ANOTHER SPIKING INCIDENT ON THE N4?

Rustenburg – Suspicions of deliberate sabotage are in the air following an incident on Wednesday 16 August 2023, near the Buffelspoort off-ramp on the N4 just outside Rustenburg.

Reports suggest that a stretch of the highway in both east-to-west and west-to-east directions was allegedly littered with spikes, posing a significant hazard to unsuspecting motorists.

However, Rustenburg police spokesperson, sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, clarified that no official report of such an incident has recently been filed in the Rustenburg region.

Motorists are urged to exercise heightened caution when traversing this route, underscoring the ongoing need for vigilant driving on our roads.



BRAZEN CASH-IN-TRANSIT HEISTS ROCK RUSTENBURG





In a second incident on the R510, the truck was ambushed by an unidentified group of suspects driving a white Peugeot vehicle.

Rustenburg/Phokeng - In a harrowing sequence of events, two cash-in-transit heists unfolded within days of each other, putting Rustenburg and surrounding police on high alert.

On the morning of Saturday 26 August 2023, near Orbit Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) College, chaos erupted. A grey Jeep unexpectedly rammed into a G4S security truck, while a Mercedes Benz rammed into the escort vehicle of the G4S truck. The Mercedes and the escort vehicle burst into flames almost instantly. In the midst of the turmoil, around 18 armed assailants fired shots to force the truck's occupants to abandon the vehicle. Although explosives were detonated to gain access to the truck, the trunks remarkably remained unopened. The criminals made off with loose coins and escaped in two Audi sedans. A highway patrol unit engaged in a gunfight with the suspects, resulting in damage to a state vehicle but thankfully no injuries.

Just two days later, on Monday 28 August 2023, another G4S truck was targeted on the R510 road between Tsitsing and Serutube villages. At approximately 5:15 pm, the truck was ambushed by suspects in a white Peugeot. Employing explosives, the culprits managed to severely damage the vehicle, before making a quick escape with an undisclosed amount of cash. "Fortunately, the G4S crew remained unharmed," said Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, who also mentioned the discovery of a burnt-out Mercedes Benz suspected to be linked to the criminals.

No arrests have been made in either incident and investigations are ongoing. These audacious acts have raised significant security concerns for cash-in-transit operations in the region, prompting calls for heightened security measures and a faster response from law enforcement agencies.

Illegal fishing nets in Olifantsnek Dam wreak havoc

Rustenburg - In a crucial joint operation stakeholders took significant steps to tackle the pressing issue of illegal fishing nets in Olifantsnek Dam. On Friday 25 August 2023, the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve applauded the teams involved, including members from the Olienhout Conservancy (Magaliesberg Landowner's Forum), Simon Netshithutuni of Biodiversity Compliance, and The Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation, and Tourism (DEDECT). They worked diligently to remove these damaging nets that have led to a decline in the fish population and ecosystem imbalance.

The use of illegal nets in the Olifantsnek Dam has surged recently, causing ecological havoc. Local fishermen have been alarmed by the dwindling fish population and called upon the authorities to take action. Fishermen have noticed a declining fish population at the dam for quite a while, and the team decided that it was time to act.

In just one day, three large nets ranging from 20 to 30 metres were pulled out, along with approximately 50 fish, most of which were already dead.







CONTRACTOR DIES IN DRAIN

Prison time for playground bullies?

Platinum Weekly is dishing out the scoop on developments relating to the Children's Act 38 of 2005, a law that is now used to take bullies to court. There's a bit of a buzz that bullies between 10 and 18 might end up doing a stretch behind bars if they're proven guilty. To get the real story, Platinum Weekly had a chat with Elmari Richter, from Van Velden-Duffey, on Tuesday 29 August 2023.

According to Richter various South African laws actively combat bullying, both directly and indirectly. For instance, the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa safeguards rights like dignity, equality, life, freedom, safety, and education. It also guarantees protection from violence, torture, and inhumane treatment. Special provisions shield children from maltreatment and abuse. The South African Schools Act also mandates public schools to establish learner codes of conduct that include anti-bullying measures and disciplinary may consequences. The Children's Act focuses on to upholding children's rights, ensuring their well- Imprisonment rounded development, and shielding them from harm. The Protection against Harassment Act empowers victims to seek interdicts against bullies for protection.

