No More Lost Sons PSA Demands End to Illegal Initiation Schools

has pledged its support to the North West Provincial Initiation Coordinating Committee (PICC) and the National Initiation Oversight Committee (NIOC) in their fight against illegal initiation schools.

The PSA condemned the reckless and unlawful practices at unregistered schools, which claimed the lives of six young initiates this year, while more than 100 were rescued from abuse, dehydration, and unsafe conditions.

"These tragedies are preventable," the PSA stressed, calling for strict enforcement of the Customary Initiation Act (Act 2 of 2021), full registration of schools, and accountability for

NW - The Public Servants Association (PSA) offenders. Parents, traditional leaders, and schools are urged to ensure compliance with legal, medical, and safety requirements.

The PSA noted that awareness and proactive monitoring save lives — citing the June 2025 rescue of 67 boys — but warned that stronger,

Rustenburg/ Phokeng - The South African Police Service (SAPS) in Phokeng is urging community members to be extra cautious when buying goods or services online. The warning comes after a surge in online fraud cases, where residents have fallen victim to criminals posing as legitimate sellers.

Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi explained that fraudsters are using fake websites, social media ads, and false payment confirmations to deceive unsuspecting buyers.

In one case from Luka Village, a resident paid over R3,700 for "stop nonsense" wall slabs — but the goods never arrived. In another incident, a victim lost R1,500 trying to buy an SUV air conditioner, only to receive a fake tracking number. Even police officers, Mokgadi added, are not immune to these scams.

SAPS has shared several safety tips to help the public stay safe online: always buy from trusted websites, verify sellers, look for secure web addresses ("https"), and never share personal information with unknown sources.

third suspect faces court

Rustenburg – Justice has taken a significant step forward in the case of local businessman Ben Gumbi (50), who was gunned down outside a Rustenburg coffee shop in August

The North West High Court, sitting in Mogwase, has sentenced Sibongiseni Ngubane (33) and Thabani Lethukuthula Gwala (30) to life imprisonment for murder and an additional 15 years for possession of an unlicensed firearm sentences which will run concurrently.

Gumbi was shot in cold blood after stepping outside a coffee shop to take a phone call while his wife waited in their locked vehicle. The killers fled, later abandoning their getaway car. Police linked the suspects to the scene through surveillance footage and fingerprint evidence.

In court, advocate Dibuseng Ntsala of the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) described the crime as "brutal, violent, and callous," urging the court to impose the maximum penalty. The NPA's Director of Public Prosecutions, Dr Rachel Makhari, welcomed the sentence, commending the prosecution for ensuring justice was served.

Meanwhile, a third suspect, Zimele Mntuyazi Nkwanyana (37), has been arrested in Port Shepstone, KwaZulu-Natal, and appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrate's Court on 10 October 2025. He is expected to return on 17 October for a bail application.

The acting provincial police commissioner, major general Patrick Asaneng, applauded the continued investigation.

From Seedlings to Success: schools cultivate hope at EduPlant Awards

Rustenburg – The vibrant spirit of growth and sustainability took root at Konka Resort on Tuesday, 7 October 2025, as learners, educators, and environmental champions from across South Africa gathered for the long-awaited EduPlant Awards Ceremony — the first since the COVID-19 pandemic.




