Rustenburg — The rumours were true! After videos of supposed crocodiles in Olifantsnek Dam flooded social media, local environmentalist and insurance broker Thomas de Wet from De Wet De Villiers Brokers decided to find out once and for all what was hiding beneath the surface.

Within days, Thomas rallied a multi-stakeholder task team including the Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism (DEDECT), the Department of Water and Sanitation, the Olifantsnek Yacht Club, local anglers, and farmers. Together, they launched a nighttime spotlight search across the dam that felt straight out of a nature-documentary thriller. By midnight, the beams of their torches revealed the truth: three young crocodiles, each about half a metre long, gliding silently near the reeds. Working carefully with nets, the team captured all three and later released them safely into the Pilanesberg Nature Reserve.

nentalist and insurance broker Thomas de Wet, whose quick action and community spirit sparked the investigation that united Olifantsnek residents.

"The goal was never to harm them," explains Vasti Botha from DEDECT. "We simply wanted to confirm their presence and move them to a safe, natural habitat. The situation is completely under control." Authorities remind visitors to stay alert near the water, avoid swimming or wading, and report any new sightings immediately. Olifantsnek remains open and safe for anglers.

Onalenna's Case **Postponed Again**

Rustenburg - The case of North-West University (NWU) student Onalenna Selebogo (21) has once again been postponed. The matter was postponed to 11 December 2025 for further investigation, confirmed Sivenathi Gunya, National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) communication officer for the North West Division.

Walter Tshela, the suspected killer, stands accused of brutally murdering his girlfriend, Onalenna, whose body was found wrapped in sheets at a Tuin Street flat in Rustenburg on 3 August 2025, after she had been stabbed multiple times in the neck.

Onalenna's story has become a heartbreaking reminder of South Africa's ongoing fight against femicide, sparking campus vigils and widespread calls for accountability. Friends remember her as a joyful, determined young woman who had so much more to give.

Caroline Werner's case faces another postponement

Rustenburg - The long road to justice for the late Caroline Werner (31) remains heartbreakingly unfinished. The murder case against Solly "Moya" Molefe (22) — accused of brutally taking her life in September 2022 — has once again been postponed.

According to Sivenathi Gunya, spokesperson for the National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) in the North West division, the matter that was meant to proceed on 14 October 2025 was first postponed to 30 October, and has now been pushed out yet again — to 6 November 2025.

For Caroline's family, each postponement reopens wounds that have never healed. "Every delay feels like she's being taken from us all over again." a Caroline's mother shared outside court. "We just want justice - nothing more, nothing less."

Caroline's vibrant life was cruelly ended near the R24 and Dinie Estates Road nearly three years ago. As her loved ones continue their painful vigil for justice, her memory lives on in the hearts of all who knew her.

When Curiosity Turns into Community Action

Rustenburg — When unverified videos of crocodiles in Olifantsnek Dam began circulating two weeks ago, most people dismissed them as gossip. But for Thomas de Wet, a local environmental enthusiast and insurance broker from De Wet De Villiers Brokers, it was worth finding out the truth.

"I'm at the dam often," says Thomas. "I keep an eye out for illegal nets - not as part of any organisation, just because I care about the place. When those crocodile videos appeared, I thought, let's rather get the facts before rumours start swimming around or growing tails."

The Operation

Within days, Thomas helped assemble a multi-stakeholder task including the Department Development, Economic Environment, Conservation and Tourism (DEDECT), the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), the Olifantsnek Yacht Club, the Rustenburg Angling Club, and surrounding farmers.

A cage trap was installed under the guidance of DEDECT damage causing animal official Vasti Botha and student Chané Oberholzer, with local farmer Shanneth Wenhold assisting in collecting the cage. Thomas Wenhold from Duco generously supplied the bait.

"We wanted to act quickly, but safely," explains Vasti Botha. "The aim was never to harm the animals - only to confirm their presence and move them to a secure environment. We also set a cage to check if there were any bigger crocodiles. For now, we're monitoring, but the situation is under control."

To add scientific expertise. Xander Combrink specialists and Fortunate Davhana from the Tshwane University of Technology's Department of Nature Conservation joined the team, bringing valuable experience in crocodile behaviour and capture techniques.

When the first night yielded no

crocodiles — only a giant barbel (catfish) in the cage - the group adjusted their strategy. The following night they launched boats for a spotlight search around the entire

Loutiie Louwies, well-known Protea angler and owner of Signature Series Fishing Products, offered his boat for the night-time operation, while John Fourie, Morné Graham, and Thomas Schlotfeldt from the Olifantsnek Yacht Club joined in with another craft and hours of patient scanning.

