### Little Rico: A Premature Fighter Needs Your Help

Rustenburg - Baby Rico Jooste, entered the world far too early on Wednesday 11 September 2024, at Life Peglerae Hospital. Born 10 weeks prematurely, Rico weighed just 1.4 kilograms at birth and was immediately placed in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU), where he has been fighting for his life ever since.

Despite his tiny size, Rico has shown incredible strength, but the challenges continue for him and his family. Two weeks ago, due to financial constraints, Rico was transferred to the Job Shimankana Tabane (JST) Hospital, as the funds and donations required for his medical care at Peglerae Hospital didn't come in as expected. His mother, Monika Jooste, is a housewife, while his father, Micheal du Toit, works to support the family. Rico is now three weeks old and still in the hospital.

The family faces a mounting financial burden, with a hospital bill at Peglerae Hospital amounting to R74,555.68 that needs to be settled. They are reaching out to the community for support during this difficult time

#### TWO BELOVED DOGS SHOT

thrown into a sinkhole on my property like they were garbage.

Rustenburg - A family living on Dinie Estates Road is grieving after a devastating incident in which their two pit bulls, Chase and Railey, were shot and thrown into a sinkhole on their property. The tragic event unfolded when the dogs followed the family's gardener to the back of the yard. Eight gunshots rang out, and the gardener, who witnessed the incident, claimed it was a neighbour who shot both dogs. "My husband heard the shots, and our gardener saw everything," the owner explained. The family has since opened a police case. The neighbour, when confronted, claimed the dogs were aggressive toward his child, which he said prompted him to act. However, the gardener told the owner there was no child present at the time of the shooting.

The family, which includes two sons aged 13 and 6, and a 4-year-old daughter, is struggling to come to terms with the loss. Living on a smallholding without defined fences, the family is familiar with their property's boundaries. The owner noted, "My dogs were within my yard when they were shot. They were

The sinkhole, approximately 8 meters deep and 11 meters in circumference, is located in a densely overgrown area, making the discovery even more painful. "It was as if someone wanted to hide them. They were lying under thick branches, and we couldn't retrieve them easily."

Chase and Railey had been part of the family for about three years, each with their own unique story. Chase, a loving companion, had been adopted after he immediately stole the owner's heart during an errand. Railey, affectionately known as "Jai-Jai," was a gift and

had become inseparable from the family's 6-year-old son, often accompanying him in daily routines. The family is now seeking justice as the investigation into the incident continues.



Rustenburg - Rustenburg is facing a critical transformation, led by the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) in cooperation with the South African Police Service (SAPS), local law enforcement agencies, and private security companies. The campaign seeks to address ongoing issues of lawlessness and disorder, aiming to reclaim the city from rising crime and neglect.

This month's campaign marks a significant step in this journey. It was officially launched on Thursday, 18 September 2024, at the Civic Centre, where stakeholders gathered to pledge their support for the initiative.

Speaking at the event, RLM municipal manager Adv. Ashmar Khuduge underscored the importance of consistency in operations to achieve long-

Adv. Khuduge painted a clear picture of Rustenburg as a city accommodating a diverse population, with some seeking employment while others engage in criminal activity. He was firm in his stance, saying, "It is over with lawlessness," emphasising the municipality's commitment to ensuring Rustenburg is a safer place for residents, businesses, investors, and visitors.

The start of the operation focused on verifying trading licences, health and safety standards, and migration status. Numerous undocumented individuals were arrested, and noncompliant traders and businesses were fined.

The Rustenburg Safer City Campaign is only just beginning, with more partners being engaged as it progresses. This multi-faceted approach is critical to restoring peace, safety, and order, allowing the community to enjoy living in a city free from lawlessness.

### **Fraudulent Matric Certificates Lead to Over R4.5 Million** in Salaries -**Two Accused Face Justice**

Margareth Mokone (46) and Mankwane Suzan Raleru (54), appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Wednesday, 25 September 2024, facing charges of fraud, forgery, and uttering. Their court appearance follows their arrest earlier in the day by members of the Serious Commercial Crime

The charges stem from allegations that both accused submitted fraudulent matric certificates when applying for positions within the North West Department of Education.



