A leaning issue

Rustenburg - On Tuesday morning 7 November 2023, I found myself in a rather unsettling situation while commuting to work. It was a typical morning; I was stuck in school traffic at 07:15, trying to reach my workplace before 07:30. While waiting in traffic on the Helen Joseph Bridge, just before the four-way intersection at Bergsig Academy, I noticed a streetlamp leaning dangerously towards the side of the oncoming traffic. I believe it's only a matter of time before this lamp falls onto an unsuspecting motorist or pedestrian. The question is, what is being done about it?

On Tuesday 7 November 2023, *Platinum Weekly* reached out to the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) for comment on the matter but received no response at the time of going to print.

Fortunately, no fatalities occurred.

Vehicle rollover

Rustenburg - On Friday, November 3, 2023, just before 21:00, a vehicle rolled over on the R30 near the R24 junction. Trauma Rescue swiftly arrived at the scene, and luckily, only one passenger suffered minor injuries.

Former attorney's representations on RAF theft case rejected by the DPP

Rustenburg - The Specialised Commercial Crimes Court in Rustenburg postponed the case against Betty Diale (52) to Tuesday 28 November 2023, for trial. This comes after her representations to request the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP)

to withdraw her charges were rejected. The state has already provided her with all the necessary documents in preparation for trial. The state also hopes there won't be any further delays recorded, as the matter has been postponed on various occasions.

A warrant for her arrest was previously issued for failing

to appear in court on 26 September 2023 and failing to provide reasons for her absence. She was rearrested on 6 October 2023 and released on warning after she produced a medical certificate. Diale is facing six charges of theft, amounting to

approximately R700,000, allegedly stolen from the Road Accident Fund (RAF) claimants.

"Police reports reveal that the Legal Practice Fidelity Fund received several complaints from the RAF claimants whose payments were deposited

into Diale's trust account. The claimants alleged that the said money did not reach them after the payout, and subsequently reported to the police for investigation. Diale was practicing as an attorney during the alleged commission of the crimes between 2009 and 2011 and was subsequently charged

with six counts of theft in June 2021. The Legal Practice Council has struck her off the roll, preventing her from practicing as an attorney," said National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) regional spokesperson Henry Mamothame.




Decomposed body discovered in canal

Sibanye-Stillwater assumes full ownership of Kroondal earlier than expected and concludes 5-year wage agreement

Rustenburg – On Wednesday 1 November 2023, Sibanye-Stillwater announced that the transaction entered into between Rustenburg Platinum Mines Limited (RPM) a subsidiary of Anglo American Platinum Limited (AAP), and Sibanye-Stillwater's subsidiary, Sibanye Rustenburg Platinum Mines Limited (Rustenburg operation) as announced on 31 January 2022, has been brought forward, resulting in the Rustenburg operation acquiring RPM's 50% share in the Kroondal pool and share agreement (Kroondal PSA) and the Group assuming full ownership of the low cost, mechanised Kroondal operation, effective 1 November 2023.

Sibanye-Stillwater chief executive officer, Neal Froneman, commented: "Concluding the transaction earlier enables effective consolidation of these operations under a single owner. By extending the operating life of the Kroondal operation, which as a standalone operation was constrained by the existing PSA agreement. We

are now able to realise the true potential of our adjacent resources by utilising the mechanised and low-cost Kroondal operation to mine across the boundary with the Rustenburg operation. This will accelerate the extraction of more remote parts of the Rustenburg operation orebody, expected to sustain employment for thousands of employees until 2029 and ensure the creation of significant shared value for all stakeholders in the region".


Furthermore, on Monday 6 November 2023, Sibanye-Stillwater advised that it had concluded a five-year wage agreement with all representative unions, comprising the Association of Mineworkers and Construction Union (AMCU) and the National Union of Mineworkers (the NUM) in respect of annual wages and benefits for employees at the Kroondal PGM operations.

The five-year wage agreement is similar to the terms and increases reached at the Group's

Rustenburg and Marikana operations during 2022. The agreement is inflation-linked, with category 4-8 employees receiving an increase of a minimum of 6% in each of the five-years of the agreement.

Miners, artisans, and officials will receive an increase of 6% in each year of the five-year agreement. The estimated average increase in the total wage bill, including all benefits, over the five-year period is approximately 6.4% per annum. Sibanye-Stillwater chief executive officer, Neal Froneman, commented: "We are pleased to have concluded this five-year inflation-linked wage agreement, which follows the agreements we reached at our Rustenburg and Marikana operations in 2022, in a constructive manner and without any disruption. The agreement secures wage stability in the operations which will benefit all stakeholders".

Rustenburg - On Wednesday, 4 October 2023, the Zinniaville Ratepayers Association, in its ongoing battle with water issues, along with residents, peacefully protested as they delivered their memorandum of complaints and demands to the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM).

"It is problematic that all areas affected are previously disadvantaged areas. There have been no improvements. We are concerned that the water situation is changing from bad to worse, and we will continue experiencing water shortages for the foreseeable future. Residents are experiencing many challenges and hardships because of a very low level of basic service to the people of Rustenburg. Residents are frustrated, angry, and upset regarding the poor level of basic services rendered by the Rustenburg Local Municipality. The consequences of the lack of

water do not have to be spelled out. Water is a gift of life, a basic need, and a fundamental human right, and it is the obligation of the government to provide every citizen with clean and potable water. We also request and propose that the residents of Rustenburg North, Zinniaville, Karlien Park, Seraleng, Nkandla, Tihabane West, Boitekong, Sunrise Park, and Geelhout Park receive water from Rand Water, which is more stable and definitely a cleaner supply. Unfortunately, the entire architecture constructed to provide service delivery has collapsed much in the same way that the actual infrastructure is collapsing around us," said Zinniaville Ratepayers Association chairman Shuaib Bham.

On Tuesday 7 November, Bham noted: "The memorandum was received on 4 October on behalf of RLM by the MMC of Infrastructure, Thabang Rampou, who had assured us that we would receive a written response within 14 days of receipt of the memorandum. However, we have still not received a written response as of date".

HAVE A HEART

When you hear someone has a pet, you immediately think of cats or dogs, right? Well, in some cases, people have pet fish. Many view pet fish as more of a decoration than a true companion, leading to misconceptions about owning fish as pets. Fish have very specific needs and require attentive and routine care. Neglect can make them sick and even lead to their demise. Taking a fish to the vet isn't always possible.

In my case, one of my pet fish, Denji, a molly, fell ill. I attempted to treat him, but it appeared he had an inoperable cancerous tumor. Saddened by this, I sought advice from friends on how to ease his suffering and help him pass peacefully. Immediate suggestions included 'flush it,' 'chop its head off,' or 'just take it out of the water.' After all, it's just a fish, right? Wrong.

Every little life deserves mercy. So, I conducted some research and discovered that the most humane way to help my little friend rest was to use clove oil. Clove oil acts as an anesthetic for fish and, in specific quantities, can be used to euthanize them.

Approximately 0.4 ml of clove oil per liter of aquarium water is sufficient to euthanize a fish. First, mix the clove oil with a small amount of warm water before gradually adding it to the aquarium water. This gently induces sleep in the fish, allowing them to pass away peacefully. Rest in peace to my dear Denji, and I hope that more fish owners out there will reconsider flushing their ailing friends down the toilet.
