Alarming increase in kidnappings

Recent police statistics have unveiled a disturbing increase in kidnapping incidents, with a staggering 4,000 individuals reported kidnapped across the country within the July to September 2023 timeframe. These are only the reported cases. These abductions, often motivated by ransom demands, human trafficking, or extortion, are becoming increasingly common.

Mike Bolhuis, Specialist Investigators into Serious Violent, Serious Economic Crimes & Serious Cybercrimes, highlights the alarming trend: "Against a backdrop of economic hardship and political turmoil, holding people for ransom has become increasingly lucrative.

The reluctance of victims, particularly parents, to seek police assistance due to fears for their children's safety complicates efforts to combat this

Shockingly, Bolhuis also revealed: "In the past 10 years, kidnappings sky-rocketed by 183% from 3,832 in 2012/13 to 10,826 in 2021/22.

Disturbing voice notes on social media

In Rustenburg, a chilling exchange captured in voice notes between a man and a woman discussing the abduction of two children for financial gain has raised alarms. Shared within a local safety WhatsApp group, the conversation reveals a sinister plan to kidnap the children, with

no intention of their return, for a sum of R30,000. The authenticity of the voice notes remains unverified, yet the content is a stark reminder of the reality of child abduction in South Africa.

The people in the voice notes chatted in a way that was weirdly polite, in well-spoken Setswana, almost like discussing what to make for dinner that

Teenagers kidnapped in broad daylight

In a recent incident in Brits, two teenagers, cousins Zahraa Mohammed (17) and Bataviya Mohammed (19), fell victim to kidnapping in a meticulously orchestrated attack on 6 March 2024. The Brits

Police Department has initiated a search for three suspects involved in this daytime abduction, illustrating the bold nature of kidnappers.

Lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani reports that the cousins were ambushed while driving, forced into another vehicle, and taken by the kidnappers, leaving behind a scene of chaos

The police are urgently calling on anyone with information that could help crack the case to get in touch. If you know something, no matter how small it might seem, please reach out to the station commander of Brits, brigadier Ellen Emmanuel, directly at 082 447 7447. Your tip



ALERT: ARMED SUSPECTS IN **VEHICLES TARGETING RUSTENBURG ROADS**

Rustenburg - Charl Visser, owner of Buffel Sekuriteit, Rustenburg Landelike Diens en Kroondal Plaaswag, has issued a critical warning to the community following concerning reports received in the late hours of Wednesday, 6 March 2024.

In a grave notice to residents and motorists, Visser detailed alarming activities involving three vehicles suspected of orchestrating criminal acts. These incidents, reported around midnight, involve attempts to forcibly stop innocent drivers through a tactic known as "boxing in," potentially leading to hijackings or robberies.

The vehicles in question have been described as follows: a white Nissan Almera with mismatched registration plates – a North West province plate at the front and a Gauteng province (GP) plate at the rear - a silver Toyota Conquest, and a red Nissan 1400 bakkie. These vehicles have been predominantly active along several key routes, including the R104 road towards Kroondal, the Oorsaak road just outside Rustenburg, Modderfontein gravel road, Rex Road,

and Kromrivier road The community is urged to exercise extreme caution, particularly when traveling through these identified areas. Reports indicate that the individuals associated with these

vehicles are armed.

MAN FOUND DECEASED AFTER BOATING INCIDENT AT HARTBEESPOORT DAM

Hartbeespoort - The Hartbeespoort community is mourning the loss of a local resident, Sibusiso Mathew Nchunu, aged 40, following a tragic boating incident near the Caribbean

Estate on Hartbeespoort Dam. Arthur Crewe. the station commander of the National Sea Rescue Institute (NSRI) Hartbeespoort Dam, confirmed their involvement in the search efforts alongside police divers following the report of a man missing since the afternoon of Saturday 9 March 2024.

The initial investigation revealed that Nchunu reportedly fell from a boat and was not seen again, prompting an immediate search operation. Despite the efforts of search teams, the grim discovery of Nchunu's body was made on Monday 11 March 2024, bringing a sad conclusion to the search.

Colonel Adel Myburgh stated, "The body of Sibusiso Mathew Nchunu was recovered by North West Divers. We are currently conducting a judicial inquest into the circumstances surrounding his death.

The community and authorities extend their deepest sympathies to the family and friends of Nchunu during this difficult time.


MURDER SUSPECT SOUGHT, R50,000 REWARD OFFERED FOR INFORMATION

Thekwane/ Rustenburg - The North West Provincial Organised Crime Unit is urgently seeking information leading to the arrest of 42-year-old Pedro Francisco Cossa, a Mozambique national, in connection with a murder case. A substantial reward of R50,000 is being offered to anyone who can provide information that results in Cossa's arrest and successful conviction.

The case revolves around the tragic death of 42-year-old Stephen Moagi, whose life was abruptly ended in the early hours of Wednesday, 19 April 2017. Moagi was returning home from work, driving between Sun City and Thekwane, just outside Rustenburg, when his journey turned fatal. According to police reports, an unidentified vehicle approached Moagi's car, and without warning, the occupant(s) of the vehicle opened fire. The gunfire resulted in Moagi being fatally wounded; his body was later discovered inside his vehicle by a passerby.



