EMPLOYER DETAILS NEEDED AFTER MEMORY LOSS FROM N4 CRASH

Rustenburg/ Pretoria - What should have A Good Samaritan been the start of a new chapter turned into Amid the chaos, hope came from an unknown tragedy for 38-year-old Quintin Snyman, who while travelling from Pretoria to his new job in Rustenburg

Quintin had just started working in the safety department at a local mine on Monday 1 September 2025. Each morning, he would message his mother, Helena Snyman, to let her know he had arrived safely in Rustenburg. But on Monday, 8 September, that message never

The Accident

At around 06:30, Quintin's car was involved in a serious collision on the N4. He was left unconscious, and emergency responders had to use the Jaws of Life to free him from the wreck. He is now in hospital with skull trauma (shock consciousness) and memory loss.

On Wednesday, 10 September, two days after the accident, Quintin underwent surgery on his legs. Doctors explained that they could not perform all the necessary procedures at once due to the extent of his injuries. One of his legs had been broken in four places, along with several other fractures.

Theft at the Scene

In a cruel twist, while Quintin lay unconscious, his cellphone and the SIM card from his dashcam were stolen — both containing details of his new employer. The family points out that the other driver involved in the collision left the scene without offering assistance, raising painful questions about who might have taken these crucial items. Without them, they have no way of notifying his workplace that his absence is the result of a life-threatening accident — and the circumstances surrounding the crash remain unclear.

woman who stopped to help. She phoned was left critically injured in a crash on the N4 emergency services, stayed until responders employer's contact details. His family fears he could arrived, and even recovered Quintin's wallet and glasses, ensuring they were kept safe.

His family shared a heartfelt message to her: "Thank you for stopping and helping my son when he needed it most — may God bless you for your • kindness."

Urgent Appeal

Because of his memory loss and the theft of his phone, Quintin cannot remember his new lose the job he had only just begun, unless contact can be made.

They are urgently asking the community:

- Did you witness the accident on the N4?
- Do you know anything about the person who took his belongings?
- Do you know Quintin's new employer in Rustenburg?




Cleaning Up for Safety - 3 September

MINE WORKER CAUGHT WITH EXPLOSIVE PRILLS

Boitekong/ Rustenburg - Police have expressed concern over the growing problem of commercial explosives falling into criminal hands, following the arrest of a mine worker found in possession of explosive prills. Explosive prills are small, bead-like granules (usually of ammonium nitrate) that look a bit like tiny white pellets. On their own, ammonium nitrate prills are not explosive, but it's a key ingredient in the widely used, low-cost industrial explosive ANFO (ammonium nitrate/fuel oil)

On Tuesday afternoon, 2 September 2025, security personnel at a Boitekong mine apprehended Abongile Mbulawa (40) after he

was discovered carrying explosive prills. He was immediately handed over to the police and appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 4 September 2025. Mbulawa was remanded in custody until his next appearance on Thursday, 11 September 2025.

The acting provincial commissioner of North West, major general Patrick Asaneng, stressed the seriousness of the arrest: "The significance of this arrest cannot be overstated. Commercial explosives, which should be carefully controlled and safeguarded, are often diverted for use in violent crimes such as cash-in-transit robberies. By intercepting this suspect, we prevented dangerous materials from being sold into criminal networks

Police investigations continue and may lead to more arrests as authorities work to trace where the explosives were intended to go

Rape Suspect Re-Arrested in Rustenburg After Escape


The suspect, originally arrested in Umzimkhulu, KwaZulu-Natal, on 1 September 2025, allegedly raped a 28-year-old woman from Sisulu. According to police, the victim was attacked while on her way to her cousin's home. The suspect reportedly forced her into a house, raped her, and later fell asleep — giving the woman a chance to escape and raise the alarm. He was arrested that same day.

However, days later, the suspect managed to escape from lawful custody. His brief taste of

Pistols Hidden **Under Bonnet** Seized

Phokeng/ Rustenburg - A tactical operation led by the Phokeng K9 unit, backed by crime intelligence, has brought five armed suspects to justice after a dramatic bust in Chaneng near Phokeng, outside Rustenburg. On Wednesday, 3 September 2025, officers acted on a tipoff about a suspicious Audi Q3 parked with its bonnet open in Mafenya. On closer

inspection, police spotted a balaclava on the engine cover. When questioned, one of the occupants fled the scene but was swiftly apprehended.

A search of the vehicle uncovered three pistols hidden inside the engine compartment, along with 25 rounds of ammunition. Two more suspects, who had attempted to hide in nearby bushes, were later tracked down and arrested.

The suspects – Matamela Madupo (46), Rapula Paul Thobi (37), Mzwakhe Matoko (22), Thabang Motaung (42), and Mojabatho Sidwell Vilikazi (36) - appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court in Tlhabane on 5 September. They remain in custody until their next court appearance on 11 September.