Raleru was hired in August 2008 as an early childhood development fieldworker for the Kgetleng River APO after allegedly submitting a matric certificate she claimed to have obtained in 1992. However, investigations revealed that although Raleru did write matric, she never passed. The fraudulent certificate led to her employment, and she earned over R2.3 million in salaries from the department during her tenure.

Similarly, Mokone applied for an administrative assistant role at Kana Primary School in March 2011, allegedly using a forged matric certificate claiming she had completed matric in 1998. Investigations uncovered that she never wrote matric exams, and her fraudulent application resulted in the department paying her over R2.2 million in salaries

Both accused were granted bail of R10,000 each, and the case has been postponed to 14 November 2024 for further investigation.

North West Hawks head, major general Patrick Mbotho, and the director of Public Prosecutions, Dr Rachel Makhari, praised the efforts of the investigation and prosecution teams, ensuring that justice is served in this case.

North-West - A multi-disciplinary Vala Umgodi team apprehended 21 suspected illegal miners in the Bojanala Platinum District on Wednesday, 25, and Thursday, 26 September 2024, for violating section (49) (1) (a) of the Immigration Act, 2002 (Act No. 13 of

Lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani confirmed that the suspects, aged between 20 and 56, were arrested during operations in Tlhatlaganyane, Witrandjie, and Mooinooi. Among the apprehended were 10 Lesotho nationals, five from Mozambique, three from Malawi, one from Ethiopia, one from Zimbabwe, and a South African.

The Vala Umgodi team seized various illegal mining equipment, including generators jackhammers drills, and crowbars.

Provincial police general Sello Kwena commended the Vala Umgodi team for their continued efforts in combating illegal mining in the province.

#### **MORE THAN 5,000 POLICE ACTIONS LEAD TO NEARLY 1,000 ARRESTS IN 7 DAYS**

North West - The South African Police Service (SAPS) in the North West province, through a series of targeted operations for 'Operation Shanela', successfully conducted 5,129 actions between Monday, 23 September 2024, and Sunday, 29 September 2024. These actions led to the arrest of 918 suspects, as police intensified efforts to maintain law and order and apprehend criminals in the province. According to SAPS spokesperson, colonel Adéle Myburgh, the arrests were related to a range of serious offenses. These included murder, attempted murder, assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm, common assault, drug dealing, and illegal liquor trading. Notably, 50 individuals were apprehended for

drug possession, 60 were caught driving under the influence of alcohol, and 83 suspected undocumented individuals were handed over to immigration authorities for processing. A focused effort by detectives during suspect raiding operations led to the arrest of 310 wanted individuals. These raids formed part of broader police actions, which included the search of 222 premises, 1,915 individuals, and 828 vehicles. In addition, police conducted 12 roadblocks, shut down nine unlicensed liquor premises, and inspected 89 legal liquor outlets and 18 second-hand dealers. A range of items, including alcohol, 14 cell phones, ammunition, six handguns, six vehicles, various drugs, and tobacco products, were confiscated.

### 15-YEAR-OLD SENTENCED TO 15 YEARS FOR MULTIPLE CHILD RAPE INCIDENTS IN RUSTENBURG

Rustenburg - In a significant legal outcome, the Tlhabane Magistrates' Court sentenced a 15-year-old boy to 15 years of imprisonment on 1 October 2024, following his conviction for four child rape cases reported over the last three years. The first incident occurred on Monday, 5 September 2022, when a 12-yearold girl was walking home from school. The convict, her classmate, grabbed her



water bottle and ran off. She chased him into a secluded area, where he overpowered and raped her.

On Youth Day, 16 June 2023, an 11-year-old girl was riding her bicycle when the convict offered to repair it. After pretending to test the bicycle in nearby bushes, he attempted to rape her. Fortunately, a passer-by intervened, forcing him to flee.

The third case took place on Tuesday 3 October 2023. An 11-year-old boy was targeted when the convict took his bicycle and led him into nearby bushes, where he overpowered and raped him.

The final and most disturbing incident occurred on Thursday, 1 February 2024, when a 5-year-old girl was playing in a neighbour's yard. The convict lured her behind a shack and raped her.

Provincial police commissioner lieutenant general Sello Kwena commended the efforts of the investigative team, led by seargent Mamotse Moshe of the Provincial Serial and Electronic Crime Investigations Unit, and praised the collaboration between the police and prosecution, which ensured the conviction of the accused.

