estimating 40-45% coverage as of mid-November 2025. It's an alarming sight for anyone living around the dam — but according to the scientists, this sudden green takeover has very real seasonal and environmental reasons behind it.

Prof. Julie Coetzee, deputy director of the Centre for Biological Control (CBC), says the team expected a tough season.

"It looks overwhelming, but there is no quick fix," she explains. "Warm weather, dropping water levels and years of nutrient buildup all trigger this rapid growth. But the long-term pian is working.

Since August, the CBC has released more than 100,000 tiny water hyacinth planthoppers, with around 20,000 more going out every week. These insects weaken the plants and stop them from making new seeds an essential step in draining the dam's huge, 50-year-old seed bank. At the same time. Magalies Water crews are removing up to 500 tonnes of hyacinth every day, though shallow areas and damaged booms make the job tougher. The CBC and Magalies Water aim to achieve 95% open water by March 2026.

HIGH-TECH CAR THIEVES

Police Say It's Not New — **But Many Motorists Don't Know**

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg -A recent vehicle theft has drawn fresh attention to criminals using advanced signal-interference technology to unlock and steal cars within minutes. The affected owner says his vehicle was targeted after being followed by another car, and that the suspects used a device hidden in a laptop bag to intercept the locking signal. According to the owner, the thieves simply relayed that intercepted signal to an accomplice, who unlocked the vehicle with ease before driving it away. A tracking attempt briefly led to a secondary location before the signal disappeared, likely after the suspects removed a cell phone left inside. The vehicle has not been recovered.

The owner also reported being told that several similar thefts occurred recently. He now wants other motorists to be aware of the technique. SAPS spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh warned that the method is already familiar to investigators. "This is not a new trend. It has been happening for quite some time

- criminals are simply using newer, more advanced technology," she said.

Netstar responded through Mehluli Dube of Technical Services: "Vehicle theft syndicates do make use of advanced methods, including signal interception, jamming, and key relay techniques." Dube added that signal-related theft is commonly used in high-risk areas and busy parking sites, often involving groups of criminals who follow a targeted vehicle. He noted that jamming of locking signals is widespread, advising motorists to physically check that their doors have locked before walking away. Netstar said stolen vehicles are typically moved to a secondary spot where tracking units are located and disabled.

What motorists should remember

- Always check manually that your vehicle is locked.
- Be alert if you suspect you're being
- followed into a parking area. Report any suspicious behaviour or failed locking attempts immediately.

Long arm of the law nabs runaway robbery pair

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg Two suspects believed to be involved in a string of business and house robberies across the North West were arrested on Thursday, 4 December 2025, following coordinated police operations involving units in Zeerust, Phokeng and Rustenburg. The arrests come after several incidents reported in Zeerust, Madikwe, Boitekong and Rustenburg earlier this year, including a break-in at Autumn Leave Mall in Zeerust. According to police spokesperson lieutenant colonel Sam Tselanyane, four suspects allegedly gained forced entry into the mall in the early hours of Thursday morning and broke into two shops, stealing numerous cellular phones. Security personnel attempted to intervene but were unable to stop the suspects, who fled in a white Suzuki.

Police later tracked the vehicle to East End in Rustenburg. Two individuals — a 33-year-old Malawian man and his 29-year-old Mozambican girlfriend — were arrested at the location. A search of their rented room uncovered suspected stolen goods, including cellular phones, explosives, household items, bedding and a television set. The vehicle believed to have been used during the crimes was also seized.

The pair appeared in the Rustenburg Magistrate's Court on Monday, 8 December 2025, facing charges relating to possession of suspected stolen goods and possession of explosives, as well as charges under section 49 of the Immigration Act. Police say further charges may be added as investigations continue, and they are looking into possible links to other cases.



CPF warns of hijacking spike on R510 and surrounding routes



Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg - As residents gear up for the busy festive season, growing fears about alleged hijackings on the R510 near Rustenburg have placed motorists on edge — despite police stating they have no confirmed incidents on record.

Brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone has called for caution and accuracy, stressing that police cannot verify any of the alleged hijacking reports. "These allegations are circulating, yet we have no confirmed cases on record. We urge anyone with information to report it to the police, as unsubstantiated claims can create unnecessary fear in the community," he said.

But on the ground, community structures say they are seeing a worrying trend. Community Policing Forum (CPF) EXCO chairperson Marcus Haasbroek has expressed deep concern over what he describes as a sharp rise in hijackings along the R510 in recent months.

Haasbroek says criminals are exploiting the road's environmental weaknesses — poor visibility, inadequate lighting, thick vegetation, and high traffic volumes from Rustenburg's CBD to the Boitekong and Sunrise Park areas. "The vehicle hijackings taking place on the R510 have significantly increased. The criminals are using the environmental design to their advantage due to the lack of police visibility, lighting and vegetation control... We urge the community to be alert and not pick up strangers. If you feel you're being targeted, drive to the nearest police station not a garage — as criminals take advantage of the chaos. He further recommends motorists travel in groups when possible, and called on SANRAL to help address the issue by installing an ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition)

Province-wide warning: hijackers targeting major routes Beyond Rustenburg, a broader alert has been issued for motorists travelling across the N14, N4, R510, R503, R53 and R52 in the North West Province

CCTV system along the route.

