Mike Bolhuis sounds the alarm on widespread corruption in law enforcement and the courts.

An alarming pattern of corruption continues to erode the rule of law in South Africa, involving traffic officers, police, and even court officials. According to Mike Bolhuis, specialist investigator into serious violent and economic crimes, many citizens have become victims of an alliance between those who are supposed to uphold justice.

From being falsely accused and intimidated into paying bribes, to being locked up unjustly over weekends and denied access to legal recourse, ordinary South Africans are suffering the consequences of systemic abuse of power.

In a chilling exposé, Bolhuis outlines how corrupt officials collaborate from roadside shakedowns to compromised courtrooms — making it nearly impossible for victims to defend themselves. His message to the public? Know your rights, recognise red flags, and report wrongdoing.

How deep does the corruption go?

PROJECT: CORRUPTION IN GOVERNMENT INSTITUTIONS – TRAFFIC, POLICE AND COURT OFFICIALS

Corruption within South Africa's government institutions — particularly among police, traffic officials, court personnel, and even judiciary members — remains a pervasive issue, eroding public trust and undermining the rule of law.

According to an Afrobarometer survey, 56% of South Africans believe that most or all police officers are involved in corruption, while 36% hold the same view about judges and magistrates. Traffic officers are frequently implicated in bribery, with national victimisation surveys identifying them as the government service most strongly associated with the unscrupulous use of a politician's authority for personal gain. These corrupt practices often involve collusion among officials across various sectors. For instance, traffic officers may solicit bribes to overlook offences, while some court officials and law enforcement personnel might manipulate legal processes in exchange for favours. Such systemic corruption not only compromises the integrity of public institutions but also hampers efforts to combat crime and deliver justice effectively

The entrenchment of corruption across multiple levels of government highlights the urgent need for comprehensive reforms and robust accountability mechanisms to restore public confidence and uphold the principles of good governance.

IDENTIFYING A POTENTIALLY CORRUPT SITUATION

• UNREASONABLE OR UNCLEAR

ACCUSATIONS

If you are pulled over and the reason seems vague, inconsistent or does not match your recollection of events.

AGGRESSIVE OR BULLYING BEHAVIOUR

If the official becomes aggressive or tries to intimidate you when you question their actions.

DEMANDS FOR IMMEDIATE CASH PAYMENT

Legitimate fines typically have a formal process for payment (e.g., at a police station or through a designated system), rather than direct cash demands at the roadside.

 THREATS OF ARREST OR ESCALATION OF MINOR OFFENCES

If a minor traffic violation suddenly leads to threats of immediate arrest or involvement of a more senior officer without clear justification

 REFUSAL TO PROVIDE IDENTIFICATION OR DOCUMENTATION

Legitimate officials should readily provide their identification and relevant paperwork.

 BEING TAKEN TO AN UNOFFICIAL LOCATION

If you are not taken to a recognised police station or court.

• PRESSURE TO RESOLVE THINGS "INFORMALLY"

Any suggestion to bypass official procedures and pay a sum of money directly to the official is a major red flag.

LACK OF CLEAR ARREST PROCEDURES
 If you are arrested without being informed of

your rights or the reason for your arrest.

UNUSUAL DELAYS OR OBSTRUCTION IN

THE LEGAL PROCESS

Suspicious delays in court appearances, or if

your attempts to file a complaint are blocked.

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

REMAIN CALM AND POLITE

Even if you believe you are being unfairly targeted, try to stay calm and respectful. This will sometimes de-escalate the situation

REQUEST IDENTIFICATION

Always ask for the official's name, rank, and badge number and make a note of it.

ASK FOR A WRITTEN NOTICE OR A TICKET

If you are accused of an offence, request a formal written notice or ticket detailing the alleged violation and the process for payment or further action.

DO NOT OFFER BRIBES

While it might seem like the quickest way out, paying a bribe perpetuates corruption and can make you liable for prosecution.

STATE YOUR RIGHTS CLEARLY

If you are being arrested, calmly state that you know your rights (e.g., the right to remain silent, the right to an attorney).

• RECORD EVERYTHING (IF SAFE)

If it is safe and legal to do so in your situation, try to record the interaction using your phone (audio or video). This can be crucial evidence later. Be aware of privacy laws regarding recording.

NOTE DETAILS

Immediately after the encounter, write down every detail you can remember: date, time, location, names and descriptions of the officials involved, vehicle numbers, and what was said.

SEEK WITNESSES

If there were any witnesses to the incident, try to get their contact information.

REPORT THE INCIDENT

Despite the difficulties mentioned, it is crucial to try to report the incident through multiple channels:

- Independent Police Investigative Directorate (IPID): This is the body responsible for investigating misconduct by police officers.
- National Anti-Corruption Hotline: The government has a hotline for reporting corruption.
- Public Protector: This independent institution is responsible for investigating complaints against government bodies.
- Civil Society Organisations: There are organisations dedicated to fighting corruption and promoting good governance that may offer assistance.
- Media: Bringing the issue to the attention of the media will sometimes create pressure for action.

SEEK LEGAL ADVICE

It is essential that if you have been a victim of such corruption, you seek legal advice from an attorney who specialises in human rights or anti-corruption law. They will advise you on your rights and the best course of

SUPPORT ANTI-CORRUPTION EFFORTS

Engage with and support organisations working to combat corruption and promote transparency within government institutions.

We encourage members of the public who were involved in such a matter to come forward and contact Mike Bolhuis. It is a sad reality that citizens must be vigilant against those who are meant to protect them.

