Rustenburg/ Mooinooi - A 66-year-old man, living a section of the fence which is covered by on a smallholding in the Groenkloof area just outside Mooinooi, was attacked by 7 armed intruders on Wednesday morning, 12 February 2025. The victim shares the house on the smallholding with a roommate who was away at the time of the attack.

At around 6:30 in the morning, he heard a disturbance and stepped outside to investigate. It was an ambush. Seven men of which some were pointing guns, overpowered him and forced their way inside.

They looted his weapons and a night vision device a tool used by many people staying on smallholdings or farms for security. His saving grace was the sound of a vehicle approaching the smallholding. It was a concerned neighbour who reacted after his phone call to the victim was not answered.

In a violent act, the suspects struck him on the head with a pickaxe before fleeing the scene in the direction homes when they hear or notice something out of Majakaneng. Hartbeespoort Emergency Services treated the injured man at the scene. Despite his injuries, he declined hospitalisation.

Prelimenary investigations show that the suspects gained access to the smallholding by crawling under

thick bush. AfriForum Buurtwag chairperson Alie Chamberlain confirmed that SAPS Mooinooi is investigating the case, but that no arrests have been made.

According to Chamberlain, the way in which farmers, and community members staying on smallholdings help protect their neighbours and their farmworkers, has saved many lives. He told Platinum Weekly: "For the vulnerable people staying on remote locations, checking in on your neighbours when something seems off — is more than just community spirit; it's a matter of life and death. They are relying on tight-knit community networks to protect one another."

Chamberlain wishes to remind people staying on smallholdings and farms to not go out of their of the ordinary. 'Rather alert the people on your neighbourhood watch, and SAPS if necessary and stay indoors', he said.

POLICE SEEK PUBLIC HELP IN TRACKING **DOWN ROBBERY AND ASSAULT SUSPECT**

Rustenburg - The South African Police Service (SAPS) is calling on the community for assistance in locating a ride-hailing driver suspected of robbery and sexual assault.



a 25-year-old woman fell victim to a horrifying crime after requesting a ride from Rustenburg's Central Business District (CBD) to East End. According to SAPS spokesperson sergeant

Ofentse Mokgadi, the victim was picked up by a silver or yellowish sedan and seated in the front passenger seat. During the trip, the driver allegedly pulled out a firearm, robbed her of cash, and forced her to make an electronic transfer of additional funds. The ordeal escalated further when the suspect diverted the vehicle toward Bleskop

Following the assault, the victim was forced out of the vehicle before the driver sped off. While she was unable to recall the full registration number, she remembers it containing "574 NW" or "547 NW." Authorities believe the suspect may be of foreign descent.

COPS CRACK **DOWN IN BOITEKONG**

Boitekong/ Rustenburg – A high-impact Safer City operation in Boitekong led to multiple arrests on Friday, 7 February 2025, as law enforcement tackled illegal liquor sales, immigration violations, and unlicensed gambling activities.

Acting Bojanala Platinum Sub-District 2 commissioner, brigadier Mamotsamai Ntoagae, spearheaded the operation, working alongside various stakeholders to enforce compliance in the area. Officers focused on liquor traders, second-hand dealerships, and conducted stop-andsearch procedures along the R510, as well as in Siza and Popo Molefe informal settlements.

"It will take us about two days to fix it," the source estimated, highlighting both the severity of the damage and their commitment to restoring accessibility.

Unfortunately, no feedback from the municipality has been provided at this stage regarding possible repairs or long-term solutions to prevent future flooding and damage.






