21-month-old boy. During the terrifying ordeal, the toddler was given a packet of Flings (crisps) and milk. In a heartbreaking moment of innocence, the child started feeding his helpless father some of the Flings as he lay bound on the floor.



Rustenburg – A father's primary duty is to protect his family, especially his children. But all sense of security was shattered for a young father on Friday morning, 15 November 2024, in broad daylight, when armed intruders invaded his home on a smallholding.

It was just before 09:30 when two men, armed and wearing balaclavas and gloves, used a crowbar to force open the security gate of the kitchen door and stormed into the house. According to an eyewitness, one of the intruders was tall and thin with a light complexion, while the other was short and dark-skinned. The father and the nanny immediately raised their hands, surrendering to the masked men. It is hoped that the toddler did not fully comprehend the nightmare unfolding around him.

The father was struck once with the crowbar and then repeatedly tapped on the head with a gun as the robbers voiced their demands, spitting out threats each time they didn't get the response they wanted. With every threat, his thoughts were consumed with fear for the safety of his son. He cooperated fully, handing over the information they sought, praying that his compliance would keep his child safe. See page 8


75-YEAR-OLD **ARRESTED FOR RAPE**

Rustenburg - The Bafokeng Sexual Offences Regional Court in Tlhabane has sentenced a 75-year-old man, Themba Moya, to 20 years in prison for the rape of a minor. The sentence was handed down on Wednesday, 6 November 2024.

The court heard that on Sunday, 4 June 2023, Moya called 15-year-old Tshwetso Letshaba, his neighbour in Lethabong near Rustenburg, to his house under the pretence of needing her help. Upon her arrival, he led her into his bedroom, where he raped her. The incident was reported to the police, and Moya was arrested shortly afterward.

Tragically, brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone revealed that the young victim took her own life just weeks after the incident.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, North West provincial commissioner, commended the investigative team led by detective-sergeant Letshabang Mzinyathi, as well as the public prosecutor, advocate Dzimema, for their tireless efforts in securing Moya's conviction.



JUSTICE IN JEOPARDY: FAKE LAWYER'S CASES **PUT COURT RULINGS** IN QUESTION

Rustenburg - The Tlhabane Magistrate Court has postponed the case against Teboho Johannes Motse (41) to 15 November 2024 to allow him time to secure legal representation, enabling the court to proceed with his bail application.

Motse was arrested by the Provincial Commercial Crime Investigation Unit (CCIU) on Wednesday, 6 November 2024, for charges of uttering, forgery, and contravening the Legal Practice Act, 2014. The postponement followed his brief court appearance on 14 November 2024, after his initial legal representative failed to appear.



Teboho Johannes Motse, accused of uttering and posing as a lawyer, awaits his next court appearance in a high-profile legal fraud case.

According to court records, Motse is accused of posing as an attorney and conducting legal duties without proper credentials. Investigations revealed that he appeared in court as a legal representative on 26 September 2023 in Tlhabane, issuing instructions and executing proceedings without being registered under Act 28 of 2014.

Further probes unveiled that on 30 January 2023, Motse unlawfully represented clients, obstructing justice by posing as a qualified attorney. He allegedly presented a forged certificate of admission and offered legal services at the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court, handling both civil and criminal matters despite lacking the necessary qualifications.

A case was registered in July 2023, leading to his arrest and initial appearance in the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Friday, 8 November 2024. Motse remains in custody while investigations continue.

The allegations raise serious concerns about the integrity of cases he previously handled. With his credentials now under scrutiny, many are questioning whether the rulings in those matters will stand or be reopened

AfriForum and Matlabas Custodians clinches a cooperation agreement to strengthen community safety

AfriForum and Matlabas Custodians signed a cooperation agreement on Thursday, 14 November 2024, which aims to promote community safety in Limpopo, North West and Gauteng. This cooperation agreement provides several opportunities to start strategic projects such as the expansion of information networks and to exercise contingency plans on a regular basis in order to promote guick and efficient action.

