abandoned mine shaft. Why? For a little spot of illegal mining, of course!

The 65-year-old homeowner, Nthabisseng Tsimane, along with his 31-year-old accomplice, Tshepang Evans Kgasago, were arrested and appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday, 9 September 2024. Their charges? Oh, just the usual illegal mining, tampering with infrastructure, and possession of stolen goods. Their bail application was postponed to 16 September 2024. Let's see if they can dig themselves out

Lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani reported that the Tlhabane Visible Policing, the Royal Bafokeng Tactical Team, and the Rustenburg Public Safety teams swooped in during the early hours of Thursday 5 September 2024. Acting on a tip-off (because apparently everyone knows about these things), they uncovered the illegal mining operation at Nkandla informal settlement near Khuseleka

The homeowner had allowed his guests to turn one of the bedrooms into a gateway to illegal mining, giving them direct access to a mine shaft. And when the police came

knocking? The rest of the gang escape straight into their DIY tunnel.

But they were finally nabbed. Eight more zama-zamas, aged 16 to 45, were arrested between 6 and 7 September 2024 after hiding underground to avoid capture. Apparently, life in a tunnel wasn't as glamorous as it sounds, so as soon as they re-surfaced, they were

Out of the 10 arrested suspects, four are South African, and six are foreign nationals, all set to make their court appearance. With the help of mine security, police also found stolen equipment in the house.

Rustenburg is a known hotspot for illegal mining. Not long ago, on 20 August 2024, a mine collapse at Tlhatlhaganyane Village left one zama-zama missing while 31 others managed to escape. And on 7 August 2024, a joint operation led to the arrest of five illegal miners who were caught dealing in unwrought precious metals worth R350 million.

Illegal mining. It's everywhere. It's dangerous, unregulated, and let's face it - it's robbing our local mines blind.

It's negatively affecting our economy. In the long run it is a threat to job security at legal mines who have to mine at much higher costs because of safety and other regulations and because they pay tax, while zama-









#### **RAPIST SENTENCED TO LIFE IMPRISONMENT**

Rustenburg - The Rustenburg Regional Court handed down a life imprisonment sentence to a 34-year-old Lesotho national on Monday, 2 September 2024, for the brutal rape of an 11-year-old girl in Sereleng New Stands, Boitekong.

The crime, which took place in May 2022, left the local community shaken. The young girl was on her way home from school when the perpetrator, a trusted acquaintance of the family, coerced her into accompanying him. A vigilant neighbour saw them walking together and, sensing something was wrong, alerted the victim's aunt. Swift action by the girl's uncle and the neighbour led them to search the area and their worst fears were confirmed when they found the suspect inside an abandoned shack, still assaulting the child. Upon discovery, the suspect fled the scene.

The girl was rushed to the hospital, and the police were quickly notified. The suspect was located and handed over to the police on 12 May 2022. He has remained in custody since his arrest. Further investigation revealed that the abuse had been ongoing, with the suspect beginning his assaults as early as March 2022. The provincial police commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwena, and director of Public Prosecution, Dr. Rachel Makhari, praised the Sereleng community for their assistance in capturing the criminal. They also extended heartfelt congratulations to investigating officer, sergeant Mmathapelo Sebogodi, and prosecutor Aubrey Mataboge for their tireless efforts in securing this important conviction.





## **Police appeal** for help in identifying 38 unclaimed **bodies**

**Brits** – Detectives from the Bojanala Platinum Sub-District 1: Brits area, are appealing to the community for assistance in identifying approximately 38 unknown bodies currently at the Brits Forensic Pathology Mortuary, located within the Brits Police Station.

According to lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani, most of these bodies are of men who were discovered at various locations in and around Brits between 2021 and 2024. These bodies were recovered from areas including Rabokala Village, Klipgat River, Letlhabile, Mamogaleskraal, Bila Mine Elandskraal, Damonsville. Majakaneng, Cyferskuil, Bapong, Marikana, Madidi, and Rooikoppies

The police are urging anyone who might have information that could help in identifying these individuals to come forward.

