Armed with a machete (panga), the man ambushed his wife as she was helping her eight-year-old child out of the car. He broke her window, dragged her from the vehicle, and slashed her throat - all in plain view of the school and morning traffic.

"I didn't see it coming," the victim told Platinum Weekly. "Although he had made threats before and was looking for me, I never imagined he'd do this. He didn't even know where I lived anvmore.

She had started divorce proceedings in 2024, after he allegedly stole her firearm. The two had been married for four years. Still legally married, the separation was complicated by his refusal to sign the final papers refusal allegedly fuelled by jealousy over her new relationship.

"He found my boyfriend on Facebook and couldn't let it go. That's when he snapped."

The woman, who was in the process of relocating out of Rustenburg, suffered multiple injuries: bruises on both knees and elbows, a hurt wrist, chest scratches, and a deep throat wound.

This is the fourth case opened against the perpetrator. Captain Mpho Manyoba confirmed a case of Assault with Intent to Cause Grievous Bodily Harm (GBH) has been registered.

UPDATE: HE WAS RELEASED FROM CUSTODY

Despite the brutality of the attack and the fact that the victim's throat was slit- the alleged attacker is no longer in police custody.

According to SAPS, the suspect was released due to issues relating to evidence. The details surrounding this development remain unclear at this stage, but it has sparked outrage and fear among those close to the victim, who now lives with the terrifying knowledge that the man who tried to kill her is once again walking free. 