Furthermore, this partnership also includes an air wing component that aims to respond more quickly to farm attacks and other crimes. These operational improvements will make communities resilient and strengthen them in the face of various security challenges.

The organisations will also pool their extensive specialist knowledge and advanced technology such as drones to achieve their goal. This technology will help monitor large and remote areas to ensure faster response and provide critical information to emergency crews. Training and expanding capacity are now a priority for the organisations as both organisations have targeted plans in place to equip community members with practical skills and strategic insights.

According to Llewellynn Hemmens, AfriForum's district coordinator for Greater Pretoria North, this collaboration is a milestone for both organisations. "The relationship of trust that AfriForum and Matlabas Custodians have already built is of crucial importance."

"We know that the path to sustainable security in our communities is built on a strong foundation of cooperation and a common goal. Together we can build a network that makes a significant difference in people's lives and that creates hope for a safer future."

"The strengthening of this circle of support is the realisation of 'standing together' by ordinary people who have the community's safety



Two Students Stabbed, Grade 12 **Learners Transferred for Exams**

Rustenburg - The North West Department and staff. The MEC emphasised the importance of Education has swiftly responded to violent of providing a secure learning environment, incidents at Meriti Secondary School in especially during the critical examination period. Rustenburg on Tuesday, 12 November 2024. To ensure a safe and calm environment for the Two learners, one from Grade 9 and another from Grade 12 learners, the North West Department of Grade 10, were stabbed in separate but related incidents believed to be linked to gang violence. The incident unfolded when a learner was attacked outside the school premises by a gang of four individuals, reportedly former students of Meriti Secondary School. The learner fled towards the school for safety, but the gang followed and stabbed another learner inside the school grounds. Both students were rushed to local hospitals, with one sustaining four stab wounds. The Department has assured that both learners will be allowed to complete their examinations once they are medically cleared.

In response to these violent events, North West MEC for Education, Viola Motsumi, convened an urgent meeting with the school governing body (SGB), parents, and the school management on Wednesday, 13 November 2024. The meeting aimed to address safety concerns and implement immediate measures to prevent further incidents. During the meeting, MEC Motsumi announced that four security personnel would be deployed to Meriti Secondary School starting Thursday, 14 November 2024, to ensure the safety of students

Education relocated 281 learners and 10 teachers from Meriti Secondary School to Swartruggens Gekombineerde Skool in Swartruggens to write their remaining examination papers. This move took place on Sunday, 17 November 2024, in light of the violent events at the school.

To further support the learners, the Department arranged for meals to be served three times a day, provided accommodation to allow effective studying, and ensured 24-hour security at the new examination centre. MEC Motsumi also confirmed that Meriti Secondary School would receive four full-time security personnel to help maintain safety on the premises.

"We are committed to ensuring that our learners are safe and able to complete their examinations without disruption," MEC Motsumi concluded.

The Department of Education remains dedicated to ensuring a safe learning environment for all students and educators, continuing to collaborate with law enforcement and other stakeholders to address violence in schools and provide the necessary security during the examination period and beyond.

Family Survives Terrifying Armed Robbery in Olifantsnek

Rustenburg - In the early hours of Friday, 15 November 2024, a family in the Olifantsnek Dam area faced a harrowing ordeal when armed robbers broke into their home

Around 3 a.m., the couple was asleep in their bedroom, while their two children, aged 9 and 10, were in their respective rooms. Their brave dog, Vlooi, a crossbreed with a Dachshund, became their first line of defence, barking persistently just as the robbers entered the house.

Recalling the moment, the woman said. "Vlooi and I had been lying in bed for about 10 minutes. Just as we were closing our

eyes, I heard a bump. At first, I thought it was my husband bumping into the bedside table. But when Vlooi jumped up barking, I saw two robbers standing in front of me with flashlights pointed at me."

The situation quickly escalated when one of the robbers attempted to silence Vlooi. "Suddenly, a firearm was pointed at me," she recounted. "I only saw the front of the gun before I jumped behind my husband, who was standing against the wall. We don't have a weapon, but my husband shouted in English, 'Give me the gun!' I handed him our steel flashlight the only thing we had to defend ourselves. When the robber tried to shoot the dog, the gun just made a clicking sound. Luckily, it wasn't loaded."

