1.2 billion for 2023, is R195 million.

### REFLECTIONS ON THE 2022/23 FINANCIAL YEAR

The Provincial Executive Representatives (PER's) and Provincial Municipal Financial Recovery Services (MFRS) teams have been deployed to municipalities to assist with the implementation of Interim Rescue Plans and development of the Financial Recovery Plans.

## BUDGET VOTE AND POLICY SPEECH

### H I G H L I G H T S

North West Premier Kaobitsa Bushy Maape tabled the 2023/24 Office of the Premier Budget Vote and Policy Speech before the North West Provincial Legislature on Thursday, 01 June 2023 where he reflected on achievements recorded in the previous financial year and plans to strengthen state capacity in the current financial year.

#### PROCUREMENT AND SUPPORT TO LOCAL BUSINESSES

The Office of the Premier has approved an internal Preferential Procurement Policy that guides strategic sourcing during the year under review. We understand the importance of supporting small and emerging businesses in our communities and are committed to creating equal economic opportunities for all. We remain committed to procurement expenditure spending on set targets for women, youth, and people with disabilities.

#### WOMEN, YOUTH AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

For the current financial year, the Office of the Premier will increase spending on Women, Youth and People with Disabilities to an amount of R29.6 million, which is more than the threshold of 25% of the designated groups. We will also continue to pay special attention to the socio-economic conditions of military veterans, older persons, and liberation struggle stalwarts.

#### ADDRESSING YOUTH DEVELOPMENT AND SKILLS

During the month of June, the Office will lead major initiatives working with various SETAs to fund critical skills development initiatives by the province. We are in discussions with MERSETA to fund training of youth in the installation of solar panels. We will further use the SETAs to train engineers for local municipalities. We are targeting at least more

than 3000 young people for these programmes. In addition, some of these initiatives will include funding student bursaries and assistance to some students with payment of outstanding debts.

#### STRENGTHENING THE CAPACITY OF THE STATE

In an effort to promote policy coherence and integrated planning across government, the Office of the Premier will continue to assess the Annual Performance Plans of Departments to ensure they are aligned and responsive to service delivery needs of our people. Departments have also been directed to reduce current vacancy rate in the provincial administration including other state entities, by filling posts required for service delivery and opening entry level positions for unemployed graduates.

#### FIGHT AGAINST CORRUPTION & STRENGTHENING ACCOUNTABILITY

We have designed a Provincial Geographic Information system (web-based application) which is triggered by the District Development Model approach, as it will be able to collect and store demographic and district profiles. Communities of the province will be able to raise and report service delivery challenges through this web application. This work will be linked to our commitment to establish a command centre to monitor service delivery challenges.

As the provincial government we want to embed our anti-corruption strategy and campaigns in communities in order to build a critical mass of stakeholders who will work with government to rid our province of this cancer of corruption. Office of the Premier will initiate a series of consultation meetings with the Traditional Leadership, the mining sector, faith-based organisations, and government departments to participate in the implementation of the strategy in this financial year 2023/24.

#### SUPPORT TO OUR MUNICIPALITIES

We have refined and revised a performance reporting tool which will be used to monitor and measure the performance of municipalities. The Premier has established an oversight committee comprising of the MECs of COGHSTA and Provincial Treasury, which meet regularly with the Auditor General to discuss post audit plans of municipalities.

#### WATER PROVISION PLANS

In our quest to address the water challenges in the province, we have established the provincial steering committee co-chaired by the Premier and the Minister of Water and Sanitation. The steering committee has finalised a provincial plan to address water challenges in the following identified "water hotspots areas", which are Ditsobotla, Tswaing, Ramotshere Moiloa, Naledi, Mamusa, Maquasi Hills and City of Matlosana

Local Municipalities. We will soon be launching operation "Bulela Metsi" in these areas.

#### IMPROVING CONNECTIVITY AND ICT GOVERNANCE

Office of the Premier has started the network modernisation programme in collaboration with the Department of Arts, Culture, Sports and Recreation (ACSR). The programme is intended to provide internet services to one-hundred and twenty-three (123) libraries across the province, allowing communities to access the internet in the libraries.

#### IMPROVING COMMUNICATING THE WORK OF GOVERNMENT

We are improving our communications to keep our communities informed about the work of government. For this financial year, the Executive Council supported by the Office of the Premier will hold regular media briefings to inform the public on EXCO decisions on various programmes and projects.

#### MORAL REGENERATION AND SOCIAL COHESION

We plan to convene District Moral Regeneration festivals across all the four Districts with focus on fighting teenage pregnancy, gangsterism, drug and substance abuse as well as gender-based violence and femicide. We will also strengthen our partnership with religious formations and where practical have joint developmental programmes.