Recent incidents reported between Ventersdorp, Coligny, Lichtenburg, Koster and Rustenburg suggest that hijackers are using varied tactics, including:

- Pretending to be stranded motorists
- Posing as officials
- Following vehicles until drivers stop in isolated areas Authorities caution that drivers should treat any suspicious situation with extreme care

How to stay safe: hijacking prevention tips

- Stay alert and aware of your surroundings If you feel unsafe, drive straight to a police station
- Avoid stopping in dark or isolated areas
- Watch for suspicious vehicles following you
- Lock your doors, close windows, hide valuables
- Do not use your phone while driving
- Time traffic lights at night to reduce stopping
- Leave space between vehicles to allow an escape route
- Avoid driving alone late at night
- Never pick up strangers
- Vary your daily routes
- If bumped from behind, drive to a public place or police station before stopping

Helen Joseph Bridge OPENS AHEAD OF SCHEDULE



Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg - In what many residents are calling a welcome surprise, the Helen Joseph interchange bridge has reopened far earlier than expected - officially on 9 December 2025 - easing one of the city's most persistent traffic bottlenecks.

The bridge, originally scheduled to remain closed until 30 July 2026, became a daily source of frustration for thousands of commuters, but the construction teams exceeded even the most optimistic predictions. Local resident Horick Demister was among the first to walk across the newly restored structure. He said that the rapid progress made it "feel like a new pair of shoes." The rapid turnaround was led by Raubex Group Limited, the construction and engineering company responsible for the project. Site manager Bernard Vos explained that the team felt a strong responsibility to act quickly because of the bridge's importance to Rustenburg's infrastructure. He noted that the closure had a significant impact on the daily lives and economic activity of residents and commuters, and that this awareness drove the company to allocate additional resources to speed up the work. Vos praised the collective effort behind the scenes,

describing the project's success as a testament to exceptional teamwork, careful planning, and unwavering dedication from engineers, contractors, and on-site workers. Although the task was far from easy, the team ensured the bridge was restored both swiftly and to the highest standard of quality.

Bakwena's PR Manager, Charmaine van Wyk, confirmed that the bridge is now open to the public. She added that while a few finishing touches will continue into early next year, these remaining tasks will not affect the safe use of the bridge. She expressed appreciation for the community's patience and support throughout the process

With the Helen Joseph bridge back in service, traffic in and around Rustenburg is expected to improve significantly, particularly for residents of Protea Park, Safarituine, Azalea Park and nearby areas. Combined with the earlier-than-scheduled reopening of the Kruger Street bridge, the city is finally seeing the benefits of the ongoing N4 upgrade, after months of congestion and uncertainty.

The restored bridge is more than a structural milestone; it represents relief, reconnection, and renewed momentum for Rustenburg's commuters

Renovating Thabane Community Health Centre

Sibanye-Stillwater recently renovated and handed over the Thabane Community Health Centre, Rustenburg, at a cost of over R660 thousand. The renovations included plumbing repairs, the construction of new ablution facilities, installation of vinyl flooring and porcelain files and new doors and locksets. The project created eight jobs and was conducted in partnership with the Department of Mineral and Petroleum Resources and the North West Province's Department of Health.

This will improve healthcare access for the community, decrease waiting times, and also help to enhance community health and hygiene. It will also contribute to strengthening the currently strained public healthcare system in South Africa.

Officials present at the handover included representatives from the Rustenburg Local Municipality, community leaders, and our valued partners from the Department of Health, the Sub-District Manager, and the Department of Mineral and





Sibanye-Stillwater University of Pretoria's Faculty Veterinary Science, recently embarked on livestock farmer development strategic partnership. primary objective this initiative is to educate farmers on Primary Animal HealthCare, improve livestock disease risk management, train and capacitate small-scale livestock farmers, and increase productivity to ensure local economic development and community empowerment.

As part of the initiative, ninety livestock farmers were trained from the Bojanala District Municipality and thirty from the Lepelle Nkumpi Local Municipality. Three modules covering early disease

identification, treatment and prevention, production and seasonal planning, and livestock marketing and sales were delivered. Participants are now equipped to apply basic datadriven livestock production management practices to enhance livestock productivity, reduce production losses and improve disease surveillance and reporting, ensuring job creation and farm sustainability.

Sibanye-Stillwater remains committed to investing in efforts aimed at increasing agricultural knowledge as a means of enhancing capacity and sustainability. We believe that communities should be exposed to the business aspects of farming and livestock value chains, since improved livestock productivity will ensure the

development of thriving and sustainable local economies.




