LITTLE GIRL DIES IN TRAGIC HOUSE FIRE AMID LOADSHEDDING, NO WATER

The burnt room where an 8-year-old girl lost her life. A tragedy fuelled by loadshedding, water shortages – and heartbreak.



Rustenburg – A community is in mourning after a devastating house fire claimed the life of an 8-year-old disabled girl during the late hours of Sunday, 11 May 2025 – tragically, Mother's Day. The fire broke out shortly after 1am in Rustenburg North, while the area was struggling with both electricity cuts and water shortages. Neighbours tried desperately to help, but they were left helpless. "I still hear her cries. Her screams for her parents. I stood in the yard, powerless. We had no water. No electricity. Nothing. We just needed one – water or power – to save her life. But we had none," one heartbroken neighbour shared, her voice shaking. "I have children of my own. I keep hearing her little voice echoing. I'm angry. I'm heartbroken. We were helpless." Another resident described how they rushed to give what water they had in their tank, handing it over a wall to someone trying to douse the flames. "He threw the water onto the fire, but the tank was nearly empty. We had no way to pump more without power. Our hands were cut off."

candle during the blackout, but this is not yet confirmed. Investigations by the Rustenburg Fire Department and police are ongoing.

"It's gut-wrenching," said another neighbour. "That beautiful little soul didn't deserve this. No one does. Especially not a child."

Especially not on Mother's Day. This entire community is shattered."

By the time the fire department reached the scene, the roof of the room had already started to collapse. They managed to contain the blaze and prevent it from spreading to neighbouring homes – but it was too late for the young girl, who is believed to have died from smoke inhalation and heat exposure.

In the aftermath, grief turned to rage. One resident, speaking the next day as power returned, said, "I don't want electricity anymore. What use is it now? Where was it when we needed it most? Take back your power. We lost one of our own."

The fire has left the community not only heartbroken, but demanding answers.

"We want justice. This was inhumane. A disabled child died, trapped and calling for help while we stood powerless. This should never happen to anyone."

A message of condolence is being extended from the entire Noord community to the grieving parents. As one mother put it: "Today, all mothers in Noord mourn with you."

We could not reach the parents of the child at the time of going to print. But please know — we mourn with you, and our hearts and prayers are with you during this unimaginable time.

Fixing Roads, Building Community

Our Ward Matters’ Bold Pothole Project Powers into Week 3

Rustenburg – Our Ward Matters (OWM) is proving that with determination, action, and heart, communities can take charge of their own streets. Now in its third week, OWM's pothole repair project in Ward 17 is transforming damaged roads into safer routes — one asphalt bag at a time. Led by OWM director and founder André van Dyk, alongside councillor Tanya Rothman and a dedicated group of Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) workers, the initiative continues to grow — in scale, in public support, and in impact.

A GROUND-UP INITIATIVE GAINING GROUND
From the outset of May, OWM has worked tirelessly, methodically tackling some of Ward 17's worst-hit streets. By 9 May 2025, they had filled 122 potholes, using 172 bags of asphalt. On Monday 12 May, another 100 bags were delivered to power the next phase of this community-driven campaign. The week kicked off in Komatirivier Avenue, then moved through Visrivier Street, Saltrivier Avenue, Drakensberg, Langeberg, and the corner of Maluti and Kougaberg Avenue. The team also repaired roads near Kagoentle Estate, ending that stretch at Drakensberg and Adelaide Street. But the work didn't stop there.

THIS WEEK’S PROGRESS:
31 BIG WINS IN ONE DAY
On 12 May, the team closed 31 large potholes, completing final repairs in Visrivier before moving into Krokodilrivier, where they tackled major road damage between House 85 and Houses 56 and 73. In Palalarivier, three major potholes were filled. Over the following days, work continued in Frederick Avenue, Gita Close, Mooney Close, and Cuckoo Avenue, where four large, high-traffic potholes opposite Houses 65 and 67, and Carmel Complex, were repaired. In Elandsrivier, three additional major potholes were completed, followed by progress in Limpoporivier and Caledon. “We’ve been busy every week this month and will continue through June to close every pothole in Ward 17. That’s our promise,” said André.

POWERED BY PUBLIC SUPPORT
Residents have rallied behind the cause, with donations of funds and materials helping OWM stay on the move. “We average about 30 potholes a day,” said André. “It’s tough work, but thanks to your donations, we’re seeing results. This is your victory, too.”