With bullying being on the increase and making headlines in South Africa, the Children's Act 38 of 2005 were dissected by the legal fraternity who is of the belief that this act allows for bullies to be dealt with more harshly and some attorneys have already started taking that route.

Richter says: "The Child Justice Act regulates the child justice system for all children in conflict with prison when they are the law. Children under 18 who committed a crime are not dealt with in terms of the standard criminal procedures used for adults. This Act distinguishes between three different age groups.

The Child Justice Act' categorisation of three distinct age groups:

- A child under the age of 10 years cannot be arrested or prosecuted! This means that a child under 10 years does not have criminal capacity and cannot be charged or arrested for an offence, which includes bullying.
- A child older than 10 years but below the ages of 14 years is presumed to lack criminal capacity unless the state proves that he/she has criminal

capacity. Such a child can thus only be arrested and prosecuted if the child is found to have the criminal capacity to understand his/her wrongdoing.

A child above 14, but under 18, is said to have criminal capacity and can be arrested and prosecuted. Children in this age group who are found guilty of an offence may be sent to a child and youth care centre to rehabilitate the child. Sending a child to prison for

bullying is highly improbable. "Rehabilitation of the children is the primary focus, rather than punishing the child their wrongdoing. The Child Justice Act stipulates that no child under the age of 14 be sentenced imprisonment.

children over the age of 14 can be considered but will be an absolute last resort and will only be applied in cases of severe criminal offenses," says

According to Richter, perpetrators will only serve their sentences in juvenile correctional above the age of 14

and if they are found guilty of a serious criminal offence. "I believe a child found guilty of bullying will not be sentenced to imprisonment unless the bullying results in a criminal offence, for example, assault with the intent to do grievous bodily harm,"

Richter says that the severity of the sentence is based on the severity of the offence. "The Minimum Sentence Act guides us. It provides a minimum sentence for each criminal offence," said Richter.

Richter recommends that parents/guardians of bullying victims engage with the school to facilitate disciplinary measures against the perpetrator. If bullying persists, obtaining a harassment interdict rehabilitation remains tricky territory.

can be pursued, as bullying often leads to abuse and harassment. In cases where bullying escalates to serious criminal offenses like assault murder rape, or sexual assault, the state may prosecute the perpetrator based on the child's age, leading to legal consequences.

Platinum Weekly interviewed local parents to get their opinions: "I reckon sending kids to prison for bullying is a bit over the top, to be honest. Sure, there's a lot in the mix, but we need to

think about what happens next. Imprisonment could mess with a kid's head even more, you know? And that could mess with their future," one parent chimed in.

> "I'm a bit on the fence about it " another parent said. "Bullies need to understand how serious it isbullying can really mess with kids. But we've got to think, bullies don't just inflict harm to act tough; there's often more going on inside that's driving them to hurt others, both emotionally

and physically." From an educator's perspective, Wynand Pieterse commented: teacher. dealing with bullying means being about forgiveness,

and helping kids grow. Locking them up doesn't fit the bill. Teaching, talking things through, and getting to the root problems are a must. Parents need to be in on it too-talking openly, backing up, and making sure they're responsible. What matters most is teaching, showing the way, and keeping things positive for everyone".

The issue of bullying and imprisonment remains a double-edged sword. Imprisonment might curb their actions and safeguard victims, yet the effects it could have on those guilty of bullying could be damaging on a multitude of levels. Thus, striking the right balance between punishment and

Upon closer inspection, the personnel discovered that the smoke was emanating from the top of a building near the Air Traffic Control Tower. Despite their quick attempts to put out the fire, the flames rapidly consumed the area. Within seconds, the thatched roof of the airport building collapsed, making their efforts to extinguish the fire futile. The structure was completely gutted by the fast-spreading flames.

Shortly after the onset of the blaze, both Sun City Fire Services and Rustenburg Fire Services arrived at the scene and took immediate action, but the structure had already suffered irreversible damage.

Head of the Department of Community Safety and Transport Management, MEC Sello Lehari, and acting department head Mpho Maleme promptly arrived at the devastated terminal. MEC Lehari ordered an immediate investigation, stating, "We would like to leave no stone unturned to ensure we get to the bottom of the

Fire strikes Gardenia Ave



Rustenburg - It was a peaceful evening on Monday 28 August 2023 as the clock neared 18:00, when a caravan beneath a carport became an unexpected focal point for residents in the neighbourhood of Gardenia Avenue, Protea Park. A flicker soon turned into a raging fire inside the caravan, raising alarm. Without wasting a heartbeat, people sprang into action to douse the flames. Kobus Myburgh, the tenant of the house where the fire broke out, shared details with Platinum Weekly newspaper: "Our water pressure is very low because our water pipe was stolen recently. It did not help much when we wanted to put out the fire," he expressed.