The acting provincial commissioner of North West, major general Patrick Asaneng, commended the arrests.

Mine Operator, Son and **Security in Court**

Ledig/ Rustenburg - A major breakthrough has been made in the ongoing battle against violent crime in the chrome mining sector around Tlhatlaganyane. Nine suspects, including a 54-year-old woman alleged to be a mine operator, her 20-year-old son, and several alleged security enforcers from KwaZulu-Natal, appeared before the Mogwase Magistrate's Court on Thursday, 4 September 2025.

The suspects face a string of charges, including kidnapping, murder, assault, attempted murder, and malicious damage to property. Their arrest follows the killing of five men at an open-cast chrome mine in Tlhatlaganyane on Tuesday, 2 September 2025.

The arrests were carried out by a multidisciplinary team comprising Provincial Murder and Robbery detectives, Crime Intelligence, the Tactical Response Team (TRT), and Sun City Detectives. This task team was established by the Acting Provincial Commissioner after escalating violence in the area. Police confirmed that two of the accused were also linked to a separate case in Sun City in August 2025, where charges of attempted murder, kidnapping, and malicious damage to property were reported.

In their first appearance, the following accused were charged with kidnapping and murder: Mpho Stella Pooe (54), Phenyo Pooe (20), Sibusiso Sanction Ngcongo (50), Flatela Bulelani (38), Thabo Gone (28), Enock Bhekithemba Mbatha (41), Swelihle Mphamiseni Shezi (30), and Thulani Thembela Latsha (43). The case was postponed for further investigations and bail applications.

In a second case involving attempted murder, kidnapping, and malicious damage to property, three accused - Tiyiselane Tiisetso Chabalala (34), Phenyo Pooe (20), and Sibusiso Sanction Ngcongo (50) – were also remanded in custody. Acting provincial commissioner, major general Patrick Asaneng, praised the swift work of the investigation team.

TRAGEDY ON THE N4

Roadworks Demand Extra Caution



Rustenburg - A tragic accident on the N4 near the Kroondal offramp on Friday, 5 September 2025, claimed the lives of four people and left others injured, highlighting once again the urgent need for motorists to exercise caution on roads where roadworks are underway.

The collision involved three vehicles: a paraffin tanker, a cash-in-transit van, and a Toyota Hilux bakkie with a trailer. The impact caused the tanker to catch fire, and emergency services were quickly dispatched to the scene.

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone of the SAPS confirmed fatalities and urded the public to remain patient and follow traffic officials' instructions while investigations continue.

Rustenburg First Responders reported that two patients with minor injuries were transported to the nearest clinic by ER24 EMS. Tragically, four occupants of the truck and cash van lost their lives at the scene.

Rayno Dempers, special operations manager of Eagle Trauma Rescue EMS, assumed the role of scene commander and coordinated the efforts of Rustenburg First Responders, ER24, and the Rustenburg Fire Department. "We extend our deepest condolences to the families of those who lost their lives," he said.

The latest retrenchments affect companies such as Glencore, ArcelorMittal, Ford South Africa, Assmang and Goodyear SA. All of these companies are core to the rest of the manufacturing value chain in South Africa and could lead to further retrenchments elsewhere.

"This is a bloodbath of job losses that will worsen South Africa's already critically low unemployment rate," warns Willie Venter, deputy general secretary of Solidarity.

The letter to Ramaphosa shows how these mass retrenchments are not only the result of global economic pressures, but that systematic government failures are making South African Solidarity press release extracts, 5 September 2025

to personally intervene in the looming job loss crisis. In a letter sharp tariff increases that are making local production less competitive; Transnet's rail and freight infrastructure that has come to a near standstill and is driving up costs; the government's sluggishness to finalise favourable export tariff agreements, such as AGOA, on time; and a general lack of policy and support for infrastructure.

SHOTS OF HOPE: protect cattle from Foot-and-Mouth Disease

Rysmierbult - Just 55 kilometres from Rustenburg, government leaders rolled up their sleeves on Thursday, 4 September 2025, to help protect the region's cattle and livelihoods. Minister of Agriculture John Steenhuisen, joined by North West MEC for Agriculture and Rural Development Madoda Sambatha, personally led a vaccination drive against Foot-and-Mouth Disease (FMD) in Rysmierbult.

The visit formed part of government's broader strategy to contain the outbreak and safeguard the agricultural economy. Before the rollout, the Minister and MEC met with local farmers to listen to concerns and explain biosecurity protocols and the importance of early detection. Nearly 300 communal cattle were vaccinated in the first phase. Steenhuisen emphasised the urgency: "Foot-and-Mouth Disease is not just a veterinary issue, it is an economic threat. We must act swiftly and collectively.'

MEC Sambatha urged vigilance: "Farmers should report unusual symptoms immediately. Cooperation with veterinary officials is critical."






