Rustenburg - For three decades, Martha Lerm has been a part of the Rustenburg community, dedicating her time, effort, and heart to improving the lives of those around her. Now, she faces one of the toughest battles of her life — a brain tumour that threatens her vision, health, and future. This selfless community champion, a former DA councillor and tireless advocate for service delivery, needs our help.

A life of service

Martha (40) has lived in Rustenburg for most of her life. Her journey started in Vredefort, Free State, where she spent her early years before moving back to Rustenburg in 1995. She attended Hoërskool Grenswag and later pursued her passion for sewing.

In 2016, Martha turned her focus to municipal service delivery, stepping in where authorities failed. She took action, closing open water pipe holes left unattended by the municipality, creating WhatsApp groups to assist with service delivery issues, and liaising with the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) on power, water, and sewage concerns. These groups still exist and are now managed by current councillors, but Martha remains active, forwarding issues and offering support.

Her dedication extended beyond infrastructure. During COVID-19, she spearheaded food parcel distributions to struggling families and used her networks to promote small businesses and handmade products, a service she continues today.

Martha has been married to her husband, Gerrie, for 15 years, and they have been together for 20. They share a 13-yearold daughter, Mia. A talented seamstress and creative spirit, crocheting, Martha enjoys knitting, and sewing — crafting baby mobile toys and other handmade treasures.

confirmed the likelihood of a meningioma brain tumour. While most meningiomas are benign, the effects of Martha's tumour are severe, causing swelling in the brain and pressing against her eye muscle, leading to constant pain and the rapid deterioration of her sight.

Emotionally and physically, the impact has been overwhelming. The tumour's location affects the hypothalamus, which controls emotions, hormones, and the thyroid, resulting

in further health complications. The pain is often unbearable, and everyday tasks, including her seamstress work, have become increasingly difficult.


Despite these challenges, Martha remains hopeful. "There is still so much I want to do. I <mark>want to s</mark>ee my daughter grow up, make her wedding dress, and one day knit sweaters for her children. My life's storybook is not finished yet," she says with determination

The cost of hope

Martha's medical expenses are daunting. Her Old Mutual policy does not cover this type of brain tumour, and the costs already stand at R487,000 — covering hospital fees and MRIs, with additional expenses for the neurosurgeon's quotation still pending.

The Rustenburg community has rallied around her, with businesses stepping up to donate a portion of their sales towards her treatment. A filing cabinet filled with fraudulent documents uncovered by police during the operation. alleged fake sick note syndicate. **FAKE SICK NOTE SCHEME BUSTED IN RUSTENBURG**

Rustenburg - A covert police operation has led to the arrest of a 44-year-old man in Boom Street, Rustenburg, for fraud and corruption. The suspect was apprehended on Thursday, 13 February 2025, following an investigation into fraudulent medical documents.

According to police spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh, the arrest was the result of a meticulous investigation by the Provincial Organised Crime and Commercial Crime Units (the Hawks). Authorities launched their inquiry earlier this month after receiving a complaint from a doctor in Thulamahashe, Mpumalanga. The doctor's name had been used fraudulently on a sick note that was presented to an employer by a private security company employee in December 2024. Further investigation led officers to the alleged source of these fake documents. During the operation, law enforcement officials discovered and seized multiple fraudulent sick notes bearing the names of different doctors. The suspect is set to appear before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on charges of fraud and

EIGHT YEARS BEHIND BARS: RHINO POACHING PLOT FOILED



Rustenburg - In a resounding victory for conservation efforts, the Tlhabane Regional Court has sentenced three men to eight years of direct imprisonment for conspiring to commit rhino poaching.

On Friday, 14 February 2025, Simon Sihlangu (51), a Mozambican national, Jimmy Molefe (39), and Albert Makhubela (45), also a Mozambican national, were convicted of multiple offenses, including conspiracy to commit rhino poaching, possession of a firearm without a license, unlawful possession of ammunition, and possession of dangerous weapons.

The charges stemmed from an incident at Mziki Lodge near Lethabong, Rustenburg, on 12 October 2017. Authorities received intelligence about a poaching attempt and launched an undercover operation. Upon arrival at the lodge's gate in three separate bakkies, the suspects were intercepted. A search of the vehicles revealed a hidden rifle, ammunition, a hacksaw, a knife, and an axe in one of the bakkies.

The trio was initially granted bail, but justice has now been served. During the trial, advocate Rodger Mareume called the owner of Mziki Lodge, who also chairs the Rhino Private Owners Association, to testify. He detailed the heavy financial toll that poaching attempts have on private reserves, stating that Mziki Lodge had to spend over R500,000 to bolster security following the incident. He also highlighted that rhino poaching is a highly lucrative international organised crime industry, generating billions for criminals.