“He said I was dying today”

A Survivor’s Story of Abuse, Courage, and Escape

She moved in with him to be closer to work and to feel safer after late-night shifts. What began as a relationship filled with laughter and companionship turned into a nightmare that nearly ended her life. In an anonymous interview with *Platinum Weekly* this week, a brave survivor opened up about the violent abuse she endured in September 2024, after dating her partner for seven months. The assault took place in his home following a disagreement about a stolen phone — something she says she wanted no part of. That's when everything changed. He attacked her while she was preparing to bathe, first strangling her with a laptop cable, dragging her across the house, and ignoring her pleas to stop. He stabbed her multiple times in the thighs, shoulders, back, and hands. At one point, he mocked her work and reputation, telling her she was going to die that night. She recalls him grabbing a spade fork and a brick — holding her down and hitting her on the head until she lost consciousness. When she came to, she realised she had urinated on herself. “I could

smell myself,” she said. “I thought I smelled like a slaughtered chicken.” Desperate to survive, she changed tactics. She told him what he wanted to hear — promising to stay, to work things out, even not to open a case. Eventually, when he fell asleep, she escaped. She ran to a nearby friend, who took her to the police. The suspect was arrested a week later on charges of attempted murder. She later found out that he had previously been charged with a violent crime and was out on bail at the time of their relationship. Since the incident, her life has changed dramatically. She left her job, struggles with alcohol, and finds it hard to trust anyone again. “It was the first time he ever got physical,” she said. “I still can't believe it happened.” The accused's family continues to pressure her to drop the charges — describing the attack as a “lovers' quarrel.” But for this survivor, sharing her story is a way to speak for those who haven't yet found their voices. “I want people to know — don't ignore red flags. Don't wait for it to get this far.”

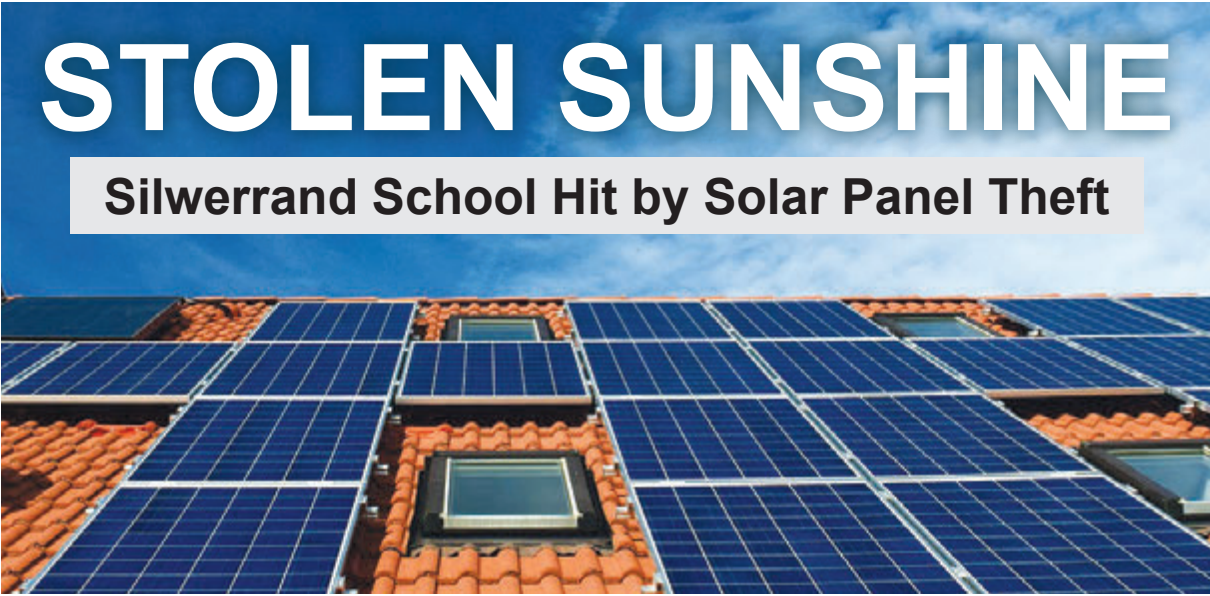

Rustenburg – On Sunday evening, 5 May 2025, 36 brand-new solar panels were stolen from the premises of Silwerrand Primary and Secondary Schools in what appears to have been a carefully planned theft. The incident occurred at approximately 21:00, after school hours, when the campus was unoccupied. “It’s such a blow,” said director Charlene Schoeman. “We are privileged to have access to solar power, and we take pride in caring for what we have. To be targeted like this — it’s heartbreaking. This wasn’t just vandalism. It was carefully planned.” Security footage from the school shows that the suspects deliberately avoided cameras. “They knew what they were doing,” Schoeman explained. “They stayed out of sight, worked quietly, and vanished without a trace.” A police case has been opened and

investigations are ongoing. Despite the emotional toll and financial loss, there’s a glimmer of hope in what followed. “Two days after the theft, someone claiming to be doing Telkom line inspections contacted us,” Schoeman recalled. “They had spotted something unusual in the field across the road from our school. When we went to look, we found 21 of our solar panels lying in the grass.” Amazingly, the recovered panels were not damaged and could be salvaged. Directors Charlene and Paulus Schoeman expressed deep gratitude to the community for their support and appealed to anyone with information about the theft to come forward. “This could have been so much worse. No one was hurt, and we’re thankful for that,” Schoeman concluded.