## Celebrating 10 years of shared value

As Sibanye-Stillwater celebrates its 10-year anniversary, it is the support of its stakeholders that is a mark of this great milestone.

Our commitment to the socio-economic growth of communities surrounding our operations and labour sending areas is evident through the jobs we have created and continue to sustain, our contribution to taxes and royalties, socio-economic development programmes, skills development and opportunities for local businesses.

By the end of 2022, we had invested R1,097 million in SLP projects and R67.7 million in CSR initiatives. Over the past decade, our spending on socio-economic development and corporate social investment has grown from just over R1 billion in 2013 to more than R2.2 billion in 2022.

As one of South Africa's largest employers, Sibanye-Stillwater has grown from employing over 36,000 people, including contractors, in 2013 to approximately 85,000 globally in 2022 while salaries and benefits have increased from R6.15 billion to R26 billion per annum over that time.

## Building her way to success

**Ofentse Lekalala, originally from Bapong, is a powerhouse with a driving ambition to make a success of her company while helping members of her community in the process.**

Ofentse started her career in the HR department at Anglo American (now Sibanye-Stillwater) in 2008. In 2012, during the unrest, she joined Lonmin as an HR Manager.

She felt the call "as a black child, and as a child of the soil" to resign to free herself up to serve her community more.

With management's full support, she launched her company, Golaatswe Mining Services. "That's when I started the hustle. It's easy to dream big dreams when you get a salary at the end of each month, but once you need to start building a company, things get a bit more real," she said. However, with grit, hard work and determination, her company has grown from one boiler maker at the Sibanye-Stillwater plant to now having over 200 employees within the Group.

Her business model focuses on employing highly skilled people who previously worked in the mines to train the next generation to be absorbed by the mine. She refers to this as "an informal feeding channel" for the mine.

She also ensures that her employees complete their N-courses and obtain their trade certificates. She attributes part of her success to the assistance provided by Sibanye-Stillwater through an extensive

development programme called Shanduka Black Umbrella. Today, Golaatswe is predominantly an engineering maintenance company that supplies labour to the mine for steel fabrication, fitting and turning, electrical work, and instrumentation work. As a Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) 8-graded company, it does large construction projects for the mine. The name, Golaatswe, means "it is commanded" and refers to her life's purpose as she

believes "It is commanded that I will be whatever I need to be".

Her name, Ofentse, also means a conqueror, and, she says, it indicates the strength she has needed to exhibit being a woman in a male-dominated field. She says, "Win or lose, it's going to happen". Ofentse is most passionate about how she can change people's lives and make the underdog a hero.

## Early warning systems in case of tailings storage facilities emergencies



Early warning of an emergency can prevent it from escalating into a disaster that will cost lives, destroy infrastructure, and damage the environment.

Therefore, Sibanye-Stillwater has installed warning sirens in strategic places within the community where it can be audible to all affected community members, should an emergency arise, and evacuation is required.

In case of a tailings dam emergency, assembly points have been identified within the community by our Engineers of Record analysis where it will be safe to gather.

**NOTE: The details of the assembly points will be shared in due course.**



### THE SIREN SOUND:

**For a tailings dam emergency, an alarm will be heard within the community with alternating sounds (7 second on and 7 second off)**

#### What to do when you hear the sound of the evacuation siren?

- Try to stay calm
- Stop what you are doing
- Start walking quickly and calmly to the closest assembly point (as identified by Sibanye-Stillwater)
- Assist any person, but only if safe to do so
- Once you arrive at the community assembly point – wait for further instructions from the Disaster Management personnel

#### What should you NOT do if you hear the evacuation siren sound?

- Do not ignore the siren
- Do not panic
- Do not run
- Do not stop to take videos or photos
- Do not return to your home to collect personal belongings
- Do not push once at the assembly point

#### Will Sibanye-Stillwater provide aid in case of a disaster?

Sibanye-Stillwater has signed an agreement with Gift of the Givers to provide humanitarian and relief support in case of any tailings emergencies due to poor pool control leading to seepages as well as natural disasters.

The safety of our communities, well-being of our surrounding environment and protection of infrastructure are important to Sibanye-Stillwater.

## Dialogue for social cohesion

As part of the Renewal Programme, regular Pitso (Imbizo) are being held within the framework facilitated by ReimagineSA. These multistakeholder dialogues are designed to encourage information sharing and problem-solving relating to the following themes: healing, socio-economic development, and land management.

The goal of the two-day Pitso, held in June, was to have conversations with a wide range of stakeholders about socio-economic development in the Bojanala District, focusing on six priority areas:

- Skills development and Education
- Food Security and Economic alternatives (township economies)

- Enterprise development
- Information and communication technology
- Productive infrastructure; and
- Community wellbeing.