# WANTED **SUSPECT FATALLY** WOUNDED IN SHOOT-OUT

Rustenburg - A 30-yearold wanted suspect was fatally wounded during a shoot-out with the police on Sunday evening, 8 September 2024, in Mogwase.

According to a police report, the suspect, a Lesotho national, was traced

a local tavern after police received regarding his whereabouts. When police officers arrived, the suspect allegedly opened fire on them. Officers returned fire, resulting in the fatal wounding of the suspect.

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone confirmed that the deceased was found in possession of a stolen firearm reported missing from Linden, Gauteng. The suspect had been on the run, wanted for multiple crimes, including attempted murder, common robbery, and assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm. These offenses were reportedly committed between January 2023 and July 2024 in Zone 8, Mogwase.

Further investigations revealed that the deceased also had two pending murder cases dating back to July 2021 in Robega village and Phokeng, outside Rustenburg.

The Independent Police Investigative Directorate (IPID), also known as the Hawks, is conducting an investigation into the incident.

# **ATM BOMBING FAILED:** THIEVES TURN TO LOOTING

Rustenburg - Chaos erupted in the early hours of Sunday, 8 September 2024, at the Shell Garage Kroondal Eastbound on the N4. A group of twelve assailants attempted to bomb the automated teller machine (ATM) at the garage but failed, leading to a chaotic scene inside the convenience store.

"They tried to bomb the ATM three times, but failed," confirmed garage owner Ettienne De Villiers, describing the tense moments during the robbery.

Frustrated by their failed bombing attempts, the criminals turned to looting, grabbing items at random. From toothpaste and sugar to cigarettes and cash, they left a trail of destruction before fleeing the scene.



## **Tragic accident** claims life of young driver

Rustenburg - A heartbreaking accident on Thursday evening, 5 September 2024, claimed the life of a young man after his car veered off the road and crashed into a large tree at the top of a mountainous pass on the Rhenosterfontein road, just outside Rustenbura.

The wreckage went unnoticed until the following morning, Friday, 6 September 2024, when a local resident made the devastating discovery. The resident, on his way to work shortly after 06:00, came across the overturned vehicle. Tragically, it was confirmed that the young man driving the car had lost his life at the scene.


The resident immediately called emergency services. "It was a sobering moment. I found the car on its side, and I think he might have swerved to avoid something before crashing into the tree. Judging by how cold the engine was, it seems the accident happened the night before," he said, reflecting on the tragedy.

# **Squatters Take Over** Zendeling Park, Community Concerned

Rustenburg - Platinum Weekly newspaper rob, and plunder. Guests who stop here have their received a troubling message from the public increasing presence of squatters at the open field park located on the corner of Zendeling and Boom Streets. What was once a small, communityfriendly park has now become a hub for makeshift tents, litter, and unrest.

A long-time resident shared his concerns: "The squatters have since started setting up tents, living there, and littering freely. We are soon going to have a fully established squatter camp right on our doorstep. On Sunday mornings, there are 40+ people bathing, barbecuing, and doing laundry in the park. We bought our property here 20 years ago, and back then, it was a little park where the kids played and rode go-karts. Now, as adults, we can't even risk stepping outside the yard."

The resident continued, describing the insecurity they now face: "Our yard is fenced so high that I can't even see outside from inside the property that the municipality has begun addressing the anymore, yet perps still come over the wall to steal,

car doors ripped open or items stolen off their trucks on Thursday 5 September 2024, reporting the as fast as you can say 'knife,' all while they are still sitting in their vehicles. They pull out knives, block you from reversing out of your driveway, and even damage your property.'

> The situation has reached the point where community members are calling for action, but little progress has been made.

> DA Ward 18 councillor, Cobus Nortje, expressed frustration: "I have been reporting this case since 2023. This has been an ongoing concern that has yet to be resolved. We are not getting any feedback. What is the way forward?"

