REPORT SIGHTINGS TO 083 761 7497

Rustenburg – A remarkable sight unfolded on Monday morning, 4 March 2024, as motorists near the Kroondal offramp on the N4 were greeted by an unusual pedestrian a hippopotamus.

To ensure the safety of both our community and the wandering hippo, the Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation, and Tourism (DEDECT) has launched an urgent search. They seek the community's assistance in tracking the animal's whereabouts.

Damage Causing Animal (DCA) official Vasti Botha, in an interview with Platinum Weekly, shared insights into the ongoing search. "We believe the hippo may have ventured into the Hexriver area or its vicinity. Despite following its tracks for as long as possible, we've reached a standstill. exercise extra caution during evening and early morning hours," Botha explained.

Residents who encounter the hippo are urged to immediately contact Vasti Botha at 083 761 7497.

The community is strongly advised against attempting to engage with the animal directly. Recognised as one of the

most aggressive and dangerous land mammals, hippos are responsible for approximately 500 fatalities annually in Africa. Their considerable size, weight, and surprisingly sharp teeth contribute to their formidable nature.

DEDECT communications director Jeremia Matebesi provided some context on the hippo's unexpected appearance. "The origins of this particular hippo remain unclear. However, it's not uncommon for young bulls to be expelled from their groups, prompting them to search for new territories and potential mates. Hippos are known to inhabit areas around the Elands, Hex, and Crocodile rivers," Matebesi noted.

Echoing a stern warning, DEDECT's deputy director of external communications, Baabua Thukubi, highlighted Given hippos' nocturnal tendencies, we urge locals to the gravity of the situation in a conversation with Platinum Weekly. "Hippos are responsible for the highest number of human fatalities in Africa. It is crucial to avoid any interaction with these animals, as they are highly aggressive and often lethal." Thukubi cautioned.

As the community and authorities rally to locate and safely manage the hippo's presence, the incident serves as a stark reminder of the unpredictable nature of wild animals and the need for vigilance in shared environments

ARMED ROBBERS TARGETING HIKERS

Rustenburg - Three suspects, Organzo Phenza Mbombe (37), Obvious Moyo (24), and Prince Njove (30), appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday 19 February 2024. They face charges related to armed robbery and extortion, following their arrest in a precisely coordinated crime intelligence-driven operation. The court has remanded all three in custody pending further investigations.



The arrests were the culmination of a joint operation by the Provincial Crime Intelligence, the Rustenburg Trio Task Team, and the Mooinooi and Marikana police units on Friday, 16 February 2024. This operation was sparked by reports of three armed robberies targeting hikers in the nature resorts around Marikana between 24 December 2023 and 1 January 2024. Lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani detailed the crimes, noting that the victims were confronted and overpowered by armed assailants. These criminals not only threatened the hikers with firearms but also robbed them of personal items such as cellphones, a video camera, shoes, and clothing. Additionally, the victims were coerced into transferring money to the assailants via E-wallets or similar electronic means before being released. Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the provincial police commissioner, lauded the cooperation and dedication of the various SAPS units involved in the

COMMUNITY **ALERT: DAYTIME ARMED** ROBBERY

Rustenburg - Residents of Joubert Street in Rustenburg were subjected to a terrifying ordeal on Wednesday 21 February 2024 when a family's home became the target of an armed robbery. In a bold midday crime, four individuals concealed with balaclavas forcibly entered the residence, threatening the occupants with firearms.

According to Ofentse Mokgadi, spokesperson for the Rustenburg South African Police Service (SAPS), the assailants held the family at gunpoint. The robbers proceeded to loot the family's safe, making off with firearms, jewellery, and other valuable possessions. This incident has raised concerns about safety in local communities, especially given the audacity of the crime occurring in broad daylight. Investigations continue.

OPERATION SHANELA NETS OVER A THOUSAND SUSPECTS

North West – In an impressive show of force, Operation Shanela, aimed at high-density crime areas, has once again demonstrated its effectiveness in curbing crime in the North West province. Between 26 February and 3 March 2024, a total of 1,154 suspects were apprehended for a wide array of offences.

The operation yielded significant arrests for various crimes: 58 individuals were detained for drug-related offences, 31 for illegal liquor trading, and 17 for driving under the influence. Additionally, eight arrests were made for the illegal possession of firearms and ammunition. The crackdown on property crimes resulted in 37 arrests for burglary and 53 for malicious damage to property.

Colonel Adéle Myburgh highlighted the operation's focus on serious and violent crimes, resulting in 10 arrests for murder, 193 for assault with intent to cause grievous bodily harm (GBH), 111 for common assault, and nine for rape.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the provincial commissioner of North West, praised the police and all contributing parties for their unwavering dedication.



MANYANE RESORT HIT BY MIDNIGHT FIRE

Mogwase – A fire incident in the early hours of Tuesday, 27 February 2024, has severely damaged Manyane Resort, a popular destination within Pilanesberg National Park.

The blaze, which erupted around 01:30, quickly spread through the resort, leading to the destruction of the reception area, conference room, restaurant, and support staff offices. Preliminary reports from security personnel suggest the fire started in a passage linking the restaurant to the conference facilities, with Fire and Rescue Services responding swiftly to contain the inferno.

Despite the significant damages incurred, there were no injuries reported among people or harm to the local wildlife and vegetation. The resort, excluding the affected facilities, remains operational, ensuring that guests can still enjoy the camping and caravan sites, along with other activities within the nature reserve unaffected by the fire.

Investigations into the cause of the fire are ongoing, with the North West Parks and Tourism Board collaborating closely with Golden Leopards Resorts management. The aim is to determine the origin of the fire and implement measures to prevent future incidents, ensuring the safety and enjoyment of all visitors to this cherished national park.