### **MARIKANA POLICE OFFICER ARRESTED FOR ATTEMPTED MURDER**

officer appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday, 30 September 2024, facing charges of attempted murder.

The officer, a sergeant stationed at the Marikana Police Station, was arrested in the early hours of Friday, 27 September 2024, in Marikana, according to colonel Adéle Myburgh. The arrest followed a shocking incident in which the officer allegedly shot a 22-year-old man in the head after a heated altercation at a tavern in the RDP Section. The confrontation reportedly escalated after reinforcing the police service's the victim flirted with the sergeant's commitment to upholding the law.

Rustenburg - A 47-year-old police girlfriend. The victim was rushed to a local hospital, where he remains in critical condition. A 9mm pistol was recovered at the scene, and the case has been referred to the Independent Police Investigative Directorate (IPID) for further investigation.

The combined efforts of the Rustenburg Local Municipality fire department, Anglo American Platinum Emergency Services, and Working on Fire (WOF) teams, and members from the National Department of Forestry, Fisheries, and Environment, were crucial in fighting the fire.

WOF communications officer, Maria Letsholo, confirmed that 16 firefighters, along with aerial support, were deployed. 'Our teams worked tirelessly day and night to battle this fire, and the support from the public, who provided water and fruit to the firefighters, was greatly appreciated," said Pieter Nel, chief conservation officer at North West Parks and Tourism Board.

#### **Cause and** consequences

The fire resulted in the loss of approximately 3 000 hectares of parkland, equivalent to about 60% of the



"These rituals have been the cause of multiple fires in the park, and this time, the destruction has been immense," said Nel. Despite the devastation, Malefo remains hopeful about the park's recovery. "There are still pockets of grazing land left, and the vlei area is already greening up, providing food for the animals in the short term," he added.

# up in flames in coordinated attack

Rustenburg – In the early hours of Tuesday morning, 1 October 2024, a total of 23 buses were reduced to ashes in a suspected arson attack. The buses, with an estimated combined value of R69 million, were destroyed in a coordinated strike across two Bojanala Bus Depots

At Chaneng Bojanala Bus Depot, six buses were torched, while at Tlaseng Bojanala Bus Depot, 17 buses were set ablaze. The possible motive behind the attack stems from the expulsion of 76 bus drivers since June for theft and other related offenses, with additional drivers currently facing disciplinary hearings.

Police are investigating cases of malicious damage to property, though no arrests have been made yet.

The North West MEC for Community Safety and Transport Management, Wessels Morweng, condemned the attack and urged the police to prioritise their investigation. "We trust our police to investigate this matter thoroughly, but it's also crucial for the public to share any information that could assist in solving this case," said Morweng.

He further expressed concern about the impact of the attack on the community, as the Bojanala Bus Company provides vital subsidised commuter services to residents across the Bojanala District. "This unfortunate incident will undoubtedly affect the daily lives of community members who rely on these buses," added the MEC.

### Devastating **Rietfontein Fire Destroys Family Home**

Rustenburg - On Thursday, 26 September 2024, the Dewandeler family's home in Rietfontein tragically burned down after a fast-moving field fire swept through the area, driven by strong winds. Despite the house being built of rock, its thatch roof stood no chance against the blaze.

Olivier and Delphine Dewandeler were at work, while their son Patrick was visiting a friend in Cullinan. Concerned for his family. Patrick called his sister Adriel at around 14:15, asking her to check on their parents' home as he had heard about the fire. By the time Adriel was on her way, their father called to say the devastating news: the house had already burned down. "The smoke was so thick that you could not even see the house." Adriel recalls.

The Dewandeler family lost one of their beloved pit bulls, Babloo, in the fire, while their other dog, Chocolate, thankfully

survived by hiding.

The two-bedroom house, with an open-plan kitchen, lounge, dining, and bar area, was home to Olivier, Delphine, and Patrick. Sadly, the house was insured, but none of the contents inside were covered. "Everything has been lost. There is absolutely nothing left," said Adriel. "Photos of us as kids, my parents' wedding photos, all my mom's things, all of my dad's things, and all of my brother's things have turned to ash.'

To add to their heartbreak, the family received no immediate assistance. "We had to let the house burn out," said Adriel. "By the time the fire brigade arrived, our house was completely