Community members in attendance shared their views on how previous engagements with the Company had been one-directional, with people who do not reside in the communities dictating to people within these communities their wants and needs. This had been a significant frustration for many communities for some time. There was consensus reached at the Pitso that the Letsama process was a better way of engaging to drive community development

partnerships beyond compliance to SLPs.

To achieve this, community leaders and champions for development are open to exploring this different approach to engagement for the benefit of all stakeholders. There is an appreciation, though, that SLPs cannot cater to all community needs, hence the need to advance these discussions using a multistakeholder approach.

The Pitso has opened the door for ongoing conversations with specific focus areas that will enable unity of purpose with stakeholders.

## Step-by-step guide to complaints and grievance procedure

**STEP 1**

**Receive grievance/ complaints**

- Walk-ins: ESD Centres and CED Department offices
- Anonymous Hot-line
- Written: Letters, SMS and Email
- Third Party Referrals: South African Human Rights Commission, Local Councils, Municipal offices, Traditional Authority, Community Leaders, Non-Governmental Organisations/ Community Based Organisations and DURE.

**STEP 6**

**Feedback to complainant on outcome of investigation.**

- Feedback provided to Complainant in a setup that is most suitable to them such as a meeting, written letter or email or telephone feedback depending on the nature of complaint/grievance
- Feedback provided in a language preferred by the Complainant

**STEP 2**

**48 hours grievance/ complaint registered and acknowledged**

- Registration of grievance/ complaint into Issue Register/ IsoMetric
- Acknowledgement of Receipt to Complainant by CED Department in language and form of communication complainant is comfortable with.

**STEP 7**

**Grievance/ complaint resolved**

- CED Department to liaise with Complainant(s) if satisfied with outcome of investigation and response from the Business
- If Complainant(s) is/are satisfied with outcome of investigation the CED Department to capture the issue as resolved/ closed in Issue Register/ IsoMetric system

**STEP 3**

**48 hours internal review of grievance/ complaint**

- Assess nature of Grievance/ Complaint
- Allocation to relevant Business Unit/ Department

**STEP 8**

**Grievance/ complaint not resolved**

- If Complainant(s) is/are not satisfied with the outcome of the investigation, the issue will be captured as open on the Issue Register/ IsoMetric and escalated to the management representative responsible for the Business Unit
- The alternative step following failure to resolve the issue internally is to be referred to an Independent Mediator/ Facilitator such as the South African Human Rights Commission

**STEP 4**

**Depending on nature of grievance/ complaints, investigation process outlined Business Unit/ Department**

- CED Department to liaise with the Business Unit representative assigned to investigate the grievance/ complaint if additional information required from Complainant
- Business Unit representative assigned to the case to provide clear time frames of when the investigation will be completed

**STEP 9**

**Independent mediation/ facilitation**

- Following outcome of the mediation efforts, if the Complainant(s) is/are satisfied with outcome the issue will be captured as closed on the system and the recommendations implemented by Sibanye-Stillwater

**STEP 5**

**Investigation and fact finding**

- Investigation to commence led by Business Unit representative assigned to the case
- Business Unit Representative to provide outcome of investigation to CED, then CED to liaise with the Complainant to schedule a suitable time to give feedback on outcome of investigation

**STEP 10**

**Litigation**

- If Complainant(s) not satisfied with outcome with Independent Mediator/Facilitator they can exercise their right to approach the Courts to litigate against Sibanye-Stillwater

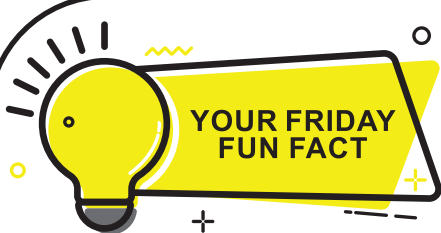

**Rustenburg** – Strong winds, a characteristic feature of the month of August, can cause destruction when they pick up embers which go on to cause fires.

We reached out to Debbie Snyman, Great Rustenburg Fire Protection Association chairperson, who shared the following information: In August, the strongest factor is wind. Fires need ignition, oxygen, and fuel (vegetative matter). In rural areas, careless actions like dropped cigarettes or unextinguished warming and cooking fires can lead to major fires, especially with the August winds' influence.

Fire breaks can slow down fires, and landowners should have these in place by now. No burning of breaks is allowed this time in the season, but landowners can continue to make breaks by slashing, ploughing, and scraping an area free of combustible vegetation.

Create a defensible space around homes and structures, keeping firefighting equipment on hand as required by law. Clear areas around cooking fires to prevent sparks from igniting vegetation. No open flames are allowed except in specially designed fire-safe areas.

Stay vigilant, day and night, monitor the wind, and collaborate with neighbours for fire safety.
