Koster – It's not the first time a project has been disrupted by crime. In South Africa, it's something we live with every day. But here's the real story: you have to fight for your life just to do your job in this country. And this time, it was for the workers just trying to fix our roads. On Tuesday, 1 April 2025, a multidisciplinary team swooped in and arrested five men in Koster for allegedly holding a major road construction project hostage. The site, funded by SANRAL and meant to upgrade the road between the N4 and Koster, had been plagued by threats and shutdowns for weeks.

The accused - Andrew Matane (42), Blasius Makati (49), Chapel

Mahlasela (50), Thabo Frederick (50), and Lazarus Mazaleni (54) - Police spokesperson, captain Mpho Manyoba explained: "The charges of extortion, intimidation, malicious damage to property, and kidnapping. Their bail hearing is scheduled for Monday, 7 April 2025. They remain in custody.

What is extortion? Extortion is when someone uses threats, force, or fear to demand money, jobs, or services. It's criminal — and it's been creeping deeper into our workplaces. In this case, the In South Africa, suspects allegedly threatened a construction company after not being awarded sub-contracting work.

Robbery at Local Butchery Ends in Gunfire

Rustenburg – A daring daylight robbery at a well-known butchery in Rustenburg was swiftly cut short on Saturday afternoon, 5 April 2025, when the business owner fired back at suspects, fatally wounding one of them.

The butchery became the scene of a business robbery when three armed men entered the premises. According to sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, the suspects threatened staff and stole an undisclosed amount of cash from the tills and office, along with a cellphone.

During the incident, the complainant was physically assaulted. As the robbers fled in a white BMW (registration unknown), the complainant retrieved his privately owned firearm and shot at the suspects. One was fatally struck, while the vehicle, also hit, managed to escape with the remaining suspects

Acting Bojanala Platinum Sub-District 2 commissioner, brigadier Mamotsamai Ntoagae, confirmed that the matter is under investigation and that police are following up on several promising leads.

Brigadier Ntoagae urged community members to assist in the investigation by reporting any information that could help police track down the remaining suspects.

ARMED GANG BLOWS UP CASH VAN

Mooinooi – A cash-in-transit van was violently ambushed and bombed on Monday evening, 7 April 2025, on the N4 near Majakaneng.

Police spokesperson Colonel Adéle Myburgh confirmed that the attack occurred around 18:00 when the van. carrying two security officers, was blocked off by several vehicles. An unknown number of heavily armed suspects opened fire, forcing the van to stop. The security guards were overpowered, and their firearms were stolen in the process. One guard was shot in the abdomen and rushed to a local hospital for treatment.

The suspects then used explosives to blast open the van,

escaping with an undisclosed amount of cash. They fled the scene in a Mercedes Benz, a Toyota Fortuner, and a Toyota Hi-Lux. As of now, no arrests have been made.

The Directorate for Priority Crime Investigation (DPCI) is leading the investigation, and police have launched a manhunt. Residents are urged to assist in tracking down the criminals by reporting any information, no matter how small, to SAPS Crime Stop on 08600 10111 or through the

R25 Million Down the Drain: Hawks Net Two More in Bojanala Fraud Scandal

Justice in motion - Hawks officers move in as another chapter unfolds in the Bojanala R25 million fraud investigation.



Rustenburg - What began as a single arrest has now snowballed into a full-scale takedown of a multimillion-rand corruption network allegedly

operating within the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality. On Monday, 7 April 2025, two more suspects - a married couple and directors of two separate companies - were arrested and appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court.

Esther Malesa (45), director of Kea's Project, and Moses Malesa (53), director of Marole Nameng Trading Enterprise, now join five others in a case that has rocked the North West's municipal landscape. The pair were arrested by the Hawks' Serious Commercial Crime Investigation team and granted bail - R100 000 for Esther, and R50 000 for Moses

This brings the accused count to seven, following last month's arrests in connection with the R25 million allegedly siphoned from the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality between December 2018 and May 2019.

According to the National Prosecuting Authority communications officer Sivenathi (NPA) Gunya, and the Hawks' lieutenant colonel Tinyiko Mathebula, the scheme centred around fraudulent invoices and unauthorised payments to companies not officially registered as municipal service providers.

The alleged mastermind, former CFO Leslina Olga Ndlovu (45), is accused of working with Esther Malesa to channel massive municipal payments to Kea's Project using the credentials of a registered service provider. Investigators discovered that while Kea's Project received over R25 million, the funds were distributed across several individuals

Esther Malesa now faces a staggering 53 counts of fraud, 84 counts of money laundering, and three counts of corruption, while her husband Moses faces seven counts of money laundering. All seven accused are currently out on bail. The case has been postponed to 2 July 2025 for further investigation. The acting North West provincial head of the Hawks, brigadier Silas Munzhedzi, and Dr Rachel Makhari, director of Public Prosecutions, praised the strong collaboration between the NPA and the Hawks, stating it reflects a committed drive toward rooting out corruption and ensuring public funds are safeguarded.

PSA Demands Justice for Bapong Clinic Attack

Bapong/ Rustenburg - The Public Servants Association (PSA) has expressed outrage following a brutal attack on healthcare workers at Bapong Health Centre in the Madibeng District.

In the early hours of Tuesday, 1 April 2025, a group of individuals stormed the clinic, allegedly demanding immediate treatment for a patient who had been stabbed. When asked to wait their turn, the group turned violent — assaulting and stabbing both clinic staff and security personnel. Several employees sustained serious injuries.

In a media release, the PSA strongly condemned the attack, describing it as "a serious indictment on health workers in the Public Sector." The union, which represents thousands of public servants, stressed that such violent incidents are becoming alarmingly frequent, and that urgent steps must be taken to prevent further harm to frontline workers.

"These are people who show up every day to save lives, often under extremely challenging conditions," the PSA said. "They deserve protection, not persecution." The PSA is calling for an immediate government response, urging the Minister of Police to prioritise this case and ensure the perpetrators are swiftly brought to justice. Additionally, the PSA has called on the Department of Health to enhance security at healthcare facilities, boost staffing levels, and improve working conditions to manage growing patient numbers.

Mom sentenced after hiding rape of her 4-year-old daughter

Rustenburg – The acting district commissioner of Boianala Platinum Sub-District 2, brigadier Mamotsamai Ntoagae, has welcomed sentencing of a 47-yearold woman who failed to report the rape of her

four-year-old daughter a tragic case that has shocked the Monakato community near Mogwase. The Tlhabane Regional Court sentenced the mother on Monday, 8 April 2025, to three years' imprisonment, wholly suspended for five years, after she was found guilty of defeating the ends of justice.

According to sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, the disturbing case dates back to October 2023, when the mother observed troubling changes in her child's behaviour. Upon questioning, the young girl revealed that she had been raped by a neighbour. Rather than turning to the police, the mother allegedly approached the suspect and his wife directly. It is further alleged that a payment of R12,000 was made to the

mother to keep the matter quiet. Months later, when the child's health deteriorated, the mother returned to the suspect to demand more money for medical expenses. When the suspect refused, she eventually reported the incident to the authorities. The case was allocated to detective warrant officer Phenyo Monchusi, from the Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offenses Unit (FCS). His dedicated investigation led to the