The fire crept to adjacent refrigerators and dishwashers, located next to the caravan. These appliances, bought by Myburgh with dreams of mending them for resale, were reduced to charred debris in no time. Adding to the nightmare, the blaze, showing no sign of retreat, lapped at the corner of his garage roof!

After relentless efforts, the fiery monster was finally tamed, and disaster was averted. Fortunately, no injuries were reported.

Kgaswane Mountain Reserve ravaged by wildfire

Rustenburg - On Saturday 26 August 2023, at approximately 13:30, a fire was reported by a neighbour outside the perimeter of Kgaswane Mountain Reserve near the Arnoldistad Circle on the R24. Within hours, the fire menacingly edged its way into the cherished reserve.

In an interview with Platinum Weekly, Kgaswane Mountain Reserve acting reserve manager Emelang Malefo said: "Originating from children reportedly playing with fire, the flames were fuelled by potent winds on that fateful Saturday afternoon and evening."

In response, the reserve immediately called upon the Greater Rustenburg Fire Protection Association, the Rustenburg Fire Department, and Working on

However, by 15:05, the fire had entered the reserve, prompting backburns to contain it to the southern part. The fire's trail of destruction spanned a staggering 515.36 hectares, impacting habitats and wildlife. While large mammals were agile enough to evade the inferno, smaller species like reptiles sought refuge in holes, open areas, and rocky outcrops. Regrettably, the slow-moving chameleons faced the brunt of the blaze.

Firefighting efforts involved blowers, beaters, and knapsack equipment, which, given the fierce conditions, proved ineffective on Saturday. The reserve's team and the Working on Fire crew then strategized a back-burn the following day, confining the fire to a single block. This strategy proved effective. Several private landowners also pitched in, utilising their firefighting equipment to counter the flames. However, the fire's intensity overpowered their initial efforts

Remarkably, amidst this challenging ordeal, no injuries were reported. The reserve's protocols ensured safety for all personnel involved.

Generous locals played their part, offering food parcels and beverages to the tireless firefighting crew throughout the weekend.

"It's essential to appreciate that wildfires, while devastating, are a natural occurrence in Kgaswane. The resilient wildlife has adapted over millennia to cope. That said, the recovery process demands caution from the public, particularly regarding rituals involving unattended candles, a factor leading to a disastrous fire in April 2023 that consumed 98.619 hectares of protected wetland," Malefo said.

Fires, while part of the natural ecosystem, demand respect and caution.

The aftermath of this wildfire underscores the delicate balance of nature and the cost of carelessness. The reserve stands resilient. anticipating the rejuvenation of its veld in the coming weeks. But the community's vigilance and support remain pivotal in ensuring the continued safety and prosperity of Kgaswane Mountain Reserve.



Hartbeespoort - Founded around fifteen years ago in 2008 by Danelle and Brendan Murray, Owl Rescue Centre is a registered non-profit company (NPC) dedicated to safeguarding the declining owl populations and vulnerable wildlife in South Africa. With their hearts set on conservation, the Murrays established the sanctuary in the rural expanse of Hartbeespoort, North West Province. Their mission goes beyond rescue and rehabilitation - it encompasses education, habitat preservation, and

The typical day at the centre is anything but routine. From dawn, the team dives into clinic duties, tending to all aspects of care from feeding to medical treatment. Rescue operations are meticulously planned, while over 3000-day-old chickens and available rats and mice are prepared for daily feeds.

Injured animals are first treated in the clinic, then moved to monitoring aviaries before being placed in release enclosures for their journey back to the

Owl Rescue Centre's efforts extend far beyond the borders of their sanctuary. Their network of over a hundred volunteers assists with rescues and care across South Africa. Permits are essential for handling, rehabilitating, and transporting wild animals, emphasising the importance of responsible and legal conservation.

The centre's challenges are varied. Changing perceptions and fostering respect for wildlife are among their core struggles. They work tirelessly to debunk superstitions and highlight the