Regional Court magistrate Paul Moeng, in his ruling, stated that he found no precedent that would justify a lenient sentence or an alternative to direct imprisonment. The sentencing breakdown is as follows:

- Eight years for conspiracy to commit rhino poaching
- Four years for possession of a firearm without a license Two years for unlawful possession of ammunition
- Two years for possession of dangerous weapons

All sentences will run concurrently, meaning the accused will serve eight

Dr. Rachel Makhari, director of Public Prosecutions in the North West, welcomed the court's decision, commending the dedication of law enforcement and prosecution teams. "These sentences underscore the NPA's commitment to fighting organised crime and ensuring that justice is

Tragic end for missing teen, **POLICE SWIFTLY ARREST** TWO SUSPECTS

Mooinooi - What began as a desperate search for missing near Majakaneng, just 1km from where she was taken. 19-year-old Lerato Moalosi ended in heartbreak when her lifeless body was found mere hours after her abduction.

Thanks to the tireless work of law enforcement, two suspects have been arrested and charged with her kidnapping, rape, and murder.

Moalosi was last seen in the early hours of Sunday, 2 February 2025, when she and her boyfriend arrived at her home in Modikwane, Modderspruit, Mooinooi. Before they could enter, two unidentified men seized her and fled, leaving her boyfriend behind.

Despite his immediate call for help from the community devastated family received a chilling phone call demanding at around 11:00, her naked body was discovered in the bushes women and children to justice.

A dedicated investigative effort by Mooinooi Detectives, Bojanala Sub-District 1 Crime Intelligence, and the Brits Trio Task Team led to the breakthrough arrest of two

suspects on 14 February. During the operation, police seized key evidence, including blood-stained clothing, a cellphone, a bank card, and an identity

The suspects, aged 29 and 30, appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Monday, 17 February, facing charges of kidnapping, rape, and murder.

Acting provincial commissioner of North West, major and police, Moalosi remained missing. Later that day, her general Patrick Asaneng, expressed deep sorrow over the brutal crime. He reassured the public that law enforcement will ransom for her safe return. But hope turned to despair when, remain relentless in bringing perpetrators of violence against

Rustenburg – Adriver is lucky to be alive after his small sedan lost control on the Helen Joseph Bridge and rolled off onto the N4 highway on Monday evening, 17 February 2025, at approximately 19:00. Bojanala Ambulance Services responded swiftly to the accident scene, finding the driver as the sole occupant of the vehicle. Despite the severity of the crash, he sustained only moderate injuries. Paramedics stabilised him on-site before

transporting him to Medicare Hospital for further medical care. Bojanala Ambulance Services manager, Rufus Nong, described the intensity of the scene: "When we arrived, my heart sank, Seeing the wreckage, we feared the worst. But to our relief, the driver was alive. It's nothing short of a miracle — he's lucky to have survived that fall."

POWER PLAY?

Rustenburg municipal employee among six arrested in copper theft scandal

Rustenburg – A municipal employee and five foreign nationals were arrested in the early hours of Sunday morning, 16 February 2025, following a tip-off that led authorities to a stash of stolen copper cables and transformer components at a residence in Tsitsing.

The suspects were caught in a joint operation by the Royal Bafokeng Administration Reaction Force, Rustenburg Local Municipality's (RLM) Public Safety Department, and SAPS. The arrest follows allegations that for the past three to six years, municipal trucks had been frequently seen entering and leaving the premises of the municipal employee, raising suspicions of illicit activity.

The recovered copper cables, estimated to be worth over R80,000, have been linked to Rustenburg's ongoing power outages, caused by rampant cable theft and infrastructure vandalism. A case of cable theft has been opened at the Phokeng police station, and the suspects remain in custody at the Rustenburg police station while investigations continue. The municipality expects further arrests as the probe deepens.

The Democratic Alliance (DA) in Ward 43 welcomed the arrests but expressed grave

concerns over what they call "weak intelligence" within RLM's Law Enforcement and Public Safety Directorate. "The Democratic Alliance (DA) strongly believes that if municipal trucks have been frequently observed around the said employee's premises, the movement reports — along with the modus operandi — would have made it easier for management to detect any abnormalities," said DA Ward 43 Councillor Luan Snyders.

"This observation is particularly noteworthy given that the employee's premises are not located within the municipal supply area." further Snyders alleged that more municipal employees could be involved in the cable theft syndicate, urging law enforcement agencies to broaden their investigation.



Flooded Roads, Rising Risks: NW ON HIGH ALERT



NW – Motorists and residents across North West are urged to exercise extreme caution as heavy rains continue to flood roads, making travel hazardous and, in some areas, impossible. Authorities are monitoring the situation closely, working to ensure public safety and redirect traffic where necessary.

The North West Community Safety and Transport Management chief director for transport regulations, Molefi Morule, confirmed that law enforcement is actively patrolling all national, provincial, and local roads to assist motorists.

"Since the beginning of these torrential rains, we have experienced interruptions in the flow of traffic on most, if not all, national and provincial roads. However, we are constantly monitoring the situation and diverting motorists to alternative routes where necessary," said Morule.

- R52 between Koster and Lichtenburg
- **R509** between Koster and Magaliesberg
- R30 between Derby and Ventersdorp
- R52 between Koster and Rustenburg