North West — The South African Police Service (SAPS) in the North West province has expressed deep concern over the troubling number of rape cases reported, particularly from townships, rural communities, villages, and farms. As reported on 27 April 2025, the acting provincial commissioner, major general Patrick Asaneng, urgently called on community leaders, social activists, faith-based leaders, gender and rights groups, and all sectors of civil society to unite against what he described as "a pandemic afflicting society."

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone highlighted that despite the existence of comprehensive crime prevention strategies — including the Gender-Based Violence and Femicide Strategy, the Community Policing Strategy, and the Integrated Violence and Crime Prevention Strategy — women, girl children, and the elderly continue to suffer at the hands of perpetrators, many of whom are young men known to the victims.

Major General Asaneng noted: "No number of resources or policing plans will cure moral depravity. It is unacceptable that young people — many of them still learners or unemployed — frequent taverns to drink liquor. Our correctional facilities are overflowing with young men convicted of violent crimes. The narrative must change if South Africa is to save itself from itself."

He stressed that blaming the SAPS alone, especially during crime statistics releases, misses the broader need for a collaborative, integrated commitment from society as a whole.

MINISTER SETS RECORD STRAIGHT **ON TIGER WELFARE**

North West - The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment has stepped forward to address growing concerns around the welfare and trade of tigers in South Africa, following recent media reports and public outcry. A particularly distressing case of a malnourished and injured tiger at a breeding facility in the North West province, which tragically had to be euthanised. has drawn national attention. The Minister confirmed that the National Council of Societies for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (NSPCA) is actively investigating the incident under the Animals Protection Act, with the department's full support.

In response to widespread speculation about South Africa's role in the global tiger trade, the Department provided the following clarifications:

- Tiger Exports: South Africa breeds tigers primarily for non-commercial purposes such as export to accredited zoos and wildlife parks. The notion that tigers are bred for trophy hunting or bone trade is unfounded. Between 2015 and 2023, only two hunting trophies and four bones were legally exported, most likely from naturally deceased animals.
- Regulation in Place: Keeping and breeding non-native big cats like tigers is already regulated in seven of the country's nine provinces, with one province banning the

practice entirely. Although tigers are not indigenous and not listed under the National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, facilities must adhere to the same care standards applied to native species like lions.

- International Oversight: All tiger exports are strictly monitored under the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES). For example, a 2024 shipment of 40 tigers to India was thoroughly vetted and destined for zoological institutions — not for
- Illegal Trade: While isolated cases of illegal wildlife trafficking have involved lion bones, there is only one known case of tiger bones from South Africa being seized internationally. Law enforcement agencies, including the Hawks, remain alert and responsive to credible leads
- Animal Welfare Commitment: Acknowledging that some facilities may still fall short in care standards, the Department committed to more rigorous inspections and stronger cooperation with animal welfare bodies to ensure all captive

The Department emphasised that South Africa does not support animal cruelty or illegal trade, and is working to enhance regulation and enforcement.

21 ILLEGAL MINERS CAUGHT, EQUIPMENT SEIZED

Brits/ Mogwase - In an effort to combat illegal mining and related offences, 21 individuals appeared in the Brits and Mogwase Magistrates' Courts on Thursday, 24 April 2025. The accused, aged between 21 and 41, were arrested during coordinated Vala Umgodi operations conducted on Wednesday, 23 and Thursday, 24 April 2025, in Witrandjie near Sun City, and Majakaneng outside Brits. Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone confirmed that three of the accused were found guilty in the Brits Magistrate's Court. They were sentenced to six months' imprisonment or a fine of R2,000, both wholly suspended. The court further ordered that they be deported to their countries of origin — Mozambique and Malawi. The remaining accused were remanded in custody pending their individual court appearances between Tuesday, 29 April and Tuesday, 24 June 2025. As part of their efforts to curb illegal mining, police confiscated equipment believed to have been used in illicit activities, including a water pump, a jackhammer, and electric extension cords. The operations form part of the ongoing Vala Umgodi initiative, which focuses on dismantling illegal mining networks across the Bojanala Platinum District.



Officers set up roadblocks on national and provincial roads, traced wanted suspects, conducted stop-and-searches, carried out compliance inspections at liquor outlets, shut down unlicensed premises, recovered stolen property, and enhanced security at ports of entry. The results were significant. Police seized copper cables, illegal firearms and ammunition, drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, and other contraband. Arrests were made for a wide range of offences. These included 95 undocumented individuals, 49 motorists driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs, seven individuals caught in possession of illegal firearms and ammunition, and five suspects carrying dangerous weapons.

Police also arrested 59 individuals for drug possession, 15 for illegal liquor trading, and 109 for assault with intent to do grievous bodily harm. A further 48 suspects were arrested for common assault, 13 for murder, and 28 for

Trio nabbed after terrifying home robbery



Major general Patrick Asaneng, acting provincial commissioner of police in North West, applauded the efforts of police and vigilant community members following the suspects' court appearance at the Bafokeng Magistrate's Court in Tlhabane on Friday, 25 April 2025.

According to brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, the incident unfolded on Sunday evening, 20 April 2025, when two men allegedly broke into a woman's home in the Phetoane Section. Armed with knives, the suspects threatened the victim and, despite her cries for help, robbed her of cash, two cellphones, and a blanket. A prompt investigation led police to Plastic View informal settlement, where the suspects were apprehended on Wednesday, 23 April 2025. All stolen items were successfully recovered. The accused - Musa Santos Mthimkhulu (24), Django Salvador (21), and Jedo Mashaba (31) - have been charged with house robbery. Their case has been postponed until Wednesday, 19 May 2025, for a bail application.

Further investigations revealed that all three accused are undocumented foreign nationals from Mozambique. They will also face additional charges under Section 49(1)(a) of the Immigration Act, 2002.






