Rustenburg – What began as a hot and quiet Sunday afternoon visit to Donkerhoek Cemetery on 3 November 2024, turned into a nightmare as a couple fought for their lives against a ruthless attacker. For many, the Donkerhoek Cemetery has become a place of fear, as assaults here have become disturbingly frequent. The couple — a 54-year-old woman and a 57-year-old man — had just paid their respects at a family member's grave and were walking back to their car when their horror began. Nearing their Volkswagen Polo, they noticed a figure approaching. The man, tall and lean, wore a red and brown striped shirt, chino pants, and a cap. In his hand was an Okapi knife, which he wielded with terrifying intent. The attack was immediate and brutal. Rocks came hurtling toward them, one smashing into the

man's head, nearly knocking him out. The woman tried to flee, but the attacker was relentless. He chased her down, stabbing her in the chest and dragging the blade downward. This wasn't a quick strike; it was violent and deliberate, an attempt to end her life. The man, despite his head wound, fought back to protect his wife, only to be slashed across his face — a cut that stretched from his eye, across his nose, and down his cheek. Blood was everywhere. His attempts to defend them left him with two deep cuts on his arm and a nearly severed middle finger. They truly thought these were their final moments. In excruciating pain and with blood pouring from their wounds, the couple battled on, their desperation mounting. The man grabbed a pot plant in a last, desperate attempt to shield his wife. Together, they finally managed to make it to the car, only for the attacker to pursue them, prying open the door to try to drag the woman out. In a moment of unexpected luck, he saw her handbag and, distracted, fled with it toward Olympia Park Stadium. "If it weren't for that handbag," a family member later said, "they might not have made it out alive." Barely clinging to consciousness, the man drove to his son's house, from where they were rushed to Life Peglerae Hospital. There, the couple underwent multiple surgeries to mend the deep, brutal wounds they had suffered. The woman, who was placed in ICU, joined her husband in recovery early the next morning, while he endured surgery on his mangled finger. Both had lost a tremendous amount of blood. With incidents like this growing all too common, the Rustenburg Crime Combatting Forum (RCCF) has urgently warned the community. "Please, do not go to the Donkerhoek Cemetery alone," urged RCCF chairperson Kobus Ferreira. "Go in a group or make sure you are armed."

To help, RCCF arranges escorts for anyone visiting the cemetery on the last Sunday of each month. The couple received immediate aid from Outdoor Arena Security. Although a case of attempted murder has been opened, no additional information has been shared. The horrific ordeal of this couple leaves the community shaken, questioning why this sacred place has become a hunting ground, and demanding answers to end the haunting violence that plagues the Donkerhoek Cemetery.

TWO CONVICTED RAPISTS SENTENCED

Rustenburg – The provincial police commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwenia, commended two Family Violence, Child Protection, and Sexual Offences (FCS) Unit investigators for securing significant convictions in two separate cases of child rape.

According to police spokesperson colonel Adèle Myburgh, the first case dates back to 2019 in Tlhabane, when a young girl's brave disclosure led to a three-year investigation. The incident came to light when a 10-year-old girl left a heart-wrenching note among her schoolbooks, which her aunt discovered on Thursday, 19 September 2019. In it, the child revealed that her 50-year-old uncle had raped her during the 2016 school holidays when she was just seven years old. After her mother was informed, the young girl confirmed her story, and a police investigation followed. Medical examinations substantiated the claims, resulting in the uncle's arrest.

Following a rigorous trial, the Bafokeng Regional

Court in Tlhabane sentenced the now 58-year-old man to 26 years in prison on Wednesday, 30 October 2024. Sergeant Mmathapelo Sebogodi of Tlhabane FCS played a crucial role in gathering evidence and presenting a solid case that led to this conviction.

In an unrelated case reported at Lethabong Gardens outside Rustenburg, a 12-year-old girl was brutally assaulted after seeking food from a 20-year-old neighbour on Thursday, 22 December 2022. After entering his home, the suspect reportedly dragged the child inside, assaulted her, and then gave her food to eat. Upon her mother's return, the child courageously recounted the horrific incident, prompting a police investigation. The suspect was arrested and denied bail, ensuring he remained in custody until his sentencing on Wednesday, 30 October 2024, when he received a 15-year prison sentence. The court also declared him unfit to possess a firearm under Section 103 of the Firearms Control Act.