By midnight, teamwork paid off: three young crocodiles, each roughly half a metre long, were safely netted. secured, and transported to the Pilanesberg Nature Reserve, where they now live freely in their natural habitat — far from human danger. "After covering the whole dam, we didn't see any others," Thomas says. "We'll repeat the search again soon, just to be sure, but it looks like the population is small and contained."

Living with Nature — Not Against It For Thomas, the lesson is simple. "People shouldn't be afraid - just

aware. It's completely natural for crocodiles to appear in dams. Floods and rivers connect everything. They're part of nature's design." He added with caution: "If you see something, please don't try to catch or harm it yourself. Call DEDECT or dam management. We can protect both people and the animals.

Crocodiles are powerful predators that deserve our respect. Earlier this year, sevenvear-old Johandré Blom tragically lost his arm in a crocodile attack at Roodekoppies Dam during a family outing a heartbreaking reminder of the strength and unpredictability of these reptiles. South Africa. Across

around three to five crocodile attacks are reported each year, usually when people swim, wade, or clean fish near the water's edge. Simple awareness saves

Enjoy the Dam — Safely

Olifantsnek Dam remains one of Rustenburg's most beloved recreational spots. Anglers can keep enjoying the water — just with added awareness:

- · Don't wade or swim in the dam (to wade means walking in shallow
 - Supervise children and pets.
 - Avoid dusk and dawn, when crocodiles are most active.
 - Never feed or approach wildlife.
 - Report any sightings to DEDECT or local authorities.


"Fishing at Olifantsnek is still fantastic," says Thomas. "Let's just enjoy it safely and look after the place we all love."



Mother Arrested After Daughter's Remains Found Under Concrete Slab

Rustenburg – The remains of a 20-year-old woman were found buried beneath a concrete slab in her mother's yard. According to colonel Adéle Myburgh, the 43-year-old mother was arrested on Thursday, 30 October 2025, after police exhumed human remains believed to be those of her missing daughter from their home in Seraleng, Boitekong, near Rustenburg. The woman appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday, 3 November 2025, on charges of murder and defeating the ends of justice.

The arrest followed a concerned family member's report after not seeing the young woman for several months. "When questioned, the mother claimed her daughter was visiting relatives in Limpopo. However, the father denied this version, prompting further investigation," Myburgh explained. A police team proceeded to the house and identified a suspicious concrete-covered area in the yard. "An exhumation was conducted, leading to the grim discovery of the remains. The accused was immediately taken into custody," Myburgh confirmed. Acting provincial commissioner of the North West, Major General (Dr) Ryno Naidoo, commended the family member for speaking up. Investigations continue.

Beware the Spikes!

Rustenburg – Bakwena Platinum Corridor Concessionaire has issued an urgent safety alert following an increase in vehicle spiking incidents along several South African highways, including the N1N4 route. The warning, issued on 31 October 2025, urges motorists to exercise extra caution when driving at night, as criminals are placing spikes and other sharp objects on roads to puncture tyres and force vehicles to stop. Once stationary, drivers and passengers are at risk of being robbed or assaulted. Bakwena is working closely with the South African Police

Community Patrol uncovers dagga and stolen cables in Geelhoutpark

Rustenburg - The Rustenburg Crime Combating Forum (RCCF), joined by Wesalarms, Fidelity ADT, and vigilant community members, conducted an intensive night patrol from 21:30 on 24 October 2025 until the early hours of 02:30 on 25 October 2025 — covering Geelhoutpark, Bo-dorp, the Central Business District, and East End.

According to RCCF chairperson Kobus Ferreira, the patrol proved fruitful in several areas. "In Geelhoutpark, we investigated a fire seen near the corner of Acasia and Willow Avenue. Upon arrival, we discovered a man who fled as soon as he saw our flashlights. After a brief search, we found a bag containing 15 packets of dagga and two aluminium cables, each about five metres long," Ferreira said. "Rustenburg SAPS took possession of the dagga, and Rustenburg Local

Municipality (RLM) collected the cables.'

In Bo-dorp, the team noticed a suspicious individual inside a yard on Klopper Street near Fields College, but the suspect escaped before they could intervene. Later, in East End. a report about an alleged vehicle theft in Bethlehem Street turned out to be a false alarm — the car's owner was simply leaving the premises.







injections and neurologist visits to mobility aids and specialist consultations — continue to stretch the family's finances. Kevin's biggest dream is to complete his matric next year — a goal his mother Aurelia and grandmother Esmay are determined to help him reach. "Thank you to everyone who participated and supported our fundraiser, and to my mother for sponsoring the lamb," Aurelia said gratefully.

When Kevin heard that October's bills had been covered thanks to the raffle, his words said it all: "Now I have to work hard to show everyone that their money is being used for a good cause."




