

Building Hope: Christ's House of Safety Nears Completion

Swartruggens – The Christ's House of Safety in Swartruggens is on the brink of completing its final phase of expansion, continuing its vital mission of providing refuge for abused women and their children. This centre, born out of a deep need to support vulnerable families, is nearing the end of its construction journey, thanks to the efforts of Stichting Hulpverlening Internationaal Barneveld (SHIB), a Christian non-profit from the Netherlands.

Since its founding, Christ's House of Safety has accommodated 21 children, including six babies, with plans to expand even further.

Phase one of the project laid the initial foundation, and phase two saw the construction of three key rooms — one for boys, one for girls, and a dedicated space for babies — and will also accommodate abused women and their children. Additional facilities, such as an office, kitchen, bathrooms, storage, and a washroom, were also established, transforming the centre into a well-equipped haven for those in need.

A symbol of hope and recovery

The Christ's House of Safety is more than just a physical structure; it represents hope and recovery for the women and children it shelters.


Swartruggens – The Christ's House of Safety in Swartruggens is on the brink of completing its final phase of expansion, continuing its vital mission of providing refuge for abused women. The rooms, furnished with donated items, offer a safe and comfortable environment, with separate spaces for boys and girls to ensure their privacy and well-being.

On 18 October 2024, a new group of SHIB students arrived in South Africa to help with the final phase of the project, which is scheduled to be completed by 2 November 2024. Phase three will focus on finishing the remaining children's rooms

Pastor Venessa Joubert expressed her excitement, saying, "Phase three is already shoulder-height, and soon the building will continue. Together, we can make a significant difference in the lives of many women and children."

This momentous journey has seen several milestones, including the ribbon-cutting ceremony for phase two on 27 July 2024, marking the official opening of Christ's House of Safety.

Founded by pastor Joubert of Agape Church, the centre was established in response to the alarming rise in child abandonment and abuse in the region. Since opening its doors, the centre has had a profound impact on the Swartruggens community.

Rustenburg – What was once a lush and serene retreat in the Magaliesberg has been left scorched after a devastating fire consumed nearly two-thirds of the Kgaswane Nature Reserve. Acting reserve manager, Emelang Malefo, has confirmed that the fire, sparked by ritual activities involving candles, has destroyed approximately 66% of the park.

"A ritual fire ignited on Wednesday, 25 September 2024, has consumed around 3,000 hectares of the reserve," explained Malefo. The fire, which started near Bosbok Kloof, was fuelled by strong winds, causing flames to spread rapidly across the reserve. Despite efforts to bring it under control, it flared up again due to the high Fire Danger Index and adverse weather conditions, ravaging the area

While the destruction has been vast, there has been some relief in the aftermath. "Fortunately, no animals were seriously hurt except for a zebra that had to be humanely euthanised," Malefo added.

However, the loss of grazing land has created a ew challenge. Most of the fe

wildlife in urgent need of food. Malefo urgently appeals to the public for assistance. "If people want to help, we need dry lucerne to feed the animals." The Kgaswane Nature Reserve, spanning over 5,000 hectares, is home to various wildlife, including antelope, jackals, waterbuck, and over 115 bird species. The destruction of the reserve is a tragic blow to both the environment and the community, as it is a cherished destination known for its natural beauty and wildlife diversity.

Despite the devastation, there is hope, thanks to the generosity of the community. On Tuesday, 8 October 2024, Grootbos Voerkrale donated 36,900 kg of silage to the reserve, a much-needed lifeline for the hungry animals. In Touch Therapy Equine also contributed three bales of grass, with founder Karen Spies expressing her gratitude for the opportunity to help. "What a privilege to show compassion to the animals and assist in times of emergency," Spies remarked. Labucon Resources responded to Droogtehulp's plea and provided one

23 Buses Torched: SAPS Offers R50,000 for Information



Rustenburg - The South African Police Service The provincial police commissioner, lieutenant (SAPS) has announced a reward of up to R50,000 for any information leading to the arrest and successful prosecution of those responsible for setting fire to a total of 23 buses at two Bojanala bus depots on the morning of Tuesday,

According to SAPS spokesperson, colonel Adéle Myburgh, two cases of malicious damage to property were reported after six buses at the Bojanala Bus Depot in Chaneng and another 17 buses at the Tlaseng Depot were reduced to ashes. The estimated damage is a staggering R69 million.

Sadly, the red Toyota Tazz, which had three occupants, left no survivors, as all were declared deceased at the scene.

Sun City and Mooinooi Sting: 39 Illegal Mining **Suspects Nabbed**

Sun City/ Mooinooi - Colonel Adéle Myburgh reported that 39 illegal mining suspects were arrested in Sun City and Mooinooi during a coordinated 'Vala Umgodi' operation that took place from Thursday, 3 October to Saturday, 5

Among those arrested, 34 males and five females were taken into custody for contravening Section 49 (1)(a) of the Immigration Act, (Act No. 13 of 2002). Further charges were laid against 10 suspects for illegal mining, while eight were charged with possession of unwrought material.

The suspects appeared before the Brits and Mogwase Magistrates' Courts on Monday, 6 October 2024.

During the operation, police seized a wide array of equipment used in illegal mining activities, including multiple generators, welding machines, water pumps, iackhammers, spades, shovels, and chisels. Also recovered were a MAN truck with two trailers, electrical extension cords, fire extinguishers, and chrome-bearing material. One of the excavators used in the mining operations was also confiscated.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the provincial police commissioner, praised the officers involved, emphasising the importance of such efforts in curbing illegal





operation, including generators, welding machines, water pumps, jackhammers, spades, shovels, and chisels.



Vala Umgodi Operations lead to arrest of 40 Illegal Miners

North West - Forty suspects were arrested during the integrated police 'Vala Umgodi' operations between Sunday, 29 September, and Tuesday, 2 October 2024. The operations were conducted in Hartbeespoort Dam, Mooinooi, Tlhabane, and Sun City.





These young athletes, under the guidance of kancho Albert Venter, have displayed immense dedication and skill, ready to showcase their talent on a global stage.