FILLING POTHOLES, FIGHTING CRIME

A section of the R556 road received much-needed pothole repairs.

Mooi-nooi – In a remarkable show of unity, the Mooi-nooi Rural Safety Forum, Mooi-nooi SAPS, Bethanie SAPS, Bila Civil Contractors, and the Department of Public Works and Roads launched a joint pothole-filling programme on Monday, 12 May 2025. The initiative, which runs until 16 May, aims not only to improve the condition of the notorious R556 road but also to reduce crime in the area.

The R556 — commonly referred to as the “Sun City Road” — has long been plagued by dangerous potholes. Criminals have taken advantage of motorists stranded with burst tyres.

“We as the Mooi-nooi Rural Safety Forum have identified this as an issue that must be addressed,” said Henry Holsthyzen, executive chairperson of the forum. “Fixing the road will protect both our local residents and tourists heading to Sun City and Pilanesberg.”

He added: “For first responders, having to drive on such a damaged road while rushing to save a life — whether it’s a fire, accident, or crime scene — is a serious risk. It’s about more than just potholes and safe driving; it affects emergency response times, vehicle wear and tear, and ultimately, service delivery. Few people realise how badly a road in poor condition can impact emergency services. In a crisis, every second counts.”

The effort kicked off with an opening prayer and

“I would like to thank the Community Police Forum, the Department of Public Works and Roads, and the Mooi-nooi Rural Safety Forum for the opportunity to give back,” said McDonald Pasipanodya, marketing coordinator at Bila Civil Contractors. “We believe in ensuring quality roads and supporting the safety of our communities.”

Mooi-nooi SAPS station commander, colonel Paramount Mosito emphasised the deeper purpose of the collaboration. “The R556 is not just a road — it’s a hub of economic activity,” he said. “Policing is not only about arrests, it’s also about preventing crime by eliminating hotspots. PSA CONDEMNS RISE IN
TEACHER ABUSE CASES



SA – The Public Servants Association (PSA) has strongly condemned a shocking rise in the number of sexual abuse cases involving educators and learners across South African schools.

According to the Education Labour Relations Council (ELRC), reported incidents have surged by 35.4% — with 111 cases recorded in the 2024/25 period, up from 82 the previous year. The PSA has labelled this a disturbing and unacceptable trend, calling for immediate reforms to safeguard learners.

“This is not just a statistic — it represents 111 young lives whose trust was shattered by those meant to protect and educate them,” the PSA said in a statement issued on 17 April 2025. “This surge confirms that current systems are failing to deter predators posing as educators.”

The PSA is calling for enhanced screening and vetting of teachers, continuous mandatory reporting of suspected abuse, and comprehensive training for school staff to identify and respond to abuse. The union also highlighted that while the Department of Justice has implemented the National Register for Sex Offenders, cases continue to rise — indicating that existing measures are falling short.

“Children deserve schools that are safe — not places where they fear the very adults entrusted with their education,” the PSA added, urging collaboration between the Department of Basic Education, the Department of Justice, and SAPS to act decisively.

The PSA also stressed the importance of regular audits, community involvement, and stronger school governance to break the silence and protect learners from further harm.

One Broken
Machine,
a Nation on Hold



SA – South Africa's driving licence card system has come to a grinding halt following the breakdown of the country's only printing machine — out of service since February 2025. The Public Servants Association (PSA) has voiced serious concern over the resulting delays in licence renewals and has called on the Department of Transport (DoT) to take swift and decisive action.

The ageing machine, in operation for over two decades, can only be repaired by an overseas company. A prior attempt to procure new equipment and introduce a new card in August 2024 was scrapped following findings of irregular procurement procedures by the Auditor General. The contract was eventually taken to court and cancelled.

The PSA warns that repeated tender failures and court battles are costing government — and taxpayers — dearly. “It defies logic that bidders who didn’t meet basic requirements were considered,” the union said.

To reduce future strain, the PSA proposes extending the driving licence validity to 10 years and calls for a modern, cyber-secure card solution. “Motorists are frustrated, and rightfully so. We need a reliable, long-term fix — not more delays,” the PSA concluded.

SA – The Public Servants Association (PSA) has voiced grave concern following the recent disclosure that 464 public schools across South Africa have dropped mathematics as a subject — a move that the PSA warns could deepen educational inequality and damage the country's economic future. This alarming trend disproportionately impacts learners in underprivileged communities, limiting their access to careers in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) — fields critical to national growth. “Without mathematics, these learners are effectively shut out from many vital courses and job opportunities, perpetuating the cycle of unemployment and poverty,” the PSA stated. Mathematics, long recognised as a cornerstone of critical thinking and problem-solving, is seen as indispensable for both academic success and future innovation. The PSA has expressed particular concern given South Africa's recent ranking at the bottom of the global list in mathematics and science, according to the Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS).