> Ward 18 committee member, Kobus Ferreira, echoed the sentiment, stating, "I have sent the complaint on behalf of Ward 18. It is supposed to be a park. There are many children in the area with all the flats. Where do they play now?"

> As of Wednesday, 11 September 2024, it appears problem. Ferreira told Platinum Weekly, "I see the



Rustenburg Local Municipality has started cleaning up the open field. It looks much better now, but for how long?'

The North West Provincial Legislature invites nominations for the position of Integrity Commissioner. Members of the Public and Organisations are invited to submit nominations. The Integrity Commissioner shall perform duties specified under the Code of Conduct and Ethics for Members of the North West Provincial Legislature which include among others:

- investigate any alleged violation of the Code of Conduct and Ethics upon receiving a complaint or on his or her own accord, and providing reports on the results of the investigation to the relevant structure of the Legislature,
- develop and maintain a Register of Member's interests,
- provide personal advice and counsel to Members of the Legislature regarding the Code;
- develop and implement systems in the Office of the Integrity Commissione
- perform any other work as required in terms of the Code of Conduct and Ethics,
- provide quarterly and annual reports to the Executive Authority on the work performed.

#### The candidate must be a woman or man who is fit and proper to hold such office, and who:-

- holds a Grade 12 certificate coupled with a minimum NQF level 7 qualification as recognised by SAQA in Administration, Social Sciences or any related qualification,
- · must be 18 years or above.
- shall not hold office in any political party or political organisation,
- shall not be a Member of the National Assembly, permanent delegate to the National Council of Provinces or a Member of a Municipal Council,
- · shall not be an un-rehabilitated insolvent,
- · shall not have been declared to be of an unsound mind by a court of the Republic,
- · shall be a person with high discretion and able to maintain confidentiality,
- · shall be independent and impartial,
- · shall be a person of integrity and honesty,
- shall have high knowledge of Ethics.
- possess knowledge of law, public policy, politics and social sciences,
- · has specialised knowledge of or experience, for an accumulative period of at least 10 years, in the administration of justice, law, public administration or public finance; and
- No criminal conviction.

The conditions of service and remuneration of Integrity Commissioner shall be determined by the Speaker. This

## **BUILDING ENVIRONMENTALLY RESISTANT** MODELS THROUGH ECONOMIC BENEFICIATION



The removal of floating plants, such as the water hyacinth, is a Herculean exercise, but it has been successfully tackled through mechanical and manual harvesting methods. After collection at Hartbeespoort Dam, the harvested plants are transported to a beneficiation site, where segregation processes take place in line with detailed waste management plans. Notably, the invasive water hyacinth, classified as waste, is transformed into valuable fertilisers or compost, contributing significantly to the agricultural sector. An effective enzyme (EC) is used to speed up the process and disrupt the molecular memory of the seeds, reducing the likelihood of future plant germination.

This groundbreaking technology has been patented by Hya Matla Organics Pty (Ltd), the appointed service provider responsible for the hyacinth's mechanical and manual removal. Despite the presence of debris that hampers the process, fertilisers can be produced within a matter of days. The harvested plants often contain several impurities, which are meticulously segregated and channelled to the appropriate

In terms of removed substances, the project has yielded the following: 250 hectares of hyacinth, 300 cubic meters of plastic waste, 200 tonnes of general waste, and 200 tonnes of logs and reeds. All of these materials are diverted to specific beneficiation pathways, fostering a circular economy that emphasizes waste valorisation and environmental sustainability. Notably, one tonne of fertiliser was donated to emerging farmers, aligning with the goals outlined in the sustainable development goals (SDGs) and contributing to food security.

This zero-emission initiative not only tackles pollution but also supports the production of biogas from hyacinth and biochar for soil improvement, thereby creating additional employment opportunities. The project extends its economic benefits to other sectors, both directly and

A key focus of the project is to promote a culture of environmental conservation and water resource security, ensuring that communities and industries reliant on the catchment's water supply are protected from pollution.
