

Rustenburg - When Platinum Weekly first reported the escape of a lioness from Lost Valley Predator Experience and Lodge in June 2024, the story captured hearts across Rustenburg. The young lioness, Savannah, was found safe two days later — and soon after, her keepers discovered the real reason behind her great escape: she had been searching for a quiet place to give birth.

On 16 June 2024, Savannah gave birth to three cubs — two males and a female. Only one, a spirited male named Judah, survived after intensive veterinary care. stands as a living reminder of courage, instinct, and the fragile future of Africa's lions.

Across the continent, fewer than 20,000 lions remain in the wild, and sanctuaries like Lost Valley play a crucial role in protecting the species through education, responsible breeding, and hands-on care.

To celebrate Savannah's journey and raise funds for animal welfare, Lost Valley will host a Wildlife Festival on 6-7 December 2025. Visitors can meet the lions, hear their stories, and help ensure the roar of Africa continues for



Tragic midnight accident claims pedestrian's life on R24

Rustenburg – In the early hours of Sunday morning, 9 November 2025, a pedestrian lost their life after being struck by a vehicle on the R24 near Magalies View.

At approximately 00:14, Rustenburg First Responders received an urgent call reporting the incident. Their team, together with Bojanala EMS Response Vehicle, was immediately dispatched to the scene. Upon arrival, responders found that the pedestrian had sustained fatal injuries. "Despite all efforts, the individual was sadly declared deceased on scene," said Ammaar Wadee, administrator of Rustenburg First Responders.

He added: "Our team extends heartfelt condolences to the family and loved ones of the deceased during this difficult time."

They raise awareness, fund reported on the daring escape of a young lioness from Lost Valley Predator Experience and Lodge in June 2024, the story spread quickly across Rustenburg. Residents were urged to stay indoors, and teams from Problem Animal Control worked around the clock to bring her home safely. The lioness, named Savannah, was found and returned unharmed after two tense days. At the time, it was believed she had escaped because she was "on heat" — but just days later, the truth came to light: Savannah hadn't been looking for adventure. She had been looking for a safe place to give birth.

On 16 June 2024, Savannah delivered three cubs — two males and a female. Sadly, the litter was premature, and despite intensive veterinary care, only one cub survived. His name is Judah, and he quickly became a symbol of strength, love, and survival.

"Judah is now one year and five months old strong, playful, and truly beautiful," says Lost Valley tour guide and manager Diana Swart. "He was born early and faced many challenges, but he's a miracle. He reminds us every day why we do what we do.'

A Beacon for Lion Conservation

South Africa's lions are among the world's most admired creatures - yet they face increasing threats. Across Africa, fewer than 20,000 wild lions remain. In South Africa, while national parks like Kruger offer protection, most lions now live in managed wildlife reserves or responsible sanctuaries like Lost Valley Predator Experience

Such facilities play a vital conservation and

veterinary care, and allow visitors to connect with lions in a controlled, ethical environment helping secure the species' survival for future generations.

"People often misunderstand what we do," says Lost Valley owner Gert van Rensburg. "Our goal isn't entertainment — it's education and preservation. Lions in the wild are disappearing fast. If we don't create safe spaces like these, they'll be gone in our children's lifetime."

At Lost Valley, every animal has a story. From rescues to rare births, the team works daily to ensure that lions like Savannah and Judah thrive under expert care, proper nutrition, and regular veterinary supervision.

Continuing the Legacy

Judah's story has become a source of pride and purpose for the Lost Valley family — a reminder of nature's resilience and a mother's instinct to protect life, even behind fences.

To celebrate these remarkable animals and raise funds for their ongoing care, Lost Valley Predator Experience and Lodge will host a Wildlife Festival on 6-7 December 2025. Visitors can meet the lions, learn more about conservation efforts, and experience the joy of connecting with Africa's most maiestic species.

Police Seize Illegal Firearms in Northam

Northam/ Rustenburg - A coordinated police operation has led to the arrest of a 41-year-old suspect and the recovery of a firearm, ammunition, and stolen goods

On Sunday, 9 November 2025, members of the Northam Detectives, Rustenburg Tactical Response Team (TRT), and the Thabazimbi Crime Intelligence Unit carried out an intelligence-driven joint operation that led to the suspect's arrest in Boitekong, Rustenburg.

According to colonel Malesela Ledwaba, the man was linked to a theft out of motor vehicle case committed in Northam during October. "During the operation, police recovered a pistol with cartridges and a magazine, along with a laptop and iPhone that had been stolen," he said. "Some of the property had already been sold to different individuals.

While tracing the firearm, officers received information about a bag left behind at a local tavern. When they searched it, they discovered the weapon inside. Rustenburg LCRC attended the scene for further forensic processing.

The provincial commissioner of police in Limpopo, lieutenant general Thembi Hadebe, commended the collaborative work of the teams involved and thanked community members who continue to share valuable information with law enforcement.

Fishy rumours spark panic but officials confirm no toxic threat at Harties

Hartbeespoort - Recent social media posts incident drew public attention around 21 October. fish on the road around Harties." The alarming claim alleged that "deadly chemicals were fish that were then supposedly being sold by the roadside

On 6 November 2025, Platinum Weekly received an official media statement from Magalies Water, Magalies Water spokesperson David Magae confirming that the only verified fish kill incident took place on 18 October 2025 at the canal near Venice Village Estate. The affected fish were subsequently buried on unoccupied land after the

warned residents to "be vigilant of people selling A joint inspection and water sampling were conducted on 22 October by Magalies Water, the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS), and released into the Hartbeespoort Dam," killing the Madibeng Local Municipality. Tests revealed no visible signs or evidence of chemical pollution, and no abnormalities were detected in the water

> explained that because the incident was reported several days after it occurred, water conditions may have changed by the time samples were taken — making it difficult to determine the precise



cause. He added that continued monitoring of raw water around the dam has shown no further

Experts believe the fish deaths were likely caused by low oxygen levels, a result of dense water hyacinth and salvinia growth combined with high levels of pollutants entering the dam. Residents are urged to report any future fish kills immediately to Magalies Water or the Department of Water and Sanitation, including photos and precise location details, to assist with swift investigation.

For now, authorities confirm there is no evidence of toxic chemicals in the Hartbeespoort Dam.


