MAN FATALLY SHOT IN SUSPECTED ASSASSINATION

Rustenburg – In a shocking incident that has left the Rustenburg community reeling, a 48-year-old man was assassinated on Thursday morning, 25 January 2024. The tragedy unfolded at the intersection of R104 and 4th Avenue in Waterfall East at around 06:20. As the victim departed for work, two vehicles were observed lying in wait outside his residence. The assailants launched their deadly assault just as the man emerged with his bakkie, a Toyota Hilux. The attackers, who were armed and dangerous, fired multiple shots at the victim before fleeing the scene. In a statement, sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi of the Rustenburg South African Police Service (SAPS) detailed the stark sequence of events. “The deceased was driving his Toyota Hilux from 4th Avenue and had stopped at the intersection to join the R104. It was at this moment that his vehicle was cornered by a white

VW GTI and a white Picanto or Hyundai i10. Two armed suspects emerged from one of the vehicles and commenced shooting at the deceased multiple times. Tragically, he succumbed to his injuries at the scene.”

The nature of the attack, which saw the victim's vehicle and personal belongings left untouched, strongly indicates an assassination. The Rustenburg SAPS has launched an intensive manhunt for the perpetrators and is urging the public to come forward with any information. This ruthless crime has not only taken a life but has also instilled fear and uncertainty in the hearts of the Rustenburg community.

FAILED RANSOM LEADS TO TRAGIC MURDER OF KIDNAPPED VICTIM...

Mogwase/ Swartklip – In a significant breakthrough, a joint operation by the Mogwase Detectives Unit and the North West Provincial Anti-Gang Unit culminated in the arrest of a 42-year-old man at Acornhoek, Mpumalanga, on Saturday 27 January 2024. The arrest was made in connection with the kidnapping of 55-year-old Pauline Nkanyane, a resident of Manamakgoteng village near Mogwase.

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone reported that the alleged kidnapping took place in the early hours of Sunday 21 January 2024. Pauline Nkanyane was en route to her job at Swartklip Mine when she was abducted. The investigation unfolded rapidly, revealing that the suspect had driven to Acornhoek with Nkanyane, leaving her vehicle

abandoned in Manamakgoteng. Initially treated as a missing person case, the situation escalated to a kidnapping after the suspect demanded a ransom. Tragically, the situation took a grim turn. When the ransom plan failed, the suspect is alleged to have murdered Nkanyane. Her body was discovered by a passer-by along the R36 road in Moraba village, situated between JJ Strydom tunnel and Ohringstad in Limpopo Province, on Thursday 25 January 2024.

According to Mike Bolhuis, Specialist Investigators into Serious Violent, Serious Economic Crimes & Serious Cybercrimes, kidnappings rocketed by 183% from 3,832 in 2012/13 to 10,826 in 2021/22. Against a backdrop of economic hardship and political turmoil, holding people for ransom has

become increasingly lucrative.

During the arrest operation, police found the suspect in possession of a 9mm pistol with a filed-off serial number. The suspect has since appeared before the Mogwase Magistrates' Court on 29 January 2024, facing charges of kidnapping. The police have not ruled out the possibility of further arrests in connection with this case.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwaena, the provincial commissioner of North West, commended the team's dedication and hard work leading to the arrest. He also extended his heartfelt condolences to the family and relatives of Pauline Nkanyane, expressing sorrow over the tragic loss. The community has been shaken by this event, and the police are committed to ensuring justice is served.

BREAKTHROUGH IN
BRITS KIDNAPPING
AND MURDER CASE

Brits/ Mooinooi – Sergeant Mapataka of the North West Police received high praise from lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the Provincial

Commissioner of North West, for his role in securing a combined 115-year sentence for five culprits involved in a heinous crime. The sentencing took place on Friday 26 January 2024 at the Gauteng North High Court in Pretoria. The convicts, Lebogang Tshabalala (29), Everjoy Sibanda (20), Lucky Motholo (25), Kagiso Matlhabe (22), and Kamogelo Modise (23), were found guilty of kidnapping, robbery with aggravating circumstances, and murder. Their victim, 34-year-old Neo Modubu, an employee at Crocodile Mine, was reported missing in Brits