The couple's 10-year-old son stood frozen behind the bedroom door, while their 9-year-old daughter remained asleep throughout the terrifying

As one of the robbers attempted to reload the gun, the husband banged the flashlight against the wall, creating a loud noise that startled the intruders. The robbers fled the house in haste.

The robbers were described as wearing a brown jacket with a black beanie and a brown hunting jacket with blue mining pants.

The woman shared a chilling detail: "Our son said one of the robbers was rummaging through the fridge, looking for food. They didn't search the rest of the house. They went straight to our bedroom. Thankfully, they didn't see our son standing nearby."

Grateful for their safety but deeply shaken, the family has since installed security alarms and plans to relocate. "We thank the Lord for sparing our lives," the woman said. "The robber's gun didn't work at that moment. I truly thought we were all going to die that morning."

For now, they remain determined to protect their children and move forward from the traumatic event.

Masked, armed robbers strike Rustenburg garage

Rustenburg - A local garage in Rustenburg was the target of an armed robbery in the early hours of Saturday morning, around 00:30. Five masked men, armed with handguns, carried out the attack, leaving staff shaken but fortunately unharmed.

The robbers escaped in a grey charcoal Volkswagen Polo, making off with cigarettes, disposable vapes, cash from the register, and the staff's cellphones. The manager of the garage explained, "They were wearing masks, so you could

not identify the suspects. Luckily, no customers were in the store or outside at that time, and no one was hurt."

Four staff members were on duty during the robbery. After the incident, they had to rely on a local casino nearby to borrow a phone and contact their management, as their personal phones were stolen.

The private security, Wesalarms, quickly responded to the scene. "Wesalarms arrived and phoned the police. Thank you for your speedy reaction, Wesalarms," the manager added.

The police are investigating the robbery, and the public is urged to provide any information regarding the suspects or the grey Volkswagen Polo.

Van soldaat tot burgemeester: Die merkwaardige lewenspad van Oom Charlie



Giant potholes, a 'growing' concern



Rustenburg - On Monday, 18 November 2024, Platinum Weekly newspaper received a video showing vehicles slowly navigating massive potholes, some of which were so deep they almost submerged entire tires in water. The video, shared by a concerned local resident, sparked alarm across the community.

To investigate the matter, our team visited the area on Wednesday, 20 November 2024. Upon arrival, we discovered that a section of the road had been taped off, indicating that it had become too dangerous for vehicles to pass. The damaged road is a critical connector between a residential area and the R510, and it has been in this poor state for nearly four months.

Local resident Christoff Muyatso, who uses this road daily, expressed his frustration. "This stretch of road has been in this condition for months. It's not just inconvenient, it's damaging our cars. And with the water, you can't even tell how deep the potholes really are," Muyatso said.

In the video shared with us, vehicles can be seen cautiously driving through the potholes, with water spilling over the sides as they try to avoid further

damage. However, by the time our team arrived on site, the road had been barricaded to prevent more cars from passing through.

With the rainy season now in full swing, the situation has only worsened. The ongoing rainfall is causing the potholes to deepen and fill with water, making it even harder for drivers to navigate and increasing the risk of accidents.

Platinum Weekly Newspaper has reached out to the Rustenburg Local Municipality for comment on any plans to address the road's condition. At the time of publication, we are still awaiting a response.

Municipality Condemns Vandalism and Acts of Sabotage at **Substations**



Rustenburg - The Rustenburg Local Municipality is alarmed and deeply disturbed by the alarming rise in sabotage and vandalism targeting its municipal substations. EXPLOSIVES, FIREARMS (ONE SELF-MADE), AND HYDROPONIC DAGGA BUST

the fight against drug trafficking and illegal arms manufacturing took place on Thursday, 14 November 2024, when a joint operation by the Drug Task Team, BIU Security Company, and Provincial Organised Crime Unit uncovered a hydroponic dagga lab in Vyfhoek, Potchefstroom.