MASSIVE COUNTERFEIT **GOODS BUST IN RUSTENBURG:** OVER R8 MILLION SEIZED

Rustenburg - In a major crackdown on counterfeit merchandise, Rustenburg police, along with various crime-fighting partners, conducted an integrated operation on Thursday 29 February 2024, resulting in the seizure of counterfeit goods valued at over R8 million. Additionally, two suspects have been detained in connection to this raid.

The operation was a concerted effort by the South African Police Service (SAPS), the South African Revenue Service (SARS) officials, Customs, Brand Protectors, and security personnel.

Lieutenant colonel Amanda van Wyk reported that the team acted on intelligence regarding several Rustenburg shops implicated in the distribution of counterfeit products. The execution of a search and seizure warrant led to the discovery of a vast array of fake items, including clothing, shoes, caps, and bags. Alongside the counterfeit goods, over R30,000 in cash was also recovered during



The apprehended suspects are expected to face charges under the Counterfeit Goods Act 37 of 1997, with one suspect additionally charged for violating the Immigration Act 13 of 2002.

This recent operation is part of a broader initiative by the SAPS' National Counterfeit Goods Unit, which has, since its inception in November last year, confiscated counterfeit goods exceeding R200 million in value and over R1 million in cash across various parts of the country.

OPERATION SHANELA: A SWEEP THROUGH THE STREETS OF NORTH WEST

North West – Operation Shanela has once again demonstrated the unwavering commitment of law enforcement agencies in the North West. From Thursday 7 March to Sunday 10 March 2024, the operation resulted in the apprehension of 974 individuals for a variety of offenses.

The operation, meticulously planned and executed, targeted a broad spectrum of criminal activities. Arrests were made for serious offenses including rape, murder, and assault with intent to inflict grievous bodily harm (GBH), alongside crimes such as malicious damage to property, burglary of residential and business premises, drug possession, theft from motor vehicles, and driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs. A notable

portion of those detained, numbering 258, were sought for contact crimes including murder, attempted murder, rape, assault GBH, common assault, house robbery, and business robbery, highlighting the operation's focus on curtailing violent crimes.

Lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani shed light on the multi-faceted approach employed during Operation Shanela. Law enforcement officers conducted stop and search operations, established roadblocks and vehicle checkpoints, inspected licensed liquor premises and second-hand goods dealerships, and traced wanted suspects, among other proactive measures. These efforts were not only aimed at apprehending suspects but also at preventing further crimes.

The operation also led to significant seizures, including drugs like mandrax tablets and powder, crack cocaine, crystal meth, heroin, nyaope, and dagga, as well as precious metals and 10 handguns. These confiscations represent a blow to the illegal drug trade and criminal networks operating within the North West.

In a statement, the provincial police commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwena, lauded the dedication and hard work of all involved officers and partner agencies.



Rustenburg - The South African Police Service (SAPS) has expressed serious concerns over a viral social media post that claims the discovery of puppies with human-like features in Zinniaville, Rustenburg. The post, which gained significant traction on Wednesday, 13 March 2024, suggests a gardener found a dog and its puppies, which allegedly possess human characteristics, with accusations pointing towards the homeowner.

Colonel Adéle Myburgh, has categorically denied these allegations. "We want to make it clear that no such incident has been reported to the police in Tlhabane. The circulating post is entirely baseless and misleading," stated colonel Myburgh. She further emphasised the importance of verifying information before sharing it, to prevent the spread of falsehoods that could lead to unwarranted panic and confusion within the community.



Cheeky visitors: Rustenburg's baboon brigade causes backyard chaos

Rustenburg - The tranquillity of communities In cases where a baboon or monkey poses Platinum Weekly received a couple of reports from concerned residents about baboons and monkeys rummaging through their neighbourhoods, creating chaos and fear.

One person told us how scared she is because of these animals. She's so afraid that she doesn't even want to go outside anymore, which means her kids can't play in their yard.

In response to the growing concerns, we consulted an expert in the field: Vasti Botha, a Damage Causing Animals (DCA) official. Botha explained, "The primary reason these animals venture into human habitats is their search for food. Attractions such as fruit trees and unsecured garbage bags prove irresistible to them. We continuously urge the community to manage waste responsibly. It's crucial to understand the potential danger baboons pose, capable of inflicting serious injuries. There have been instances where they have attacked and consumed small to medium-sized pets."

Botha offered advice on how to safely deter these unwelcome visitors: "Direct confrontation with baboons or blue monkeys is highly discouraged. An effective, non-harmful deterrent can be a garden hose with a strong stream of water. For those encountering these primates in their yards, it's advisable to bring pets indoors and remain inside until the area is clear. Additionally, small fireworks (those green and red ones) can serve as a scare tactic."

She also highlighted the counterproductive nature of feeding wildlife, a practice that inadvertently lures baboons and monkeys. "While the intention might be to feed birds or other garden wildlife, such actions unfortunately attract these primates."

Moreover, Botha emphasised the importance of securing homes against potential intrusion: "Ensure doors and windows are locked when leaving the house to prevent any unwelcome entries.




