Draft Marriage Bill

A LEAP TOWARDS INCLUSIVITY OR A CONTROVERSIAL TURN?

complexities of modern marriage in a multicultural nation like South Africa is no small feat. The new Draft Marriage Bill of 2022 aims to make the process more inclusive, but it's sparking some intense debates. Is legitimising polygamous marriages a step too far? And is it even possible to create a 'one-size-fits-all' approach to matrimony

in a country so rich in diversity? On Wednesday 6 September 2023, Platinum what people really think.

The Department of Home Affairs recently published the Draft Marriage Bill of 2022 in 2023, inviting public opinion and comments their race, sex, gender, sexual orientation, or cultural beliefs.

The Bill offers promising regulations, especially in Chapter Two, which deals with the age of consent for marriage, stating unequivocally that anyone wishing to get married must be 18 years or older. This provision is laudable for its effort to protect minors.

SA/ Rustenburg - Navigating the However, the Bill isn't without its contentious points. Chapter Three, for example, aims to validate polygamous marriages, allowing men to marry multiple wives, provided they have their existing spouse's consent.

Community sentiment on this matter is mixed. One local resident told Platinum Weekly: "To validate polygamous marriages is a slap in the face to my cultural and religious beliefs. Each to his own, I understand the Bill aims for inclusivity, but it needs to be more detailed and culture specific. One formula can't Weekly took to the community to find out serve and respect the beliefs of multiple cultures."

Another resident expressed concerns over the potential for increased gender-based Government Gazette No. 48914 on 7 July violence (GBV): "I believe that laws have the power to affect cultures and change before 31 August 2023. The Bill aims to behaviour. Even if a wife must give consolidate and modernise laws related to consent for her husband to marry another marriage, ensuring inclusivity, and treating woman, who's to say this consent won't all individuals with dignity, irrespective of be coerced through financial or physical abuse?" They also questioned the Bill's fairness, asking why the same right to enter into polygamous marriages isn't granted to women?

> In an age where the spotlight is increasingly focused on equal rights and social justice, this Bill attempts to take a step forward. But it also raises valid concerns that we, as a society, need to consider.

the case against Evan Mutale (44), a Zambian national, and Dineo Precious Powane, to Tuesday 26 September 2023. This decision was made in order for Powane to appear in court following her absence. Her attorney indicated in court that she sent him a medical certificate dated 30 August 2023, booking her off until 1 September 2023.

The state applied for a warrant for her arrest, pending her appearance in court on the set date. Failure to appear will result in her arrest and an automatic forfeiture of her bail money. The state argued that she informed her attorney about her ill health on Monday, 28 August 2023, but only decided to consult a doctor a day before the resumption of the trial. This the state views as a delay tactic, to avoid a speedy completion of trial. Powane is facing charges of money laundering, while Mutale is facing 49 charges of fraud and one of money laundering, after his arrest by the SAPS Provincial Commercial Crime Unit on 12 April 2023, in Rustenburg. He was charged for stealing over R5, million, from Jaira Construction and Projects, where he was employed as an accountant, responsible for managing accounts, payroll, and loading payments. Powane was granted R3.000 bail, while Mutale is out on R10.000 bail.

"It is alleged that between September 2019 and November 2020, Mutale fraudulently transferred money into an account belonging to Powane, who has no links to the company but is known to him. These transactions were done under the pretence of paying a service provider for services rendered to the company. In the process, he deceived his supervisor to make final authorisations for money to be transferred into Powane's bank account. Investigations revealed that some of this money was later transferred to his bank account and, as such contributed to the state charging him with money laundering," said regional national prosecuting authority (NPA) spokesperson Henry Mamothame. The North West director of public prosecutions, Dr Rachel Makhari, expressed her concern over the delays, as they create an unnecessary backlog in court matters.

Petrol prices: How does SA compare on average?

SA - Globalpetrolprices.com shows petrol prices per litre, octane-95, for South Africa from 29-May-2023 to 04-Sep-2023. The average value for South Africa during that period was 22.35 South African Rand with a minimum of 22.10 South African Rand on 3 July 2023 and a maximum of 22.98 South African Rand on 29 May 2023. For comparison, the average price of petrol in the world for this period is 33.90 South African Rand.