NORTH WEST POLICE
NETS 885 SUSPECTS

North West – In a major crackdown during the Safer Festive Season Operation Shanela, the North West police have arrested a total of 885 suspects for a range of offences. The operation, which ran from Monday 22 January to Sunday, 28 January 2024, targeted various crimes across the province. Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone highlighted that the arrests covered a wide spectrum of offences, including drug-related crimes, illegal liquor trade, driving under the influence, possession of firearms and ammunition, assault with intent to cause grievous bodily harm, murder, business and residential robberies, burglaries, malicious damage to property, and rape. Key achievements of these operations included the recovery and confiscation of three firearms, 143 rounds of ammunition, four vehicles, along

with seized quantities of liquor and various drugs. In a comprehensive effort to curb crime, the police conducted searches on 93 premises, 1,451 vehicles, and 2,853 individuals. A notable success was the arrest of a wanted suspect in Rustenburg. This individual has been linked to three separate cases of motor vehicle theft and one case of fraud, with these offences being committed between January and October 2023. Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the provincial police commissioner of North West, expressed his gratitude to all the participants in the operation.

RAPIST GETS LIFE SENTENCE

to a 33-year-old accused by the Mogwase Regional Court on Friday 26 January 2024. According to brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, the accused was also given five years imprisonment for kidnapping. The court further declared the accused unfit to possess a firearm. Moreover, the court gave an order that the accused's name be included in the National Register for Sex Offenders. According to evidence presented in court, the accused dragged the then 12-year-old girl into the bushes in Morogong, near Ramokokastad outside Rustenburg in December 2020, and raped her. The matter was reported to the police and the accused was subsequently arrested. Lieutenant general Sello Kwena commended the investigating officer, detective constable Balungile Makaya of the Mogwase Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) Unit and the prosecutor, advocate Tebogo Mokoka, as well as other role players for their collaborative efforts to ensure that the accused got a hefty sentence.

Rustenburg – The provincial police commissioner in North West, lieutenant general Sello Kwena, welcomed the life imprisonment sentence handed down

LIFE IMPRISONMENT FOR MAN IN
BRUTAL ATTEMPTED MURDER CASE

Mogwase – The Mogwase Regional Court on Friday 26 January 2024 sentenced 41-year-old Joel Lempaletse Moatshe to life imprisonment for the attempted murder of his girlfriend. Additionally, Moatshe received a five-year sentence for assault and was declared unfit to possess a firearm. The conviction stems from two separate incidents involving Moatshe and his 26-year-old girlfriend. The first occurred on 16 August 2022, when Moatshe physically assaulted her. After the attack, the victim's screams alerted neighbours and community members, who apprehended Moatshe at his workplace and performed a citizen's arrest. Following this incident, Moatshe was granted bail and a protective order was issued against him. However, the situation escalated tragically on 12 October 2023. Henry Mamothame,

spokesperson for the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA), reported that Moatshe encountered his girlfriend en route to her workplace and launched a violent knife attack. He inflicted multiple stab wounds to her stomach, hand, and back, leaving severe injuries. The victim's colleagues intervened upon hearing her cries for help, causing Moatshe to flee. She was promptly taken to a medical facility for urgent care. Moatshe was subsequently re-arrested, and this time the court denied bail. Despite his plea of not guilty to all charges, the court convicted Moatshe, delivering a sentence reflective of the severity of his crimes. This case has drawn significant attention to issues of domestic violence and the importance of community vigilance in preventing such tragedies.