This initiative strengthens visibility and safety in our communities, equipped to serve and protect communities. Sibanye-Stillwater remains committed to making

As part of this we have erected high-mast lights, trained community safety coordinators (CSCs), regularly partner with the SAPS, religious leaders and local communities, ensuring CPF members are better constructed GBVF pods, and established the Bojanala Wellness and Safety Centre.









- Flash floods are sudden and unpredictable, making them one of the most dangerous natural disasters
- These floods can develop within minutes or hours from heavy rain or dam failures, making them extremely dangerous
- Fast-moving water can sweep away vehicles, damage landscapes, and cause fatalities, especially in areas with poor drainage



Remember:

- Strong currents can pull you off your feet, even in shallow water
- Flash floods can happen without warning, even when rainfall is not heavy
- Tailings dams and mine shafts are not areas to swim in
- The fences around the tailings facilities should not be damaged or broken to avoid harm to people and livestock
- Swimming is not allowed as this may result in drowning or diseases



Choose carefully:

- Avoid water-covered roads, especially at night
- Do not walk or swim near dams or areas that are fenced and have "danger" and No Entry" signs
- Do not allow children to play in or around flowing water

SMALL HOPPERS, BIG JOB Hartbeespoort Turns to Nature for Relief

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Hartbeespoort Dam is once again feeling the pressure of a fierce surge of water hyacinth, with coverage estimated at 40–45% in the week of 4 November 2025. What many residents see as a sudden crisis is, in reality, the result of a complex environmental cycle decades in the making.

According to prof. Julie Coetzee, deputy director of the Centre for Biological Control (CBC) at Rhodes University and principal scientist at the NRF South African Institute for Aquatic Biodiversity, the dramatic green spread is no

"It looks overwhelming, but there is no quick fix," prof. Coetzee explains. "Peak summer growth, exposed old seed banks, and nutrient-rich runoff have all aligned to fuel rapid expansion. But we are responding - and the long-term strategy is working."

Biological control: nature's slow but powerful solution

Since August, the CBC has intensified its biological control programme built on a tiny but highly effective ally: Megamelus scutellaris, commonly known as the water hyacinth planthopper. These insects stress the plants, prevent flowering, and — crucially — stop new seeds from forming. Over time, this depletes the dam's 50-year-old seed bank, the true driver of seasonal hyacinth explosions. "Since 2019, these insects have kept summer hyacinth levels below 5%," says Prof. Coetzee. "The challenge isn't failed biocontrol — it's the massive seed germination that happens every spring. Each year we prevent flowering, the seed bank shrinks. That is long-term success."

More than 100,000 insects have already been released, with 20,000 more added each week, supported by community-run rearing stations.

A dam under pressure

Magalies Water and contractors are removing up to 500 tonnes of hyacinth per day, using harvesters, excavators, and manual crews working 22-hour days. But progress is often slowed by: shallow and inaccessible shorelines, vandalised containment booms, safety restrictions at the dam wall, and rapid plant regrowth during peak season. Despite these challenges, an expanded fleet — including additional excavators and harvesters — is being deployed this month.

The work on the water

Prof. Coetzee emphasises that biological control must work hand-in-hand with harvesting and nutrient reduction. "Integrated management is the only path to lasting control," she says. "Biocontrol weakens growth, harvesting removes mass, and reducing upstream pollution tackles the root cause '

What About Spraying? Hippos? Commercial Harvesting?

Some community suggestions appear every year — but science and safety tell a different story.

- Herbicides cause dangerous blue-green algal blooms and trigger mass flowering, adding millions more seeds.
- Hippos were tried historically and nearly starved hyacinth offers almost no nutrition and poses human-safety risks.
- Commercial harvesting is helpful but cannot keep up with peak seasonal growth.

"If spraying worked, we'd use it," prof. Coetzee says plainly. "We need solutions that don't make next year's problem worse."

Safety First: NSRI Warns Boaters

The NSRI has issued a strong advisory urging boaters to reconsider launching onto the dam, warning of unpredictable drifting hyacinth mats, engine damage, entanglement hazards, and limited rescue options. "Every rescue in these conditions is dangerous," says Arthur Crewe, NSRI station commander. Boaters who still choose to launch are urged to check wind forecasts, monitor hyacinth movement, and log trips on the SafeTRX app.

What residents can expect — and when

The CBC and Magalies Water aim to achieve 95% open water by March 2026. "Community anger is justified," says prof. Coetzee. "But giving up will doom the dam. We're asking for 12 months of sustained support so the science can do its job."

The bottom line

This is not a failure — it is a long-term recovery from a 50year problem. The insects are working. The harvesters are working. The system is responding. But the dam will only heal through persistence, partnership, and patience. For now, on Hartbeespoort's waters, the tiniest workers may be the most important ones of all.