27-YEAR SENTENCE FOR TLHABANE TAVERN ROBBER

Rustenburg – The provincial police commissioner, lieutenant general Sello Kwenia, has commended the work of the Tlhabane Detectives Unit after the Bafokeng Regional Court sentenced 24-year-old Siphanyathi Cetwayo to 27 years in prison. The sentence follows a thorough investigation by constable Lindiwe Masilela, working under the mentorship of warrant officer Khomotjo Matlala.

On Monday, 28 October 2024, the court convicted Cetwayo for a brutal robbery that took place on 22 September 2023, when a 32-year-old man was attacked inside a Tlhabane tavern. The victim was stabbed multiple times in the head and back by three suspects, including Cetwayo, who took his cellphone and fled. Emergency responders transported the critically injured man to a nearby health centre, where he received a month of intensive treatment. In a twist of fate, the victim recognised Cetwayo in Tlhabane after his recovery. He promptly alerted the police, leading to Cetwayo's swift arrest and denial of bail at his first court appearance on 31 October 2023.

Cetwayo received the following sentences:

- **Count 1** – Robbery with aggravating circumstances: 12 years imprisonment
 - **Count 2** – Attempted murder: 15 years imprisonment
- Five years of the sentences for Counts 1 and 2 will run concurrently. Additionally, the court declared Cetwayo unfit to possess a firearm under Section 103 (1) of the Firearm Control Act (Act 60 of 2000).

STARVATION DRIVES ILLEGAL MINERS FROM UNDERGROUND: 565 ARRESTED

North West – In a groundbreaking development, the South African Police Service (SAPS), under the leadership of acting national commissioner lieutenant general Shadrack Sibiya, has praised the Vala Umgodi task teams for their determined stance against illegal mining in North West province.

The ongoing operation has already forced 565 illegal miners to resurface from underground due to starvation and dehydration, with arrests continuing.

On 2 November 2024, 225 illegal miners emerged from an underground network in Orkney after being cut off from supplies. In a bid to halt illegal mining activities, the Vala Umgodi teams, led by SAPS and the South African National Defence Force (SANDF), have strategically blocked all routes used to deliver food and other necessities to these illegal operations. In a swift follow-up, an additional 340 miners surfaced on 3 November 2024, bringing the total to 565 detained individuals by midday on Sunday.

Lieutenant general Sibiya commended the commitment of the

task teams, encouraging them to press forward with their efforts to restore the rule of law. "We're witnessing the impact of our operations firsthand. The teams on the ground are delivering remarkable results, and their work is vital to dismantling these illegal networks," he stated.

The Vala Umgodi operation is a part of a broader mission to tackle illegal mining across South Africa. In Stilfontein, another incident on 5 November 2024 saw over 140 illegal miners resurface at the Margaret Shaft. These efforts form a significant part of the SAPS' Dr. Kenneth Kaunda District Illicit Mining Team, aimed at crippling the complex and well-organised networks controlling illegal mining.

Since its launch in December 2023, Operation Vala Umgodi has led to the arrest of over 13,691 suspects across seven illegal mining hotspots, seizing R5 million in cash and uncut diamonds valued at R32 million. The majority of those arrested include South African, Mozambican, Basotho, Zimbabwean, and Malawian nationals.

POLICE OPERATION SNARES SIX SUSPECTS

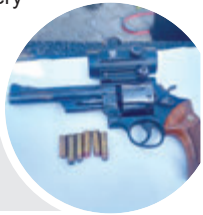
Brits – In a coordinated operation driven by information from Crime Intelligence in the Tshwane District, law enforcement agencies intercepted a grey Mercedes Benz near the Brits Traffic Department on Thursday, 31 October 2024, leading to the arrest of six suspects linked to multiple serious crimes.

The swift action was executed by Brits Crime Intelligence, the Brits Trio Task Team, Hartbeespoortdam Crime Prevention, the Brits Operational Command Centre (OCC), and PPS Security, who worked together to track the vehicle carrying six men. The vehicle was stopped around 14:50, with all occupants thoroughly searched.

Colonel Adèle Myburgh reported that three firearms, some with serial numbers removed, were

found concealed in the vehicle. The suspects, who were unable to account for the firearms, were immediately arrested for possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition. Investigations revealed that the men, aged 20 to 35, have ties to seven other cases, ranging from robbery to murder, reported in Temba and Hammanskraal in Gauteng Province between June and October this year. One of the firearms was linked to a house robbery in Kameeldrift in July 2024.