MAN SENTENCED TO LIFE
FOR WIFE'S MURDER

Rustenburg – In a significant ruling by the Tlhabane Magistrates' Court on Thursday 25 January 2024, Sithandile Ndlobothi, aged 36, has been sentenced to life imprisonment for the murder of his wife, Subenathi Nqalekane. Additionally, the court has declared Ndlobothi unfit to possess a firearm. The conviction stems from a tragic incident on 14 January 2023, in Phase 1 Freedom Park, near Rustenburg. Henry Mamothame, the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) regional spokesperson, detailed the circumstances leading to the crime. Ndlobothi suspected his wife of infidelity. On the night of the incident, he woke up to the cries of their baby and noticed his wife was not in the house. After putting the baby back to sleep, he went searching for her and was later informed by neighbours that she had returned home. Upon Ndlobothi's return, a heated argument broke out, escalating to a violent assault. He attacked her with his hands and a stick and kicked her with booted feet while she was defenceless. According to Mamothame, the assault briefly paused when she admitted to visiting a man with whom she was having an affair, but then it mercilessly continued despite pleas from onlookers and her brother-in-law. Tragically, Nqalekane succumbed to her injuries upon arrival at a nearby medical facility. Ndlobothi was arrested two days later, on 16 January 2023. During the trial, he pleaded guilty to the offense. Highlighting the severity of the crime, state prosecutor Sangweni Zimema emphasised to the court the pandemic of domestic violence and the urgent need for the courts to respond decisively. Zimema also pointed out the lasting trauma for the couple's son, who is now left motherless. Magistrate Segakweng Moeng concurred with the prosecution, noting the alarming number of cases involving serious and violent crimes against women and children. He underscored the importance of the courts sending a clear message regarding such criminal offenses. Dr. Rachel Makhari, the director of Public Prosecutions in the North West, commended the efforts of prosecutor Sergeant Motsheoa Segopolo of the South Africa Police Service (SAPS) and other key role players in ensuring justice was served in this case.

BEWARE OF FAKE POLICE
SCAM IN RUSTENBURG

Rustenburg – Residents of Rustenburg are being cautioned about a worrying message that has been circulating on WhatsApp groups over the past two weeks. The message warns of individuals posing as police officers, specifically targeting the areas



of Tlhabane, Geelhout, and their surroundings. The message details that the alleged criminals, two bald-headed males appearing to be in their 40s, are driving around in a white Polo. One of the imposters reportedly presents a "police badge". These individuals are described as wearing formal attire to look like undercover detectives, with one sporting a distinct "Chanel O" trimmed beard. According to the circulating warning, these fake cops approach unsuspecting individuals under the pretext of seeking information, often showing a picture of a Bangladeshi national. In a cunning move, they then request residents to save their phone numbers for any future tips. However, as soon as the victim presents their phone, it is snatched by the impostors who then make a quick getaway. In response to this alarming situation, *Platinum Weekly* reached out to SAPS spokesperson, sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi. On Tuesday, 23 January 2024, sergeant Mokgadi clarified, "We have no information regarding this, but we have noted it with concern." The authorities urge the public to remain vigilant and to report any encounters with these or similar fraudulent individuals. If you find yourself in a situation involving fake police officers or have any relevant information, it is crucial to contact the real police immediately or visit your local police station. Reporting such incidents promptly, can prevent these conmen from deceiving more people.

Aisha, the Beloved Chow Chow

Derby – A personal tragedy unfolded in the quiet streets of Derby's downtown area on Saturday 13 January 2024. Monique van Bosh, a resident of the community, is grappling with the heartbreaking loss of her seven-month-old Chow Chow, Aisha, who was tragically poisoned.

Monique, still reeling from the shock, recounted the distressing details. "It was unmistakable, the sight of her vomit being neon-green. I knew immediately that Aisha had been poisoned," Monique said. Confronted by transportation and financial hurdles, Monique faced the daunting reality of being unable to secure immediate veterinary assistance during the challenging mid-January period.

In a desperate attempt to mitigate the effects of the poison, believed to be anti-freeze, Monique administered a homemade remedy. "I resorted to giving Aisha milk and an egg mixture, hoping it would help her body expel the poison," she explained. Despite a thorough search of their property, no evidence of the toxic substance was found.

For Monique, Aisha was not just a pet but a beloved member of the family, cherished and pampered in every way. "Aisha held a special place in our lives. She was a gift from my husband, a nod to the cherished Chow I grew up with. We waited 19 years to welcome another Chow into our lives. Aisha was loved deeply; she had her own set of brushes, shampoo, toothpaste, and even conditioner," Monique shared affectionately.

The incident has left Monique not only with a profound sense of loss but also with concerns for the safety of her other pets, a Boerboel and a Labrador. "My hope now is that those responsible for this cruel act do not return. People often dismiss the significance of pets, but Aisha was more than 'just another animal' to us. She was a vital part of our family," Monique stated.

In the wake of Aisha's passing, Monique has found a symbolic way to honour her memory. "Aisha's nametag now adorns my keyring, a daily reminder of the unique bond we shared. Her presence reaffirmed my belief that sometimes, dogs exemplify virtues of loyalty and love more profoundly than humans ever could," Monique reflected.


