# North West mourns 85 lives lost on roads this festive season

North West – In a tragic turn of events, a head-on collision between a heavy motor vehicle and a sedan on the R502 road, connecting Leeudoringstad and Makwassie in the Dr Kenneth Kaunda District, has resulted in the loss of five lives. The incident, involving a male driver and four passengers (two males and two females) from the sedan, has escalated the fatality count in the province to over 85 since the festive period began on 1 December, 2023. Marking a sombre milestone, this is the first major crash in the region to claim five or more lives in a single event.

Expressing profound sorrow, Sello Lehari, the MEC for the Department of Community Safety and Transport Management, extended heartfelt condolences to the bereaved families. In a silver lining amidst this dark cloud, the province has witnessed a 10% decrease in road fatalities compared to the same period last year.

Under MEC Lehari's leadership, joint law enforcement operations have been rigorously implemented and will persist until 15 January, 2024. "There is zero tolerance for disregarding regulations. Every life matters, and our enforcement will be more stringent to prevent further tragedies," affirmed MEC Lehari. He further implored motorists and pedestrians to remain vigilant and patient, emphasising that law enforcement officers have been instructed to strictly enforce traffic laws.

# Church leader sentenced to two years imprisonment for flashing



**Rustenburg/ Boitekong** — On 27 December 2023, the Rustenburg Regional Court handed down a two-year suspended sentence to Zoliswa Menziwa, aged 36, for violating *Section 22 of the Criminal Law (Sexual Offences and Related Matters) Amendment Act.* 2007.

Captain Sam Tselanyane reports that the case stemmed from an incident on 1 June 2022. Menziwa, along with five other church congregants, was discovered in a house used as a church in Sondela Phase 1, Boitekong. Eleven children, aged four to twelve, were also found on the premises under compromising circumstances.

Menziwa, identified as the church leader and the only one clothed at the time of the incident, was the only person charged. The children, comprising six boys and five girls, were immediately placed under social care and subsequently entrusted to family members.

The case was thoroughly investigated by the Rustenburg Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) unit, led by colonel Mosidi Mafora and warrant officer Phiri Mfetane. Although Menziwa was convicted, the five other individuals were acquitted.

The court's decision includes a five-year suspension of Menziwa's sentence, on the condition of no further convictions of the same nature during the period of suspension.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena of the North West Provincial Police commended the sentencing, reaffirming the SAPS' dedication to combating crimes against women and children. He praised the investigative team for their diligent work in bringing justice in this case.

This report underscores a commitment to the protection of the vulnerable and highlights the ongoing efforts to address and prevent such incidents in the future.

#### **URGENT CALL FOR WITNESSES:**

justice for the victims of Boitekong mass shooting

Boitekong/ Rustenburg — In the wake of the tragic mass shooting in Boitekong, the North West provincial commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwena, has formed a dedicated investigative team. The team is urgently appealing to anyone with information about the incident, which led to the loss of nine lives at



the Popo Molefe informal settlement near Rustenburg at around 21:15 on Saturday, 16 December 2023.

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone detailed the attack on a group of primarily Xhosa-speaking individuals by suspects believed to speak Sesotho. This brutal act resulted in eight people dying on the spot and a ninth succumbing to their injuries at the hospital. Additionally, eight individuals were reported injured.

If you saw or heard anything, or have any information, no matter how small it may seem, please report it to your nearest police station. The victims were brothers, sisters, mothers, and fathers with families and loved ones who are now grieving. They deserve justice.

An eyewitness, who chose to remain anonymous, shared her harrowing experience of hearing the gunfire while caring for her baby. Her account underscores the terror and chaos that has shaken the community.

While the motive behind this grievous act is still unclear, and no arrests have been made, the ongoing investigations are critical.

North West premier Kaobitsa Bushy Maape also condemned the atrocity, extending condolences to the bereaved families and wishing the injured a swift recovery. "These were members of our community, and it is our collective responsibility to assist in bringing the perpetrators to justice," stated premier Maape.

This tragedy not only highlights the need for community solidarity in the face of violence but also serves as a reminder of the profound impact such incidents have on families and communities. The call for witnesses and information is a crucial step towards closure for the families and ensuring that those responsible are held accountable.

# POLICE RECOVERS FIREARM FOLLOWING COMMUNITY TIP-OFF



Swartruggens – The Swartruggens police, acting on a community tip-off, made a crucial discovery and subsequent arrest on Wednesday, 3 January 2024. The tip was about a local man suspected of illegal firearm possession. Proactive police action unfolded with the questioning of the suspect, who then led the officers to a friend's residence in Extension 4, Borolelo Location. The man then directed the police to his neighbour, where they uncovered a hidden 9mm pistol with a magazine, concealed under a tree. Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone confirmed the suspect's arrest, additionally linking him to a burglary incident that occurred on Saturday, 23 December 2023 in Swartruggens. The suspect, identified as 22-year-old Kgotlaetsile Selebogo, faced the local Magistrates' Court on Friday 5 January 2024. Charged with unlawful possession of a firearm and residential burglary, his case has been postponed to 10 January, while he remains in custody. Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the North West provincial commissioner, extended his gratitude to all the members involved in this operation, including

security officers. He lauded their swift and collaborative efforts that played a pivotal role in confiscating the firearm and ensuring community safety. This incident underscores the importance of community engagement in policing and highlights the effectiveness of collaborative efforts in crime prevention and ensuring public safety.