However, South Africa is quickly catching up. On 4 September the Minister of Mineral Resources and Energy, Mr Gwede Mantashe, announced the adjustment of fuel prices based on current local and international factors with effect from the 6th of September 2023. Based on current local and international factors, the fuel prices for September 2023 will be adjusted as follows:

- Petrol (both 93 and 95 Octane): One hundred and seventy-one cents per litre (171.00 c/l) increase
- Diesel (0.05% sulphur): Two hundred and eighty-four cents per litre (284.00 c/l) increase.
- Diesel (0.005% sulphur): Two hundred and seventy-six cents per litre (276.00 c/l) increase.
- Illuminating Paraffin (wholesale): Two hundred and seventy-eight cents per litre (278.00 c/l)
- SMNRP for IP: Three hundred and seventy cents per litre (370.00 c/l) increase.
- Maximum Retail Price of LPGas: Two hundred and twenty-six cents per kilogram (226.00 c/kg) increase.

A haven of hope: inside Rustenburg Child and Family Welfare Centre

Rustenburg - In the heart of Cashan, on 12 Mayet Drive, is a sanctuary for children in need. Founded in 2016 by Dr Sheehan Grant, Rustenburg Child and Family Centre has been a beacon of hope, offering children not just shelter, but also love, care, and a chance to heal.

What makes this centre a home? First and foremost, it's the non-profit organisation's unwavering commitment to the well-being of the children they take in. Each child undergoes a thorough assessment during admission, followed by the development of an individualised care plan. All this is carried out by a designated social worker, who, along with the centre's manager, ensures that only children who meet the home's requirements are admitted, backed by a valid court order.

But the home's care doesn't stop at admission. As a registered child protection organisation (CPO), the home sees to it that all children continue to receive vital services like medical and therapeutic care. Keeping the child's stability in mind, efforts are made to let them stay in their original schools. When necessary, they are enrolled in schools that better meet their educational needs.

The foster home leaves no stone unturned when it comes to emotional and educational support. Children have access to social workers five days a week to help them process their feelings and experiences. Furthermore, every child receives daily after-school tutoring from qualified teachers to ensure they don't fall behind academically.



The carers themselves aren't overlooked either. These caregivers are trained and well-versed in meeting the emotional needs of the children they look after. Each unit is small, managed by a prescreened caregiver to make sure the children receive the attention and emotional support they deserve.

Safety is also paramount. The premises is under camera surveillance, monitored by the home's manager, and equipped with double security gates, high walls, and electric fencing.

Behind the scenes, a dedicated management committee of volunteers takes on the herculean task of sustaining the organisation while ensuring that the children receive the highest quality of service

While they offer a world of love and care, there are ways the community can chip in. Donations of food, toiletries, or even help in arranging birthday parties for these children can go a long way.

It's comforting to know that in a world that often seems cold and uncaring, places like Rustenburg Child and Family Welfare Centre exists, ensuring that every child they take in feels a little more loved, a little safer, and a lot more hopeful about the future.



Mango Atchar

Rustenburg - Dive into the rich flavours of Mango Atchar, a cherished recipe from Akira Hussain's family kitchen. Infused with a hint of curry, this age-old recipe has been passed down from her grandmother and remains a beloved staple in their home. Simple yet delightful, it's a timeless treat for the taste buds.

Ingredients:

- Green mangoes: 1 and 1/2 kg
- · 2 tablespoons of salt
- · 4 tablespoons of red chili powder
- · 2 tablespoons of whole jeera
- 1 tablespoon of crushed dhania
- · 3 tablespoons of Methi masala
- 1½ cups sugar (375 ml)
- 2 cups vinegar (500 ml)
- 1/2 cup corn flour/ Maizena (125 ml)

Vagaar mixture:

- 1½ cups oil (375 ml)... you can use less oil if you'd like!
- · 6 green chilies slit
- 8 cloves of garlic
- · 2 tablespoons of mustard seeds
- · 1 handful of curry leaves

Method:

- 1. Peel the mangoes, wash, and drain thoroughly until dry. Sprinkle with salt and red chili powder.
- 2. In a pot, combine sugar, Maizena, and vinegar. Bring to a boil, stirring continuously. Once the mixture thickens, pour it over the bowl of mangoes.
- 3. In a pan, fry the vagaar mixture in oil. Once fried, pour it over the mangoes.
- 4. Mix everything thoroughly and allow to cool. Once cooled, transfer the atchar into bottles.
- 5. This atchar can be frozen and preserves well in the freezer.


Held at the Sasol Recreation Club in Secunda, the kick-off for this high-stakes match is at 15:30.