DOG POISONING INCIDENTS
INCREASING IN KOSTER AND DERBY

Koster/ Derby – A troubling wave of dog poisonings has been reported in Koster and Derby, stretching back to October 2023, according to Stella Potgieter, FF Plus councillor of Kgetlengrivier Local Municipality. The issue came to light after Potgieter's appeal for information on local WhatsApp groups, revealing a concerning number of medium to large dogs having been poisoned. "The response to my inquiry was alarming," Potgieter shared. "Regrettably, many of these incidents haven't been reported to the South African Police Service (SAPS). With more reports, the SAPS could have identified this as a growing trend, enabling the community to be alerted and measures to be taken." Potgieter emphasises the importance of reporting such incidents to the authorities, including your local police or community policing forum (CPF). "We need a more

comprehensive understanding of the situation. Anyone in the Derby/ Koster area whose dogs have been affected and hasn't reached out yet, please contact me. Your information is vital."

"Monitor your pets for any unusual behaviour and inspect your property for suspicious objects. If you find anything out of the ordinary, notify your CPF or the police immediately. It's crucial to safeguard our beloved pets against these heinous acts." The rise in dog poisonings has rattled the community, underscoring the need for increased awareness and preventive measures to protect our furry family members.



A chicken leg, suspected to be laced with dog poison, was recently found thrown over a residential wall in Koster. Alert homeowners were able to prevent their dogs from consuming it, preventing potential harm.

ESSENTIAL STEPS TO TAKE
IF YOUR DOG IS POISONED

In the unfortunate event that your beloved canine companion is poisoned, immediate action is crucial. It is essential to notify your veterinarian as soon as you notice any symptoms. Even a simple phone call can make a significant difference in your pet's survival chances.


Here are some vital steps to follow

- Keep your pet calm:** Panic can exacerbate the situation. Calming your pet down can prevent further harm.
- If the poison is external, bathe your pet:** In cases where your pet's skin is exposed to a toxin, thoroughly wash them. It's crucial to rinse repeatedly to ensure all traces of the poison are removed.
- Identify the poison:** If the toxin was ingested, try to obtain a sample of the poison or its container (without getting infected yourself!). This information can be vital for your vet to determine the most effective treatment.

Administer activated charcoal: For certain poisons, like chocolate, administering activated charcoal can help. However, it's important to consult with your vet for the correct dosage and suitability.

It's also wise to prepare a 'poison kit' at home, particularly if you live in remote areas far from veterinary assistance. This kit should include activated charcoal and milk of magnesia. Such preparations are especially important in rural areas or farms, where there is a higher risk of dogs being poisoned during break-in attempts.

In an emergency, you can create a makeshift remedy for your dog. Mix a raw chicken egg with a teaspoon of activated charcoal (adjust the amount for larger dogs after consulting with your vet). You can add a bit of milk to make the mixture more fluid and easier for your dog to ingest. This mixture



should be fed to your dog immediately. Lastly, it's advisable to keep your dogs indoors at night, especially in areas with higher risks of break-ins. Outdoor dogs are often targeted by perpetrators to facilitate their criminal activities. Remember, the safety of your pets often depends on your preparedness and quick response. Always consult with your veterinarian for the best course of action in case of poisoning.

Destructive storm hits Rustenburg

Rustenburg – A severe storm hit Rustenburg and its surrounding areas on Monday 29 January 2024, bringing with it strong winds of approximately 30 km/h. Following a boiling day (at 31°) marked by high humidity, menacing storm clouds gathered.

The thunderstorm, accompanied by scattered clouds, began forming around 14:00. Various localities reported significant rainfall, with some areas recording as much as 30mm, while another location within Rustenburg reported a substantial 50mm of rain for the day.




The Rustenburg Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) also faced the storm's wrath. A large tree on the property toppled over, resulting in broken branches and debris scattered across the SPCA premises, some of which landed on animal cages. The following morning, the SPCA received much-needed assistance from Roly Engineering and community members, who helped clear the area. Marisa Kruger, the SPCA manager and inspector, expressed relief that no animals were harmed and extended her gratitude for the community's swift response and support.



In the Magalies View area, a local car dealership suffered extensive damage when its zinc plate roof was torn off by the storm's fierce winds. The roof was lifted and deposited about 10 meters away from the dealership. Fortunately, there were no reported injuries despite the severity of the incident.