ATTEMPTED MURDER AND RAPE CASE UNFOLDS IN COURTROOM

Rustenburg – A 56-year-old man, Mogomotsi Mothupi, stood before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday, 4 November 2024, facing charges of attempted murder and malicious damage to property. After a brief court appearance, he was remanded in custody, with his next court date set for Thursday, 7 November 2024.

Colonel Adèle Myburgh shared details of the case, revealing that Mothupi's charges stem from a harrowing incident in Marikana's Mahumapelo

Section late on Tuesday, 6 August 2024. According to reports, Mothupi arrived at his 58-year-old girlfriend's house with a 49-year-old woman. After being invited inside, Mothupi allegedly launched into a violent attack, first smashing property with a hammer before pouring paraffin on his girlfriend and setting her on fire. The situation escalated further when Mothupi reportedly assaulted the 49-year-old woman, allegedly raping her.

After the attack, Mothupi instructed the woman to

pack his girlfriend's belongings, claiming he intended to take her to the hospital. However, he left her injured at a nearby bus stop, where a taxi driver later transported her to a hospital, where she remained for over two months.

Both women have since opened cases against Mothupi. He was initially arrested on rape charges in September 2024 and has been denied bail, with another court appearance scheduled for 20 March 2025.

Six classrooms destroyed in fire at Rauwane Sepeng Secondary School



Firefighters worked tirelessly to control the intense blaze that engulfed six classrooms at Rauwane Sepeng Secondary School.

Rustenburg – A devastating fire broke out at Rauwane Sepeng Secondary School in Tlhabane on Monday 4 November 2024, destroying six Grade 12 classrooms and causing extensive damage. The fire, which spread swiftly through the block, was met with prompt reaction from local firefighters, who managed to evacuate all learners and staff safely. Thankfully, no injuries were reported. The following day, MEC Viola Ntsetsao Motsumi and District Director Dr. Motsei Paledi visited the school to assess the damage firsthand. Their visit underscored a commitment to restoring

a safe learning environment as the North West Department of Education prepares for the 2025 academic year. During the visit, MEC Motsumi expressed her deep concern over the loss of crucial educational infrastructure, especially as Grade 12 learners are currently writing their final exams. "This tragic event, which has destroyed a vital section of our school infrastructure, is a significant setback," she remarked. "With a backlog in school construction projects, our priority is now on rebuilding and ensuring a safe, functional learning space for our students." In the interim, mobile classrooms will be provided to accommodate the affected learners, preventing disruption to their studies. The cause of the fire remains under investigation.

GRANDFATHER BRUTALLY STABBED 12 TIMES IN FRONT OF GRANDDAUGHTER IN SAFARI GARDENS

Rustenburg – On Monday, 21 October 2024, an ordinary afternoon turned into a nightmare for an elderly man and his granddaughter. At around 15:00, the man had just taken his granddaughter to a math tutor's house for extra lessons, with his other granddaughter, aged 12, waiting in the car with him in Safari Gardens. A man approached the driver's side, asking the elderly man if he had any food to spare. The response was simple: "No, I don't have any food with me." The man's gaze, however, landed on a piece of chocolate inside the car, which led to another request: "May I have the chocolate?" The elderly man apologised, explaining that only two blocks remained.

After this brief exchange, the man vanished. The elderly man resumed a casual conversation with his granddaughter. Moments later, their sense of safety was shattered. The same man suddenly reappeared, this time armed with a khaki knife, leaping from behind a tree. In a flash, the situation turned violent. "He stabbed me," the elderly man recalls, his voice shaking. He tried to dodge the blade, but the assailant relentlessly attacked, stabbing him a total of 12 times. The man forced open the car door, and amidst the chaos, the victim's phone fell to the floor. As he bent down to retrieve it, the assailant continued his assault, eventually grabbing the phone and the elderly man's wallet.

"It was less than a metre away from my granddaughter. She's traumatised. We will never be the same after this incident," he shared. The attack left the man hospitalised, spending five days in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) followed by four days in a physical rehabilitation department. Now, three weeks later, he continues to struggle with soreness and bruises all over his body. A case was opened with the South African Police Service (SAPS), though obtaining a case number has proven difficult.