During the operation, police discovered dagga plants with an estimated street value of R10 million. In addition, the team seized two rifles — one self-made — along with ammunition and three self-made explosive devices, including two hand grenades and a small pipe bomb.

Colonel Amanda Funani confirmed that the raid, conducted with a search warrant, targeted a smallholding in the area. Inside, authorities uncovered a sophisticated hydroponic dagga lab, illustrating the Extortion Hotline at 080 091 1011.


Potchefstroom – A significant breakthrough in scale and organisation of the operation.

Michael Cilliers (29), the individual arrested at the scene, appeared before the Potchefstroom Magistrates' Court on Tuesday, 19 November 2024. He faces charges of unlawful possession of firearms and explosives as well as cultivating and dealing in dagga. He was remanded in custody, with his next court date set for Wednesday, 4 December 2024.

Lieutenant general Sello Kwena, the provincial police commissioner, praised the operation, emphasising that it sends a strong message.

Members of the public are encouraged to report any criminal activities anonymously via the SAPS Crime Stop number (08600 10111) or the MySAPS application. Extortion-related incidents can also be reported on the

Father Tied Up and Held at Gunpoint in Front of **Toddler**

Rustenburg - A father's primary duty is to protect his family, especially his children. But all sense of security was shattered for a young father on Friday morning, 15 November 2024, in broad daylight, when armed intruders invaded his home on a smallholding.

It was just before 09:30 when two men, armed and wearing balaclavas and gloves, used a crowbar to force open the security gate of the kitchen door and stormed into the house. According to an eyewitness, one of the intruders was tall and thin with a light complexion, while the other was short and dark-skinned. The father and the nanny immediately raised their hands, surrendering to the masked men. It is hoped that the toddler did not fully comprehend the nightmare unfolding around him.

The father was struck once with the crowbar and then repeatedly tapped on the head with a gun as the robbers voiced their demands, spitting out threats each time they didn't get the response they wanted. With every threat, his thoughts were consumed with fear for the safety of his son. He cooperated fully, handing over the information they sought, praying that his compliance would keep his child safe.

With guns in hand, the robbers tied up the father and the nanny before ransacking the house. They took anything of value they could carry to the back door. Among the stolen items were an orange GRIP 6.5KVA generator, a small blue generator, two televisions, two (light blue) setting, the other gold with a topaz (purple) setting), a coin collection, a soundbar, a vacuum cleaner, tools such as a drill and battery-operated screwdriver, two cellphones belonging to the father and nanny, keys to their Jetta, a gas gun, and even the kettle. They packed some of the loot into the family's hard-shell suitcases using sheets and scatter cushions.

However, it wasn't the material loss that left this family shattered - it was the emotional trauma. After binding the father and nanny, the nanny, desperate to comfort the toddler, asked that they fetch Flings (crisps) from the cupboard for him to eat. One of the robbers handed the child a two-litre bottle of cow's milk from the fridge, which the little one couldn't drink, along with a large packet of Flings (crisps). In a heartbreaking moment of innocence amid the chaos, the toddler began feeding his father some of the crisps. The father, recounting the moment in an interview with Platinum Weekly, said: "I prayed like I've never prayed before. When they took my baby and the nanny to another room, I thought the worst. I kept praying for my child's safety.'

Once they had gathered most of the loot, one of the robbers took the remote for the security gate and left. The other staved behind to watch the nanny. A few minutes later, he returned with another intruder, described by an eyewitness as arriving in a grey-blue "what looked like" a Ford Bantam bakkie. The nanny described the third intruder as having a large belly. All three robbers threatened the nanny before leaving the house, saying, "We know where you live."

One of them even loaded his gun in front of the nanny, trying to instil further fear. While the robbers whispered to each other, the nanny overheard one speaking Zulu and the other with a Zimbabwean accent. "He tried to hide the fact that he is Zimbabwean, pretending not to understand English," she

laptops, a black high-performance Intel to save enough money to buy his fiancée Core Ultra PC and screen, a microwave, an an engagement ring. This young couple Xbox, two rings (one gold with an amethyst understands the value of hard work and dedication, but the father, knowing that he escaped the ordeal with his life does little to restore his sense of security.

