

It's costing SA billions!

A report by the Transnational Alliance to Combat Illicit Trade (TRACIT) underscores the magnitude of the issue, with illegal mining and illicit trade in precious metals and diamonds estimated to cost around R7 billion annually (this figure was estimated in 2017!), including heightened security costs to protect mines from invasions by syndicates. South Africa. being a leading producer of platinum and chrome, faces substantial losses due to these illegal activities, despite global price fluctuations.

The report also states that there are between 8,000 and 30,000 illegal miners reported to work in South Africa, including common reports of child labour and other human rights abuses.

Estimates place the illegal mining and export of chrome ore at nearly 1 million tonnes per year – more than 10% of South Africa's legal chrome output.

Arrested appeared before court

The police operation, dubbed 'Vala Umgodi', led to the arrest of 71 illegal immigrants and eight illegal miners, alongside the seizure of mining material and equipment. RUSTENBURG DETECTIVES CHARGED WITH CORRUPTION AND EXTORTION



Rustenburg - Two Rustenburg detectives, sergeant Yvonne Suzan Sikwani (54) and constable Bontle Mmudi (41), were brought before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 22 February 2024. The detectives face serious allegations of corruption and extortion stemming from their conduct while investigating a fraud case initially reported in May 2021.

Granted bail at R1,000 each, Sikwani and Mmudi

are scheduled to make their next court appearance on Friday 31 May 2024.

The arrests were the result of an undercover operation spearheaded by the Provincial Anti-Corruption Unit. According to colonel Adéle Myburgh, the operation was launched in response to information suggesting that the accused had repeatedly demanded money from a complainant between October 2022 and January 2024. The

reported motive behind these demands was to rush the investigation process, a clear breach of their duty and a violation of public trust.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the provincial police commissioner, expressed his disappointment and concern over the incident. He emphasised that corruption within the police force not only undermines the integrity of the institution but also erodes public confidence in law enforcement.

Navigating tenant rights and squatter laws:

A Rustenburg resident's predicament

Rustenburg – A story of excitement turned to frustration as a local woman diligently saved up for a deposit and the first month's rent, dreaming of a new beginning for herself and her children.

After careful budgeting, she discovered a pretty two-bedroom house with a welcoming yard, an ideal setting for her family's next chapter. With the deposit and first month's rent paid, keys in hand, she embarked on the moving process, packing her life into boxes with eager anticipation.

However, upon arrival at what was supposed to be her family's new sanctuary, she was met with an unexpected obstacle: the previous tenants had not vacated the property. Despite the landlord's efforts since October 2023, these occupants refused to leave, citing 'squatter laws' and claiming they had every right to remain.

SQUATTER LAW IN SOUTH AFRICA

Let's start with what the term 'squatter law' refers to. There is no act called the 'Squatters Act or Law' in South Africa. It is a term that is often used to describe the rights of illegal occupiers (squatters) not to be removed or evicted from residential or business premises without a court order to such effect. It basically means that an owner of residential or business property may not take the law into his/her own hands and forcefully remove illegal occupiers from the property.

An illegal occupier or squatter refers to any person or organisation occupying property when they have no legal right to do so. A few examples of this may be where people simply move into a property and refuse to leave, where people simply move onto vacant property, erect housing structures and start living there, or where a lease agreement between an owner and the tenants comes to an end or is

legally cancelled, and the tenants refuse to leave lease agreement as he would not be able to give the premises.

What are the rights of residential property owners?

Any owner stuck with illegal occupiers may evict them lawfully. Depending on the circumstances, different eviction laws in South Africa provide the legal process to be followed in each instance. Our advice is to always approach your attorney

to assist you with an eviction because it is such a sensitive topic in our country. One could also approach the local Rental Housing Tribunal in your area to obtain an eviction order, which would have the same effect as if it were granted by a court. Once the eviction order has been obtained, the sheriff of the court will remove the illegal occupiers. Unfortunately, eviction orders aren't obtained overnight or even within a week. It often takes months to have illegal occupiers lawfully removed from your premises.

What are the rights of the new tenant? In the scenario above, the new

tenant who already signed a new lease agreement and paid a deposit and first month's rent in respect of the property, would not be able to take occupation of the premises.

If the illegal occupiers still refuse to vacate, the owner of the property would be in breach of the new

occupation to the new tenant. Either the tenant or the owner would then have to cancel the new lease agreement. The new tenant would be entitled to claim back any money which was already paid in respect of the lease agreement.

GERMAN TOURIST'S TRUST LEADS TO TRAGIC END IN NORTHAM

WESTPHAL BRUTALLY TORTURED AND MURDERED

has cast a shadow over South Africa's reputation culminating in tragedy. as a tourist destination, a German visitor fell victim to a brutal crime that underscores the importance of vigilance and trust, especially in South Africa.



Rustenburg's own Molokoane shines as a glass artist on the global stage



Elections in South Africa are held for the national assembly, provincial legislatures, and municipal councils - following a five-year cycle - with national and provincial elections held simultaneously and municipal elections held two years later. South Africans of all races took part in the first fully democratic elections in 1994. Since then, the Constitutional Court has struck down two attempts by the government to deny the vote to convicted criminals in prison. The court has also ruled that South Africans living outside the country must be allowed to vote.