Rustenburg – In the early hours of Monday morning, 29 January 2024, a tragic accident occurred on the R104, commonly known as the 'Old Pretoria Road.' At approximately 05:30, a bakkie and a truck were involved in a head-on collision, causing major disruptions to the morning traffic. Authorities quickly responded to the scene, and traffic was redirected to one side of the road to allow emergency services to attend to the accident. The driver of the truck sustained minor injuries and was treated at the scene. Regrettably, the collision proved fatal for the driver of the bakkie, who died upon impact. We extend our heartfelt condolences to the friends and family of the deceased during this difficult time.

Understanding the Polyphagous Shot Hole Borer

Hartbeespoort – In January 2024, a prominent estate in Hartbeespoort alerted authorities about a suspected infestation of Polyphagous Shot Hole Borer (PSHB). This proactive step was crucial to curb the potential spread of this destructive pest. The concern is that the pest may have spread from large quantities of chopped wood sold along the main roads in the Broederstroom/Hartbeespoort area. The estate reached out to the authorities, along with the Magaliesberg Biosphere for assistance, and the situation is under investigation. Belinda Cooper, a coordinator at Magaliesberg Biosphere, highlighted the distinction between beneficial and harmful borer species. Several indigenous types of wood-boring insects contribute positively to the ecosystem by creating habitats for other species and aiding in decomposition, the PSHB is one of the exceptions. Its presence in Hartbeespoort has led to measures, such as cutting down and treating the affected trees to prevent further spread.

Polyphagous Shot Hole Borer (PSHB): a closer look. The PSHB, scientifically known as *Euwallacea formicatus*, is a significant threat to South Africa's indigenous trees. Measuring about 2mm, these beetles form a symbiotic relationship with certain fungi, which serve as their primary food source. This relationship, however, spells disaster for the host trees. The fungus, carried by the beetles, attacks the tree's vascular system, disrupting water and nutrient flow and eventually leading to the tree's demise. Detecting the beetles themselves is challenging due to their tiny size. However, signs of infestation in trees are noticeable and vary across different tree species. Common indicators include a wilting tree, dead branches, entry and exit holes on the bark, shotgun-like lesions at entry/exit holes, sugar volcanoes on the bark at entry/exit holes, or blotches of oozing resin on the bark at entry/exit holes.

It's a symbiotic chain. While the presence of PSHB is alarming, it's important to remember not to panic. Not all borer species are detrimental. Many play a crucial role in our ecosystem, contributing to biodiversity. It's vital to stay informed and understand the specifics of each species. If you suspect a borer infestation, take the time to research and consult experts to identify the species correctly and take appropriate action. Understanding the nature of these borers can help in managing these pests effectively and safeguarding our natural heritage.



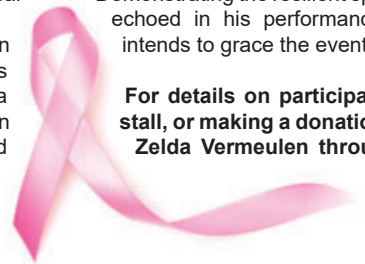
Rustenburg community rallies behind beloved local, Pieter Naudé

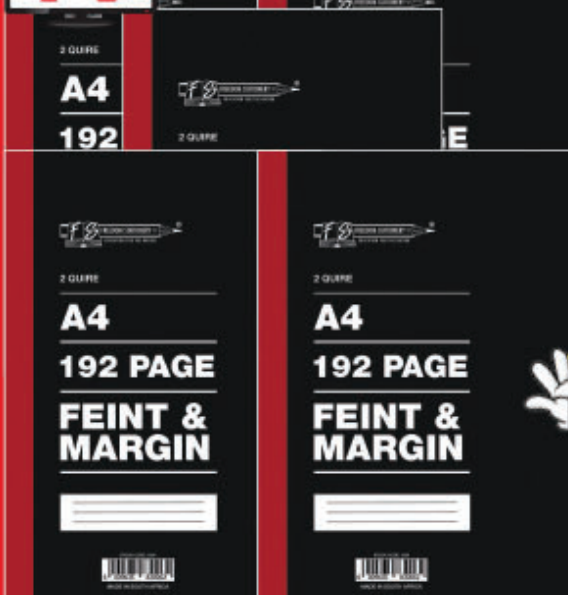