> As the festive season approaches, this terrifying incident serves as a stark reminder that no one is truly safe. Even in broad daylight, behind security gates and locked doors, criminals can strike. This family's property was fenced, their doors locked yet they still fell victim to these predators. It is evident that the robbery was well planned in advance.

> Most criminals show no hesitation in resorting to firearms and violence, displaying a complete disregard for the harm they inflict on others. Driven by greed, they show no concern for justice or the well-being of those affected. Ironically, the effort and ingenuity they invest in criminal activities could have been channelled into building successful, meaningful lives. Ultimately, their actions reflect the choices they make.

> This incident serves as a warning to all of us. In a world where violent crimes can happen without warning, we must remain vigilant. Our security, awareness, and preparedness must be sharper than ever before.

> "I would like to express my heartfelt thanks to the responding security officers, the first SAPS responders, as well as the other police officials and the forensic team who came to our home. I'm also deeply grateful to those behind the scenes who provided eyewitness testimony and information to SAPS. and the BSO Tactical Team for their vital role in assisting with the investigation. A special thank you to the investigating officer for all the hard work and dedication he's putting into this case," said the father.

> As the criminals drove away, covering their stolen goods with a green shade net, they left behind more than just physical damage. They left a family forever changed.

> At the time of going to print, the victims were informed that two arrests were made and that a court appearance is imminent.

Life-coaching initiative to assist Lighthouse "kids" transition into adulthood



Rustenburg - Crossing the threshold and becoming an "adult" is simultaneously exciting and daunting for most teenagers. It's a life stage where you both question and discover your "self": who you are and why you are here. Taking this next step boldly and intentionally sometimes requires a little bit of expert help and care - which is now being offered to the young adults at the Lighthouse Children's Home.

As an extension of the Iwisa No 1 Fills Good campaign, the oldest teenagers at Lighthouse will be receiving group life-coaching sessions in the build-up to the end of the year. These will equip them with the skills, positivity and resilience they need to start their future journeys with hope and a sense of possibility.

The age of "majority" - when a child turns 18 years old - is a critical turning point for most teenagers. For children at the Lighthouse Children's Home however, it's a defining moment. "In South Africa, as soon as a child turns 18, they become an adult," explains Elsa Doubell, co-founder of Lighthouse Children's Home. "This means that they are no longer able to stay at our current facilities, and will need to find a new home somewhere else.'

This is the challenging reality facing Lighthouse at the moment, and something the collective team of Lighthouse, Three Star Powertrade and Iwisa No 1 are trying to do something about. "When Lighthouse was selected by Three Star Powertrade as the NPO beneficiary of the Iwisa No 1 Fills Good competition, they were very clear from the beginning that all money raised through the campaign would be put towards saving for an exit house for the older children," explains Sibongile Mooko, Premier FMCG Marketing Executive: Milling. "There is an available house next to their current property that they would like to buy. The property is currently on the market."

The amount needed to buy the house is a daunting R600,000 however - needed by the end of November 2024. "We're also mindful that providing a physical space for these young adults is just one aspect of their transition though. One of these is an offer to help prepare the older children for what lies ahead through a life-coaching intervention. Adam Botha from Your Mindful Coach will be working closely with the teenagers at Lighthouse over the next few months. "His sessions will focus them on the realities of adulthood and equipping them with some of the essential life skills they need to step fully and mindfully into this next chapter," explains Doubell. "This will include facilitating discussions around emotional resilience, decision-making, personal responsibility and living meaningful lives of purpose. We want to empower each of these remarkable young people with the knowledge and tools they need to succeed in the real world.

Mooko notes that this intervention speaks directly to the intention of the campaign and to the heart of the Iwisa No 1 brand: "Iwisa No 1 is a legacy brand - built on the power of community in communities where we are privileged to be part of daily life. Our products 'witness' key family moments including children growing up and starting families of our own. 'Fills Good' is all about capturing those moment and amplifying them.
