SA - Unaudited data from the Central Energy Fund (CEF) is pointing to fuel price hikes for all fuel grades in August dealing another blow for already cash-strapped South Africans, says the Automobile Association (AA). According to the data, petrol ULP95 will climb by around 35c a litre, and petrol 93ULP by around 30c/l. But it's the expected increases in diesel which are most concerning. "The data is showing diesel will increase by around 72c/l which will, effectively, mean consumers will have to pay more for goods and services down the line. Illuminating paraffin, too, is expected to increase - also by around 72c/l. These are all significant upwards adjustments which will impact all South Africans," says the AA. The data shows that the main driver behind the expected increases is international oil prices which escalated steadily throughout the month. Easing some of the pressure on fuel prices is the Rand which improved its value against the US Dollar throughout the month.

Faulty cable identified as Verassingdienste. the cause of power outage

Rustenburg - Many have speculated the reason for the power outage which occurred in Rustenburg on Friday 4 August 2023. An image of a broken-down pylon at the industry substation started circulating soon after the power went off at approximately 12:00, and thoughts ventured towards cable theft or vandalism. However, Democratic Alliance (DA) ward 18 councillor Cobus Nortje says, "The outage occurred because of a faulty 33 kV cable which runs between the industry substation and the northern substation. Eskom was on scene and attended to the matter. While the power in various areas was restored, other areas such as Oos Einde and Rustenburg CBD had to wait a little longer for the matter to be resolved. The broken-down pylon has been there for a while and did not relate to the outage"

A few weeks ago, I noticed a couple of teenage boys walking down my street with airguns. This got me thinking on the law surrounding airguns. Of course, in their defence, they hadn't discharged their guns, but I couldn't help but wonder, what would happen if a reckless youth were to fire such a gun and injure an innocent passerby? I did some reading, and I think it's important for parents to be informed

Firstly, let's start with the definition of an airgun

in terms of the law (Firearms Control Act 60 of 2000): "An airgun is any airgun with a calibre of below 5.6 mm regardless of power/ energy at the muzzle. An airgun is any airgun with a calibre of 5.6mm and above but is manufactured to be incapable of shooting at powers/energy of no more than 8 joules / 6 -foot pounds at the muzzle.

Any airgun that exceeds both the 5.6mm calibre and muzzle energy of 8 joules / 6-foot pounds is classified as a firearm in South Africa and in Platinum Weekly reached out to police terms of the Firearms Control Act (FCA) a firearms licence is required to own and operate such."

Although airguns do not require a firearms licence in South Africa, there are provisions in the FCA that treat the use and ownership of airguns in the same manner as firearms. According to the act, it is an

Discharge or otherwise handle a firearm, an antique firearm, or an airgun in a manner likely to injure or endanger the safety or property of any person or with reckless disregard for the safety or property of any person.

Have control of a loaded firearm, an antique firearm, or an airgun in circumstances where it creates a risk to the safety or property of

any person and not to take reasonable precautions to avoid the danger.

Point any firearm, an antique firearm, or an airgun, whether it is loaded or capable of being discharged, at any other

SISTER-IN-LAW CHARGED WITH MURDER

However, with the state firmly opposing her release, the hearing has been deferred to 14 August. The intricate tapestry of this investigation is still

being woven, with inquiries ongoing. Lieutenant General Sello Kwena, the North West provincial commissioner, has extended his commendation to the team and all parties involved in achieving this significant advancement

HEAD-ON CRASH, N4 CLAIMS A LIFE

Rustenburg - Two vehicles, a grey Chevrolet Aveo and a white Mercedes-Benz, collided head-on, on the N4 just outside Rustenburg (about 2 km from StayEasy Lodge) on Friday morning 4 August 2023 at approximately 07:00. Tragically, the driver of the Chevrolet died on the scene. The driver and four passengers in the Mercedes survived the ordeal.

Over the past two weeks, the N4 and its offramps have been plagued by regular accidents, raising concerns over road safety in the area. This tragic incident outside Rustenburg is yet another grim reminder of the need for heightened vigilance and caution while travelling on this route.

Rustenburg - Bring the aroma of homemade bread to your kitchen by baking fresh loaves of Nico Brits' favourite recipe — caramel bread! He was taught this recipe by his mother.

Ingredients:

- 500 ml heavy whipping cream
- · 2 cups caramel sugar
- · 2 ready-to-bake bags of dough (± 500g per bag)

- 1. Mix the caramel, sugar, and cream together.







Various food stalls will be available, which means that families can enjoy their dinner along with the entertainment and lights!


