the Mooinooi off-ramp. The attack was meticulously planned and executed by a heavily armed syndicate — a stark reminder of the alarming rise in such violent crimes across South Africa.

According to police, the armoured truck was ambushed by armed suspects travelling in a silver-grey Volvo, later joined by a white Amarok and a white Mercedes-Benz SUV. After ramming and disabling the truck, the suspects opened fire, forcing the security crew out before detonating explosives to blow open the cash compartment. The suspects fled the scene with an undisclosed amount of money.

Tragically, one security escort was fatally shot while attempting to defend his colleagues, and another sustained critical injuries.

Two explosive devices left behind by the robbers were safely neutralised by specialist bomb technicians on the scene. A large team of law enforcement units — including the SAPS Explosives Section, Organised Crime, K9, and Tactical Response Teams — responded swiftly to secure the area.

At the time of going to print, no arrests had been made, and investigations by the Directorate for Priority Crime Investigations (Hawks) are ongoing.

Our deepest condolences go out to the family and colleagues of the brave officer who lost his life in the line of duty.

MOM STILL SEARCHING FOR MISSING SON

Rustenburg/ Derby - The Rustenburg Crime Combatting Forum (RCCF) and local residents are urgently appealing for assistance in locating 39-year-old Alwin Dorman, who has been missing since Monday, 6 October 2025.

Alwin, a teacher at REC and resident Olifantsnek, last spoke to his mother. Stell Dorman, shortly before disappearing. The

final conversation still heunts her "We were just talking about regular things," recalls Stelia. It told him his father went for a course and struggled a bit — I just wanted to keep him talking."

That evening, around 20:00, she phoned him again. Alwin told her he was driving on the Derby Road and that his petrol tank was almost empty. Then, suddenly, she heard the

words that still echo in her mind: "Oh F**k, I'm in the bushes."

Panicked Stelia stayed on the line, urging the to try restarting his car — a red Renault SUV (registration number FTN133L) — but he said it wouldn't start. He told her she might see his headlights flickering from the

I drove and drove where Alwin said he was, but I couldn't find him anywhere," she says through tears. Since that night, all attempts a contact him have failed, and his phone has emained off. A missing person's case has been opened with the Rustenburg Police.

Rustenburg – In the heart of town, at 6 Kotze Street, Rustenburg, a humble classroom at Mukhanyo Theological College, Rustenburg Advanced Learning Centre, is transforming lives — not just through education, but through faith, purpose, and practical empowerment.

Founded in 1994, Mukhanyo Theological College is a respected Christian institution with a central campus in KwaMhlanga, Mpumalanga, six regional campuses, and more than 100 Local Learning Sites across Southern Africa. The Rustenburg Centre, under the leadership of Dr Eben le Roux, plays a unique role in bridging faith and everyday life.

"In the mornings from 08:00 to 13:00, we run a life-skills programme based on a Biblical worldview," explains Dr le Roux. "It equips young people with tools to find employment, manage money wisely, and develop a good work ethic — all while grounding their values in God's Word."

Evenings at the centre are devoted to theological studies — from the FOCUS programme, which connects Biblical truth to real-life issues, to accredited qualifications such as the Higher Certificate in Bible Teaching and the BTh degree. Classes are interactive and deeply personal. "We don't just learn Bible history," says student Lincoln Rabotho. "We discuss it, question it, and discover how it shapes our daily lives."





By debushing and cutting deeper into the veld, they improved safety for walkers and joggers. Cllr Tanya Rothman also directed the team to clear access to RLM's sewer line for easier maintenance.

Ward 17 Mega Clean-up

Our Ward Matters joined hands with the DA Ward 17 team and local councillors in Red Maple Drive and Kloof Road, opposite Greystone Shopping Centre, for a large-scale clean-up. Illegal dumping was removed, and overgrown areas were cut back. A DA gazebo was set up to help residents collect proof of residence while volunteers got their hands dirty for a good cause. 
